KEY HIGHLIGHTS

The Monthly Leading Economic Indicators report highlights changes in Consumer Price Indices, inflation rates, interest rates and exchange rates. In addition, the report details changes in selected indicators of international trade, agriculture, energy, construction, manufacturing, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

The overall Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased from 148.02 in December 2025 to 148.96 in January 2026, as shown in Table 1(a). The annual inflation rate, as measured by the CPI, stood at 4.4 per cent in January 2026, as presented in Table 1(b).

In January 2026, the Kenya Shilling appreciated against the US Dollar, Japanese Yen, and Tanzania Shilling, but depreciated against the Sterling Pound, Euro, South African Rand, and Uganda Shilling, as shown in Table 2. During the same period, the Central Bank of Kenya maintained its benchmark interest rate at 9.00 per cent. Treasury bill yields declined across all maturities in January 2026, the 91-day yield fell from 7.78 per cent to 7.72 per cent, the 182-day yield eased marginally to 7.80 per cent, while the 364-day yield declined from 9.28 per cent to 9.20 per cent. The interbank rate edged down from 9.08 per cent in December 2025 to 8.99 per cent in January 2026. Similarly, the weighted average deposit rate at commercial banks decreased from 7.13 per cent to 7.03 per cent, savings rates declined from 3.22 per cent to 3.18 per cent, and lending rates fell from 14.82 per cent to 14.81 per cent, as shown in Table 3.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 Share Index increased from 3,139 points in December 2025 to 3,299 points in January 2026. Similarly, the NSE All Share Index rose from 187 points to 195 points, while the NSE 25 Share Index advanced from 5,097 points to 5,322 points. Over the same period, the number of shares traded declined from 540 million to 410 million, while the number of equity transactions grew from 95.9 thousand to 127.2 thousand. Equity turnover fell from KSh 17.5 billion to KSh 13.8 billion, while market capitalization increased from KSh 2.9 trillion to KSh 3.1 trillion, as shown in Table 4.

Total money supply (M1) increased from KSh 2.36 trillion in November 2025 to KSh 2.39 trillion in December 2025. Over the same period, broad money supply (M2) rose from KSh 5.3 trillion to KSh 5.4 trillion, while foreign currency deposits increased from KSh 1.3 trillion to KSh 1.4 trillion. Consequently, the broader money supply (M3) expanded by 1.68 per cent, reaching KSh 6.7 trillion in December 2025, as shown in Table 5(a). Gross foreign exchange reserves grew by 1.1 per cent to KSh 2.4 trillion in January 2026, while net of foreign exchange liabilities declined from KSh 1.19 trillion in December 2025 to KSh 1.16 trillion in January 2026, as shown in Table 5(b).



The volume of coffee sold at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange rose from 2.8 thousand metric tonnes (MT) in November 2025 to 4.2 thousand MT in December 2025. During the same period, the average auction price per kilogram (kg) increased from USD 7.86 to USD 7.94. For the year 2025. The annual average price for 2025 was USD 7.21, up from USD 4.90 in 2024, while total sales declined by 7.4 percent to 41.6 thousand MT, down from 44.9 thousand MT in 2024, as shown in Table 6.

Tea production volume increased from 48.3 thousand MT in November 2025 to 50.7 thousand MT in December 2025. The volume of tea auctioned dropped from 31.4 thousand MT in November 2025 to 22.9 thousand MT in December 2025. Similarly, the average auction price decreased from USD 2.27 per kg to USD 2.26 per kg. The average auction price for 2025 stood at USD 2.15 per kg, down from USD 2.19 per kg in 2024, as presented in Table 7.

Cane deliveries decreased from 800.2 thousand MT in November 2025 to 709.8 thousand MT in December 2025. Cumulatively, 7.0 million MT were delivered in 2025, down from 9.3 million MT in 2024, as shown in Table 8. Tables 9(b) and 9(d) show the average retail prices for one kilogram of dry maize and dry beans, respectively. The average retail price of dry maize declined from KSh 61.8 per kg in December 2025 to KSh 57.6 per kg in January 2026. Similarly, the average retail price of dry beans fell from KSh 145.2 per kg to KSh 141.6 per kg over the same period.

Coffee export volumes increased from 2.9 thousand MT in December 2025 to 3.9 thousand MT in January 2026, with earnings rising from KSh 3.1 billion to KSh 4.3 billion. In contrast, tea export volumes declined from 64.0 thousand MT to 49.7 thousand MT, with earnings falling from KSh 19.6 billion to KSh 14.5 billion over the same period, as shown in Table 10.





The total value of trade increased from KSh 338.1 billion in December 2025 to KSh 342.6 billion in January 2026. Over the same period, export earnings rose from KSh 92.3 billion to KSh 97.3 billion, while import expenditure declined from KSh 245.8 billion to KSh 245.3 billion, as shown in Table 12.

In January 2026, the leading export destinations were Uganda, and Netherlands, with export values of KSh 9.6 billion, and KSh 6.4 billion, respectively as shown in Table 13(a). By product category, food and beverages accounted for the largest share of total exports at 44.7 per cent, followed by non-food industrial supplies at 23.0 per cent, while machinery and other capital equipment contributed 2.0 per cent, as shown in Table 13(b).

China, India, and the United Arab Emirates were the main sources of imports in January 2026, with import values of KSh 64.3 billion, KSh 31.0 billion, and KSh 23.0 billion, respectively, as presented in Table 14 (a). By product category, non-food industrial supplies constituted the largest share of total imports at 40.8 per cent, followed by fuel and lubricants at 15.4 per cent, machinery and other capital equipment at 12.9 per cent, food and beverages at 12.0 per cent, and transport equipment at 10.1 per cent, as presented in Table 14(b).

The total export value of ICT equipment rose by 95.7 per cent to KSh 338.7 million in January 2026, with telecommunications equipment exports increasing by 90.7 per cent to KSh 252.3 million. Conversely, the total import value of ICT equipment declined by 50.5 per cent to KSh 4.2 billion in January 2026, with the import value of telecommunications equipment falling by 38.7 per cent to KSh 2.3 billion, shown in Table 14(c).

The number of active agents increased from 473.6 thousand in December 2025 to 474.8 thousand in January 2026. During the same period, mobile money subscriptions, including active, inactive, and dormant accounts, rose from 89.5 million to 90.4 million. However, the total number of transactions decreased from 217.6 million to 215.1 million, while the total transaction value fell from KSh 722.5 billion to KSh 699.6 billion, as presented in Table 14(d).



ENERGY AND CONSTRUCTION



Local electricity generation increased from 1,170.2 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) in December 2025 to 1,199.0 million kWh in January 2026. Geothermal generation rose by 0.7 per cent to 564.6 million kWh, accounting for 47.1 per cent of total generation. Wind generation grew by 32.8 per cent to 201.5 million kWh, while solar generation increased by 17.9 per cent to 45.9 million kWh. In contrast, hydro generation declined by 11.1 per cent to 265.6 million kWh over the same period, as shown in Table 15(a).

Total electricity generation and imports rose from 1,328.5 million kWh in December 2025 to 1,360.2 million kWh in January 2026. Electricity imports increased from 158.3 million kWh to 161.2 million kWh, while electricity exports grew from 52.1 million kWh to 57.0 million kWh. KPLC electricity sales increased from 963.0 million kWh to 1,021.2 million kWh during the same period, as presented in Table 15 (b).

In January 2026, the national average retail prices of petroleum products were KSh 183.59 per litre for premium motor gasoline, KSh 171.64 per litre for light diesel oil, and KSh 154.96 per litre for illuminating kerosene. The average retail price of charcoal was KSh 94.10 per kg, while a 13-kg LPG cylinder retailed at KSh 3,146.51, as shown in Table 15(e). On the international market, the OPEC crude oil basket price increased from USD 61.70 per barrel in December 2025 to USD 62.31 per barrel in January 2026, as presented in Table 15(f).

The total value of building plans approved by Nairobi City County more than doubled from KSh 17.0 billion in November 2025 to KSh 40.5 billion in December 2025. This growth was driven by both residential approvals, which rose from KSh 14.7 billion to KSh 35.6 billion, and non-residential approvals, which increased from KSh 2.4 billion to KSh 4.9 billion. However, cumulative approvals for 2025 declined by 9.2 per cent to KSh 201.3 billion, down from KSh 221.6 billion in 2024, as shown in Table 16.



Sugar production declined from 66.3 thousand MT in November 2025 to 61.4 thousand MT in December 2025, as shown in Table 17(a). Soft drink production decreased from 83.1 million litres in December 2025 to 68.3 million litres in January 2026, as shown in Table 17(b). The number of vehicles assembled increased from 1,174 units in December 2025 to 1,375 units in January 2026, as shown in Table 17(c). Production of galvanized sheets declined from 29.2 thousand MT in December 2025 to 25.0 thousand MT in January 2026, as shown in Table 17(d). Cement production decreased from 953.2 thousand MT in December 2025 to 938.0 thousand MT in January 2026. Similarly, consumption declined from 938.3 thousand MT to 922.4 thousand MT, as shown in Table 17(e).

Total visitor arrivals through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), Moi International Airport (MIA), and other border entry points declined from 219,570 in October 2025 to 201,684 in November 2025, as presented in Table 18. Tables 19(a) and 19(b) present data on embarked passengers by port of destination and landed passengers by port of origin through JKIA, respectively. Total embarked passengers rose by 3.5 per cent to 287,914 in December 2025, while landed passengers increased by 16.5 per cent to 313,944 over the same period. Notably, departures to North America surged by 74.1 per cent to 4,063, and arrivals from the region grew by 57.0 per cent to 4,906.

Passenger traffic on the Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) increased from 258,600 in November 2025 to 344,391 in December 2025, with revenue rising from KSh 446.0 million to KSh 602.3 million. Freight tonnage via SGR decreased from 600.7 thousand MT to 569.5 thousand MT, while freight revenue increased from KSh 1.2 billion to KSh 1.3 billion over the same period, as shown in Table 19(d). Passenger traffic on the Metre Gauge Railway (MGR) decreased from 244,825 in November 2025 to 227,030 in December 2025, with revenue rising from KSh 13.0 million to KSh 16.2 million, as shown in Table 19(e). Similarly, freight tonnage via MGR declined from 82.4 thousand MT to 77.5 thousand MT, with revenue falling from KSh 144.0 million to KSh 141.1 million, as shown in Table 19(f).

Total cargo throughput at the Port of Mombasa increased from 4.1 million MT in November 2025 to 4.5 million MT in December 2025. During the same period, export volumes rose from 445.5 thousand MT to 453.6 thousand MT, while imports increased from 3.3 million MT to 3.7 million MT. In contrast, transshipment traffic declined from 330.6 thousand MT to 293.8 thousand MT and restows decreased from 16.3 thousand MT to 11.6 thousand MT, as presented in Table 19(g).

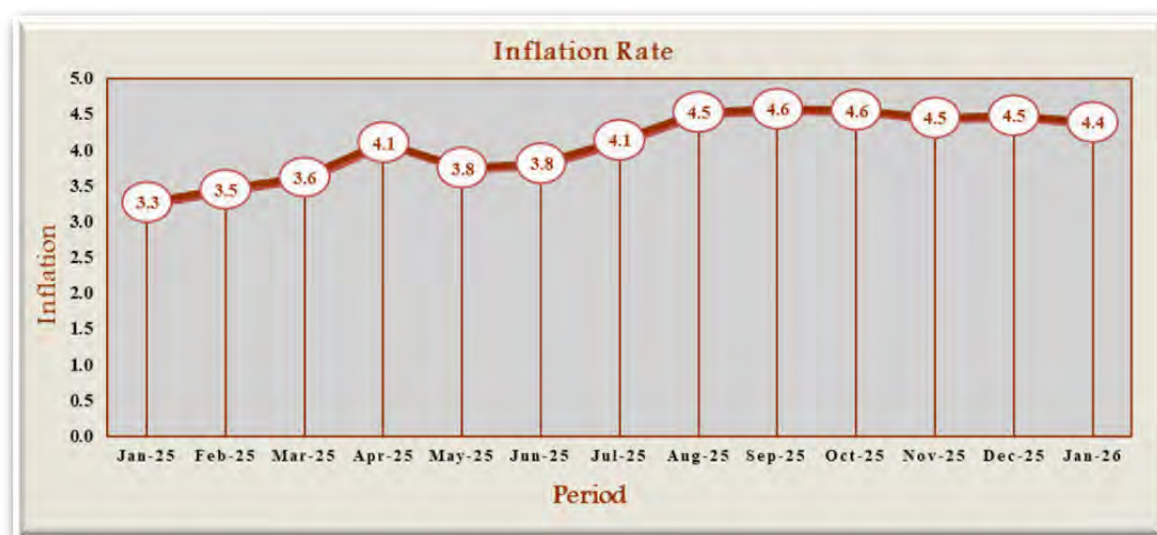
Figure 1: Inflation Rates: 2025 - 2026

Figure 2: Mean Monthly Foreign Exchange Rates of Kenya Shillings against Selected Major Currencies

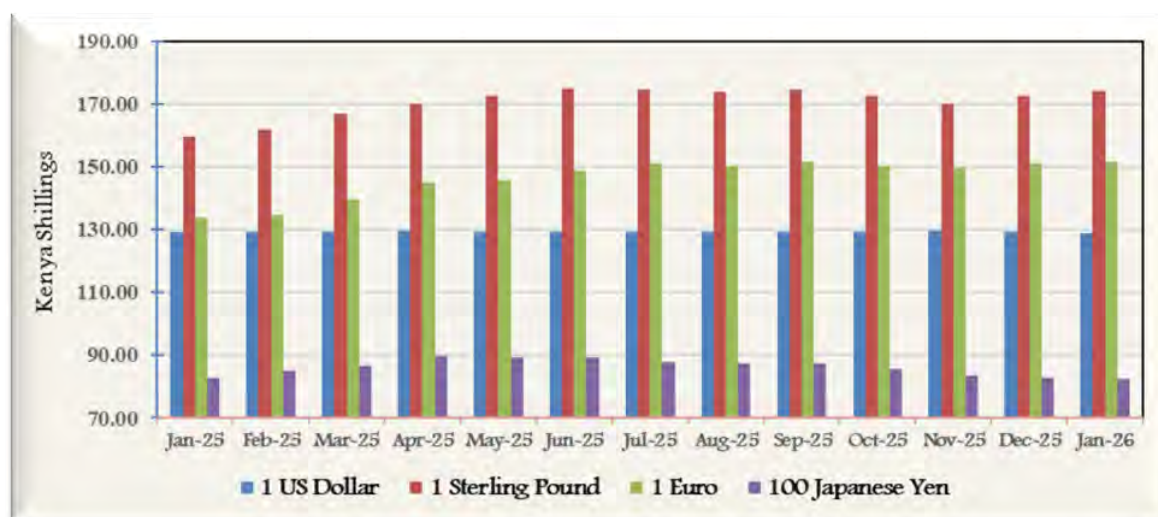

Figure 4: Tea Production

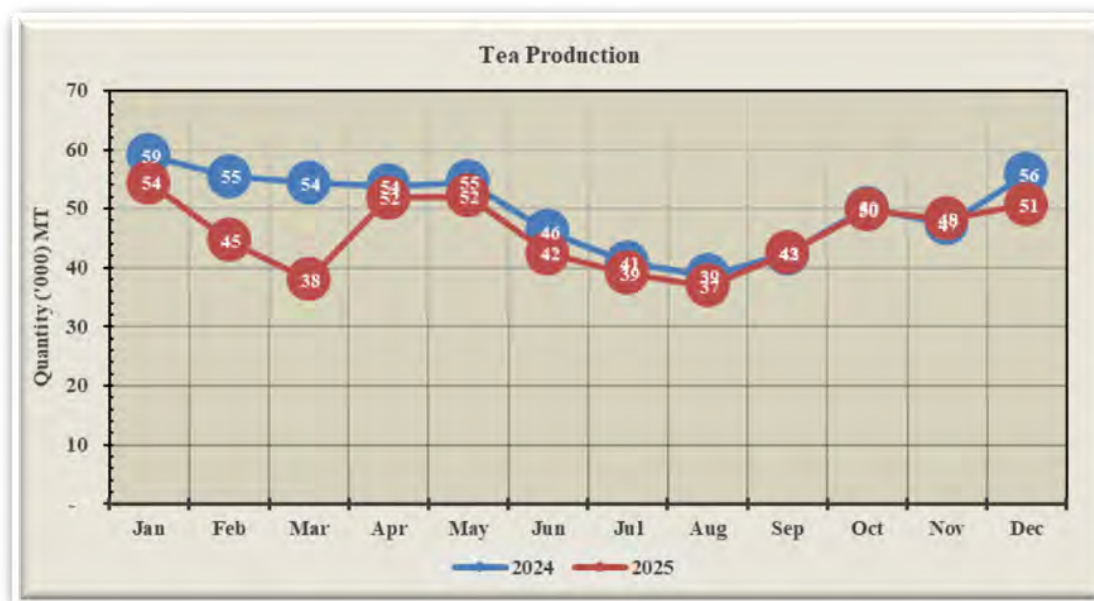

Figure 5: Cane Deliveries

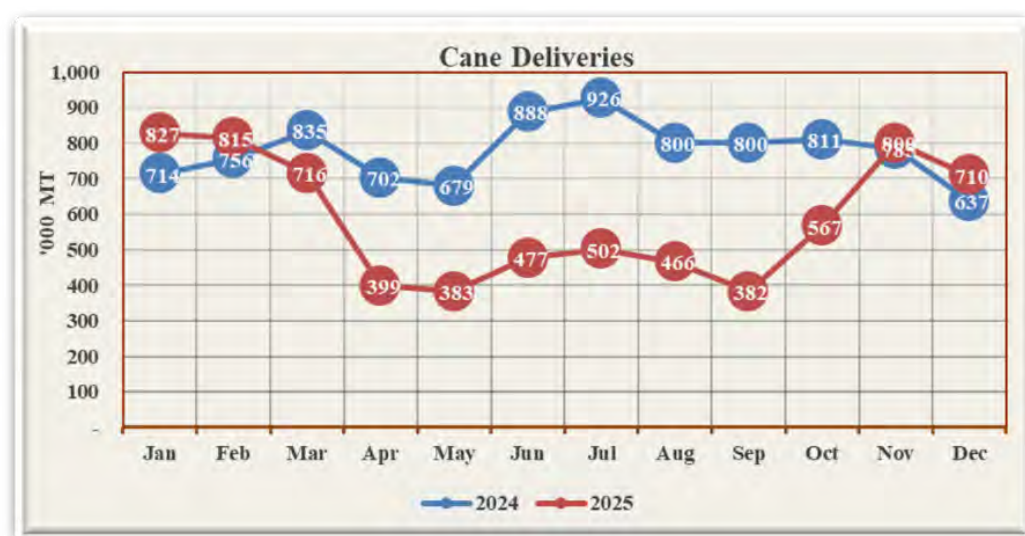

Figure 6: Electricity Generation by Source

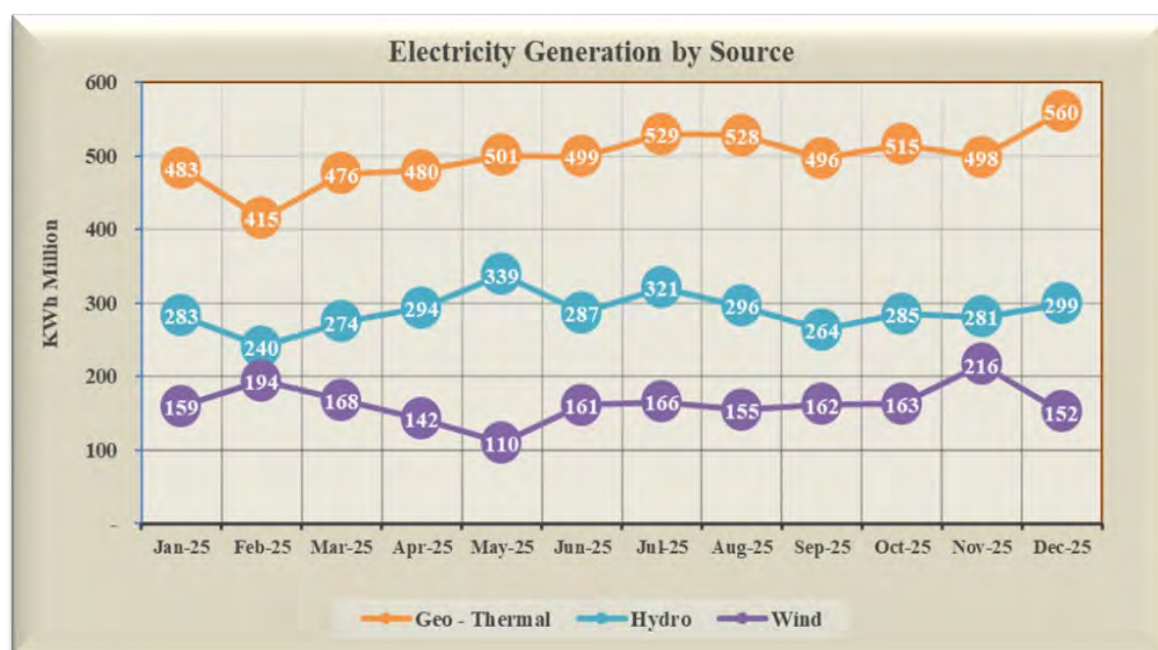

Figure 8: Sugar Production

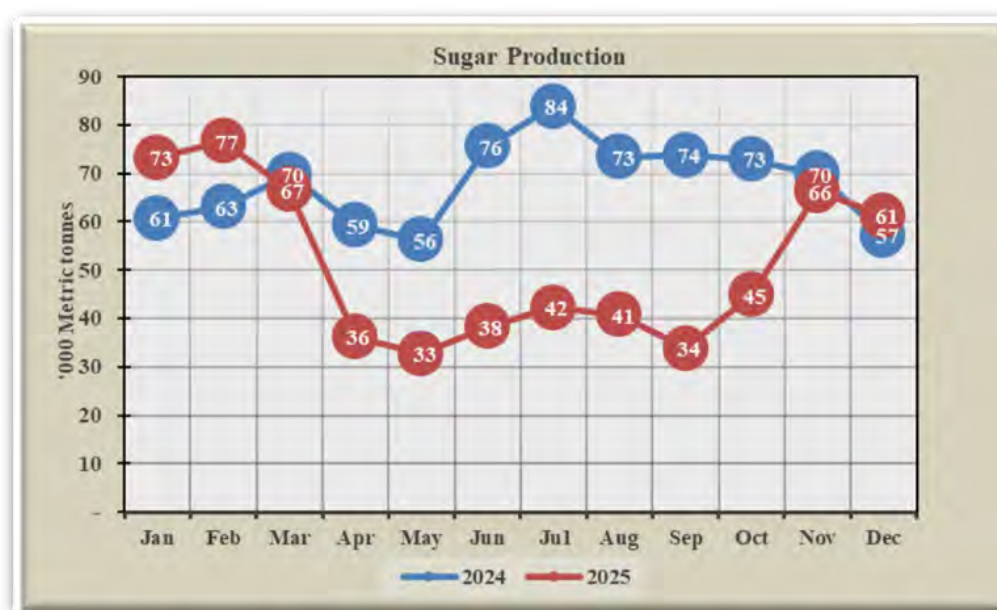

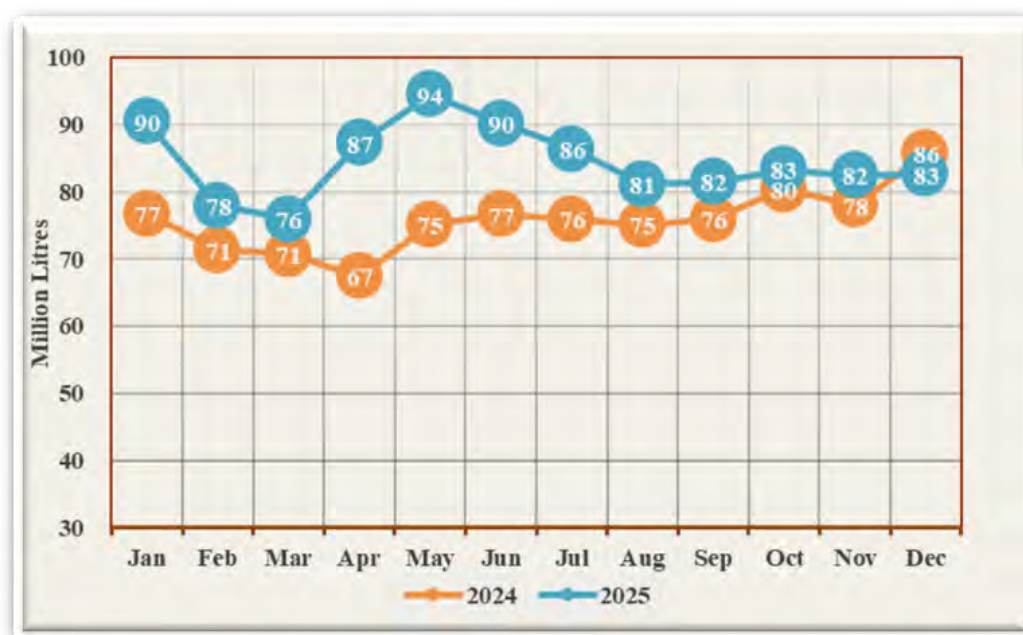
Figure 9: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector
