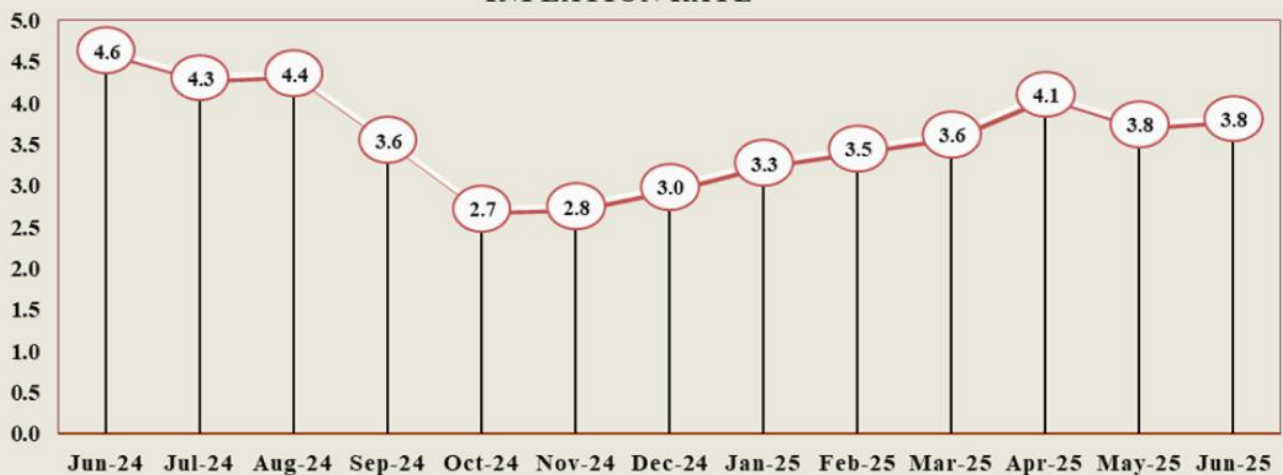

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

The Monthly Leading Economic Indicators report highlights changes in Consumer Price Indices, inflation rates, interest rates and exchange rates. In addition, the report details changes in selected indicators of international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased from an index of 144.88 in May 2025 to 145.58 in June 2025, as shown in Table 1(a). The overall year-on-year inflation rate, as measured by the CPI, was 3.8 per cent in June 2025, as presented in Table 1(b).

In June 2025, the Kenyan Shilling depreciated against all selected trading currencies except for the US Dollar, as shown in Table 2. The Central Bank of Kenya lowered its benchmark interest rate from 10.00 per cent in May 2025 to 9.75 per cent in June 2025. Similarly, the interbank rate declined from 9.86 per cent to 9.72 per cent over the same period. The average yield rates for Treasury Bills declined across all maturities in June 2025. The 91-day rate decreased from 8.37 per cent in May 2025 to 8.21 per cent in June 2025. Likewise, the 182-day rate edged down from 8.59 per cent to 8.51 per cent, while the 364-day rate declined from 10.01 per cent to 9.84 per cent. Commercial banks' weighted average lending rate decreased from 15.44 per cent in May 2025 to 15.29 per cent in June 2025. Similarly, the average deposit rate declined from 8.70 per cent to 8.37 per cent over the same period, as shown in Table 3.

Table 4 presents the monthly performance of the Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE). The NSE 20 Share Index increased from 2,183 points in May 2025 to 2,440 points in June 2025. The NSE All Share Index rose from 134 to 153 points, while the NSE 25 Share Index grew from 3,535 to 3,938 points. The number of equity transactions increased from 37,193 to 40,718, with the volume of shares traded rising from 501 million to 580 million. Equity turnover expanded from KSh 9.6 billion to KSh 12.0 billion during the same period.

The total money supply (M2) grew from KSh 5.09 trillion in May 2025 to KSh 5.18 trillion in June 2025, while the broader money supply (M3) expanded by 1.60 per cent to KSh 6.45 trillion, as shown in Table 5 (a). The total gross foreign exchange reserves increased from KSh 2.19 trillion to KSh 2.29 trillion, while net foreign exchange liabilities rose from KSh 1.00 trillion to KSh 1.07 trillion, as shown in Table 5(b).





The volume of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange decreased from 3.2 thousand MT in April 2025 to 0.4 thousand MT in May 2025. Over the same period, the average auction price per kg increased from USD 6.37 to USD 6.97. The Nairobi Coffee Exchange was in recess in June 2025, as presented in Table 6.

Tea production decreased from 52.1 thousand MT in May 2025 to 42.4 thousand MT in June 2025. Similarly, the quantity of tea auctioned decreased from 33.4 thousand MT to 32.3 thousand MT. In contrast, the average auction price increased from USD 1.91 per kg in May 2025 to USD 2.01 per kg in June 2025. For the first half of 2025, the average auction price stood at USD 2.12 per kg compared to USD 2.20 per kg recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, as presented in Table 7.

The volume of cane deliveries increased from 383.1 thousand MT in May 2025 to 477.4 thousand MT in June 2025. Cumulatively, total deliveries for the first half of 2025 amounted to 3,617.5 thousand MT, a decrease from 4,573.7 thousand MT recorded in the corresponding period of 2024, as shown in Table 8. The average monthly retail market price of one kg of maize increased from KSh 61.0 in May 2025 to KSh 64.0 in June 2025, while the price of one kg of beans decreased from KSh 150.4 to KSh 148.7 during the same period, as shown in Tables 9(b) and 9(d).

The volume of coffee exports decreased from 7.4 thousand MT in May 2025 to 4.6 thousand MT in June 2025, with corresponding earnings decreasing from KSh 7.4 billion to KSh 4.5 billion. Similarly, the volume of tea exports decreased from 55.7 thousand MT to 46.9 thousand MT, while earnings decreased from KSh 15.4 billion to KSh 12.6 billion, as shown in Table 10.

Table 11 presents data on exports of fresh horticultural produce. The volume of cut-flower exports declined from 12.6 thousand MT in May 2025 to 10.7 thousand MT in June 2025, with corresponding earnings decreasing from KSh 7.9 billion to KSh 6.7 billion. Similarly, the volume of vegetable exports decreased from 6.5 thousand MT to 5.3 thousand MT, accompanied by a decline in earnings from KSh 1.9 billion to KSh 1.5 billion. In addition, the volume of fruit exports decreased from 26.0 thousand MT to 25.4 thousand MT, while earnings increased from KSh 4.6 billion to KSh 4.8 billion.





The total value of trade decreased from KSh 322.8 billion in May 2025 to KSh 313.2 billion in June 2025. During the same period, export earnings decreased from KSh 95.0 billion to KSh 85.2 billion, while the value of imports increased from KSh 227.8 billion to KSh 228.0 billion, as presented in Table 12.

In June 2025, Uganda, the United States of America, and the Netherlands were the leading export destinations, with export values amounting to KSh 11.0 billion, KSh 5.8 billion, and KSh 5.3 billion, respectively, as shown in Table 13(a). Food and beverages accounted for the largest share of total exports at 45.0 per cent, while non-food industrial supplies contributed 25.0 per cent and machinery and other capital equipment 1.7 per cent, as shown in Table 13(b).

The leading import partners in June 2025 were China, the United Arab Emirates, and India, with import values of KSh 55.1 billion, KSh 26.7 billion, and KSh 21.6 billion, respectively, as shown in Table 14(a). Non-food industrial supplies constituted the largest share of total imports at 36.2 per cent, followed by fuel and lubricants at 20.1 per cent, machinery and other capital equipment at 14.0 per cent, and food and beverages at 11.7 per cent, as shown in Table 14(b).

Table 14(c) presents data on the exports and imports of ICT equipment. The value of ICT exports decreased from KSh 150.6 million in May 2025 to KSh 87.5 million in June 2025. Notably, the export value of monitors, projectors, and reception apparatus increased more than fourfold to KSh 21.4 million in June 2025, from KSh 4.9 million in May 2025. The value of ICT imports increased from KSh 4.2 billion in May 2025 to KSh 7.6 billion in June 2025.

Table 14(d) presents trends in mobile money services. The number of active mobile money agents increased by 2.2 per cent, from 424,404 in May 2025 to 433,615 in June 2025. Over the same period, mobile money subscriptions (active, inactive, or dormant) decreased from 85.6 million to 84.2 million. The total number of transactions decreased from 214.5 million in May 2025 to 206.2 million in June 2025, while the total value of transactions decreased from KSh 713.3 billion to KSh 667.8 billion.

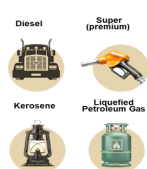




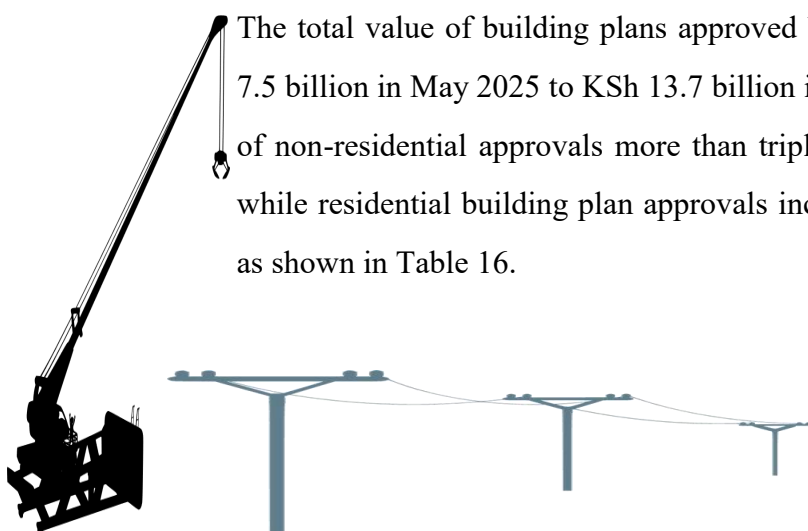
Local electricity generation decreased from 1,118.5 million kilowatt-hours (kWh) in May 2025 to 1,077.4 million kWh in June 2025. Geothermal energy was the leading source, generating 499.4 million kWh, followed by hydro generation at 287.1 million kWh. Notably, wind power generation increased by 46.9 per cent to 161.5 million kWh in June 2025, as shown in Table 15(a).

Total electricity generation and imports declined from 1,246.5 million kWh in May 2025 to 1,208.7 million kWh in June 2025. During the same period, electricity sales by KPLC increased from 1,030.7 million kWh to 1,090.9 million kWh. Electricity exports increased from 6.4 million kWh to 10.4 million kWh, while imports rose from 128.1 million kWh to 131.3 million kWh, as shown in Table 15(b).

Table 15(c) presents data on petroleum fuel consumption. Automotive Gas Oil (Light Diesel Oil) consumption decreased from 198.5 thousand MT in May 2025 to 185.3 thousand MT in June 2025. During the same period, Jet Fuel consumption decreased from 53.4 thousand MT to 53.0 thousand MT, Motor Spirit decreased from 135.9 thousand MT to 127.3 thousand MT, Illuminating Kerosene decreased from 3.7 thousand MT to 3.6 thousand MT, while Aviation Gasoline decreased from 1.6 thousand MT to 0.1 thousand MT.



In June 2025, the national average retail prices for petroleum fuels were KSh 178.19 per litre for motor gasoline premium, KSh 163.89 per litre for light diesel oil, and KSh 147.92 per litre for illuminating kerosene. The average retail price of charcoal was KSh 88.89 per kg, while a 13-kg LPG gas cylinder retailed at KSh 3,134.91, as shown in Table 15(e). On the international market, the OPEC crude oil basket price increased from USD 63.62 per barrel in May 2025 to USD 69.73 per barrel in June 2025, as presented in Table 15(f).



The total value of building plans approved by Nairobi City County increased from KSh 7.5 billion in May 2025 to KSh 13.7 billion in June 2025. Over the same period, the value of non-residential approvals more than tripled from KSh 0.7 billion to KSh 2.5 billion, while residential building plan approvals increased by 65.6 per cent to KSh 11.2 billion, as shown in Table 16.



Sugar production increased from 32.8 thousand MT in May 2025 to 38.3 thousand MT in June 2025, as shown in Table 17(a). Soft drink production decreased from 49.2 million litres to 41.0 million litres over the same period, as presented in Table 17(b).

The number of assembled vehicles decreased from 1,256 units in May 2025 to 1,080 units in June 2025, as shown in Table 17(c). Production of galvanized sheets increased from 25.7 thousand MT in May 2025 to 26.2 thousand MT in June 2025, as outlined in Table 17(d).

Cement production decreased from 845.0 thousand MT in May 2025 to 811.6 thousand MT in June 2025, as shown in Table 17(e). Similarly, cement consumption decreased from 829.6 thousand MT to 797.8 thousand MT over the same period, as shown in Table 17(e). Milk intake in the formal sector decreased from 94.5 million litres in May 2025 to 90.2 million litres in June 2025, as presented in Table 17(f).

Visitor arrivals through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA), Moi International Airport (MIA), and other border points increased from 171,269 in May 2025 to 211,609 in June 2025. During the same period, arrivals at MIA recorded the highest growth, increasing by 59.1 per cent to 11,330 visitors. Arrivals at JKIA increased by 28.5 per cent to 153,958, while arrivals through other border points increased by 4.5 per cent to 46,321, as shown in Table 18.

The number of passengers using the Standard Gauge Railway (SGR) increased from 183,359 in May 2025 to 226,717 in June 2025, with corresponding passenger service revenue increasing from KSh 325.9 million to KSh 373.9 million. The volume of cargo transported via the SGR grew from 586.0 thousand MT to 732.5 thousand MT. However, revenue from cargo services declined from KSh 1.6 billion to KSh 1.5 billion over the same period, as shown in Table 19(d). Passenger traffic on the Metre Gauge Railway (MGR) decreased from 225,899 in May 2025 to 202,715 in June 2025, with corresponding passenger service revenue decreasing from KSh 12.8 million to KSh 11.6 million, as presented in Table 19(e).

Table 19(f) presents data on cargo throughput at the Port of Mombasa. The total volume of cargo handled decreased from 3.8 million MT in May 2025 to 3.5 million MT in June 2025. During the same period, export volume increased from 413.1 thousand MT to 420.2 thousand MT, while import volume decreased from 3.1 million MT to 2.7 million MT. Transshipment volume increased from 269.8 thousand MT to 333.9 thousand MT, while restows decreased from 23.6 thousand MT to 17.2 thousand MT.

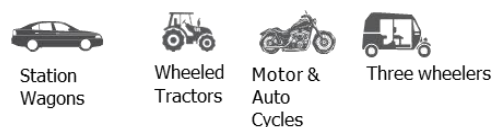

Figure 2: Mean Monthly Foreign Exchange Rates of Kenya Shillings against Selected Major Currencies

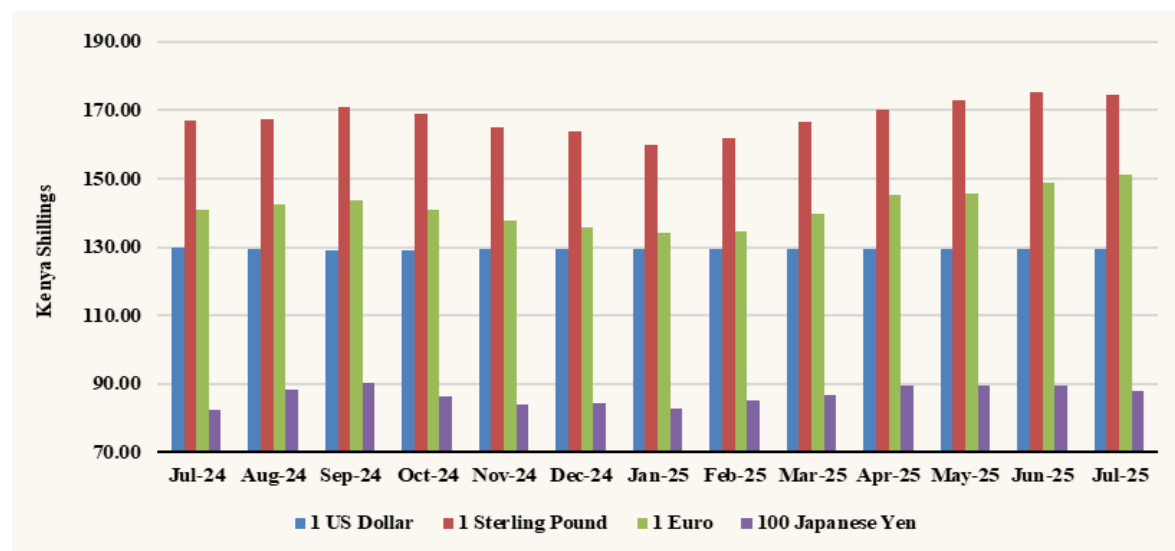

Figure 4: Coffee Sales at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange

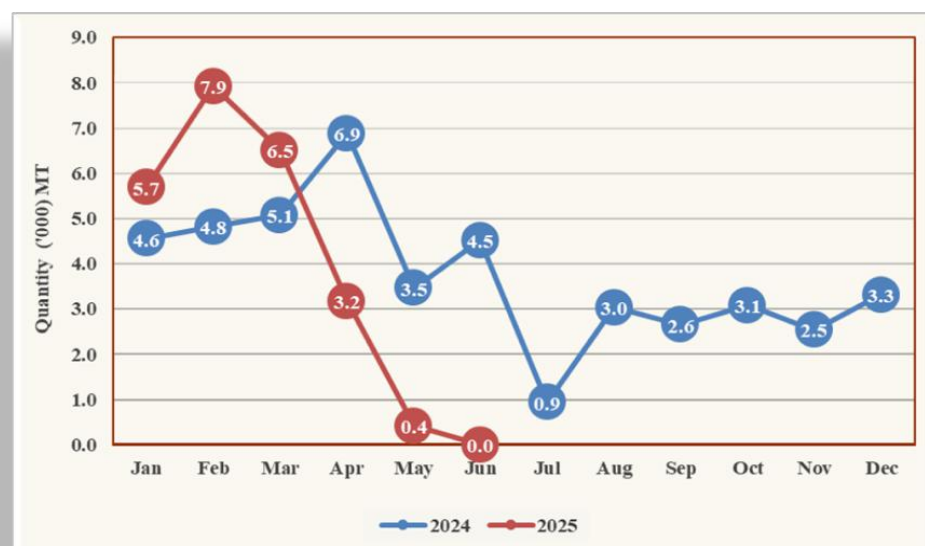

Figure 5: Tea Production

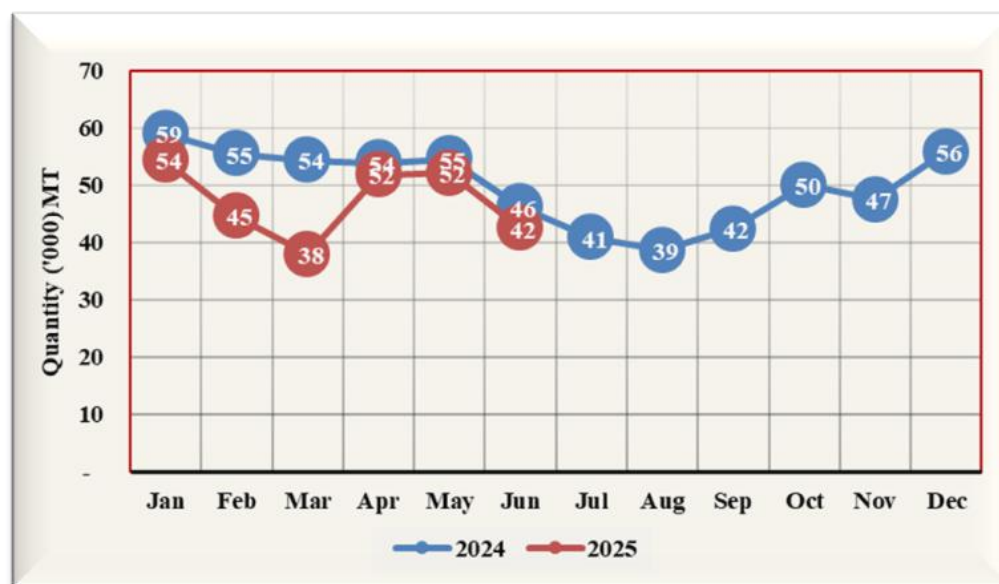

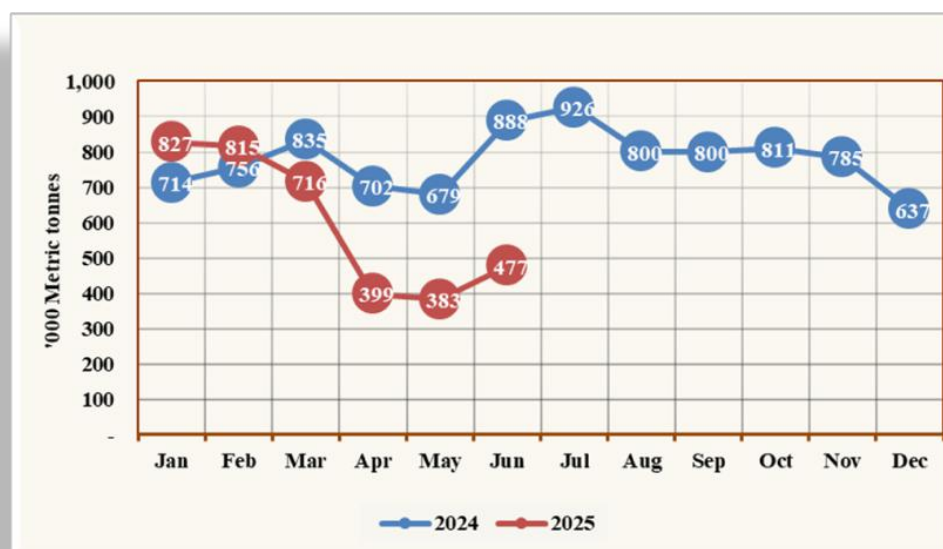
Figure 6: Cane Deliveries

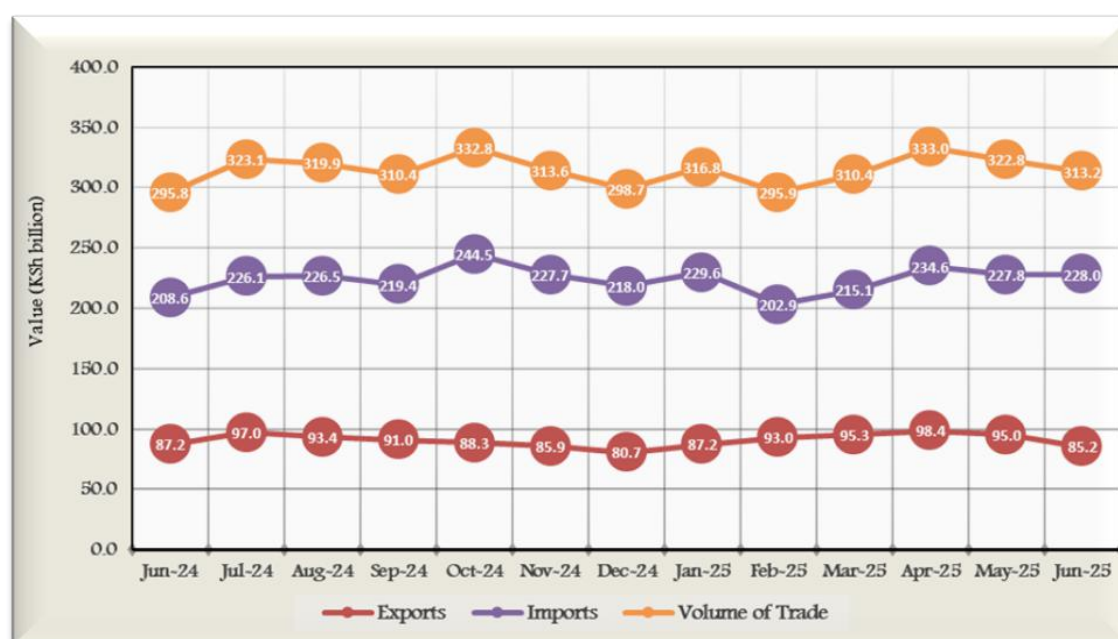
Figure 7: Monthly External Trade Performance

Figure 8: Electricity Generation by Source

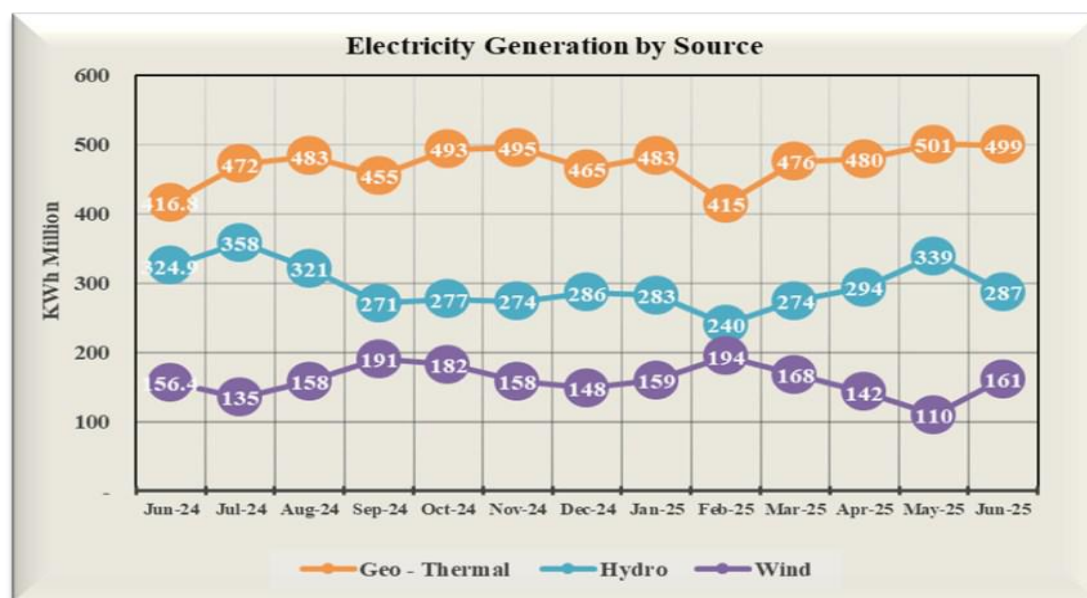

Figure 10: Sugar Production

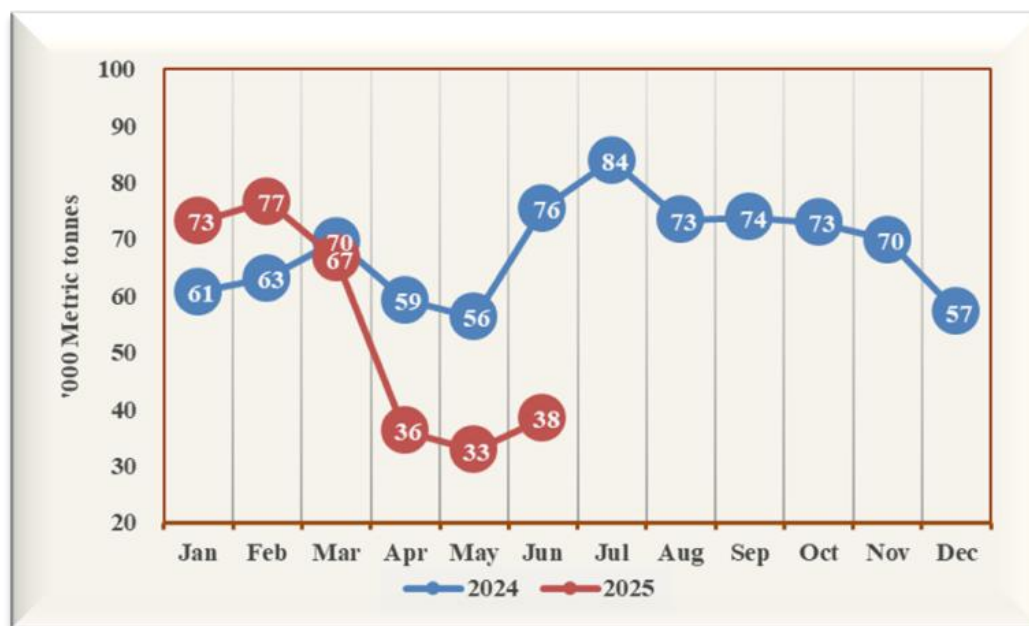

Figure 11: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector

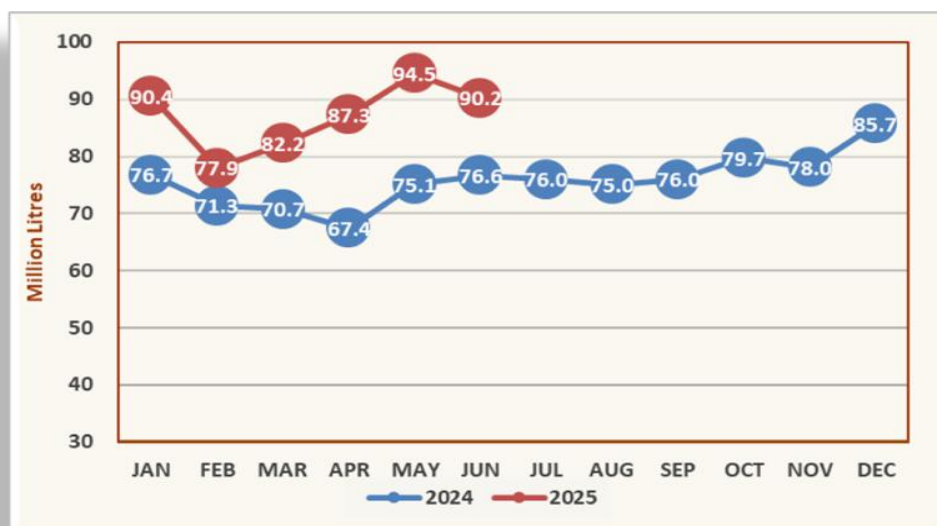

Figure 12: Visitor Arrivals through JKIA, MIA and Other Borders

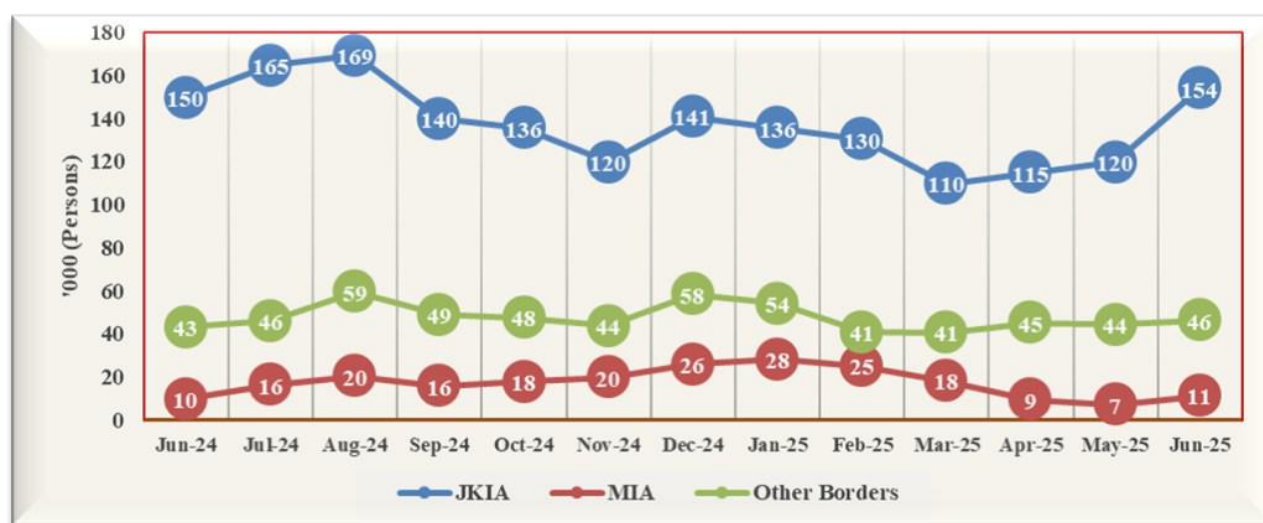
