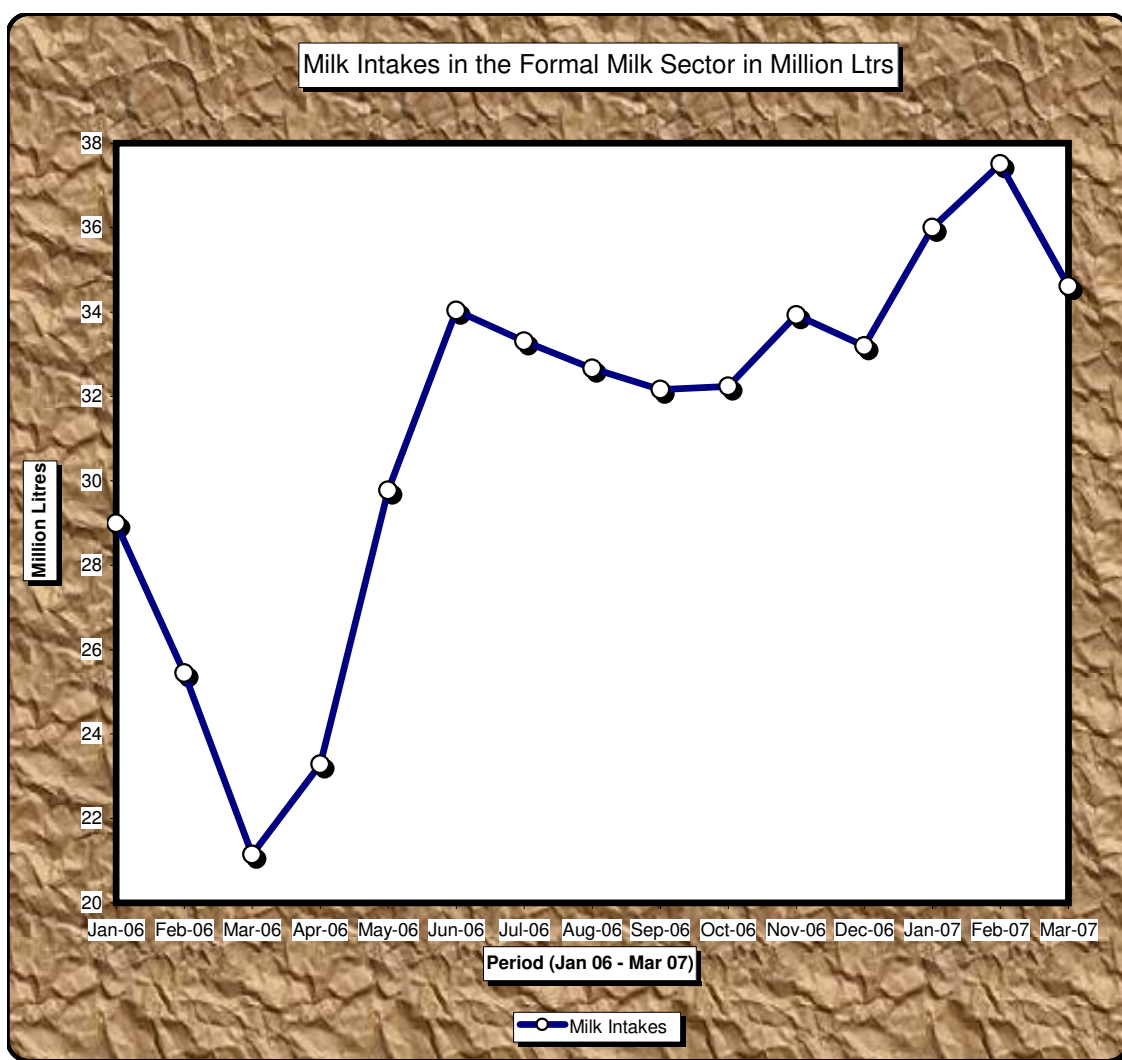

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Key highlights on Leading Economic Indicators

Overview

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators Publication for April 2007 highlight trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

Macroeconomic Indicators and Financial Intermediation

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 0.8 per cent from 223.6 points in February 2007 to 225.3 points in March 2007. Month-on-month overall inflation rate decelerated from 6.8 per cent in February 2007 to 5.9 per cent in March 2007. On the other hand, month-on-month underlying inflation rate which excludes food items from the CPI basket remained at 6.1 per cent in March 2007 as the previous month.

The Kenyan Shilling appreciated against all the major international currencies and the Tanzanian Shilling in March 2007. It weakened against the Ugandan Shilling in the same period. The Shilling appreciated against the US Dollar to trade at KSh 68.781 in March 2007 compared to KSh 69.733 in February 2007. The Shilling strengthened against the other international currencies to close the month at KSh 135.004 to the Sterling Pound, KSh 91.766 to the Euro, KSh 58.444 to 100 Japanese Yen and KSh 9.594 to the South Africa Rand. The shilling weakened against the Ugandan Shilling to trade at KSh 25.3721 in March 2007 compared to KSh 24.903 in February 2007.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, rose marginally from a rate of 6.22 per cent in February 2007 to 6.32 per cent in March 2007. The weighted average lending rate given by Commercial banks for loans and advances declined further by a marginal 0.08 percentage points from 13.64 per cent in February 2007 to 13.56 per cent in March 2007. Savings rate rose marginally to close at 1.43 per cent in March 2007 compared to 1.41 per cent in February 2007.

The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) declined further by 4.7 per cent from 5,387.3 points in February 2007 to 5,133.7 points in March. The value of shares traded also declined further by 10.3 per cent from KSh 7.8 billion in February 2007 to KSh 7.0 billion in March 2007. The number of shares traded rose by 4.7 per cent from 109,081 thousand shares in February 2007 to 114,218 thousand shares in March 2007. The decline in the value of shares while the number of shares went up may be attributed to the decline in the average value of each share in March 2007 compared to February 2007.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded by 2.5 per cent from KSh 659.9 billion in February 2007 to KSh 676.3 billion in March 2007. Money and Quasi-Money (M2) expanded by 2.6 per cent in March 2007 compared to an expansion of 5.9 per cent in February 2007 to stand at KSh 577.9 billion.

Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded by 2.6 per cent from KSh 236.6 billion in February 2007 to KSh 242.6 billion while Net Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded by 2.3 per cent over the same period to stand at KSh 221.1 billion.

SECTORAL PERFORMANCES

a). Agriculture

Quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange declined by 3.8 per cent from 4,548 MT in January 2007 to 4,377 MT in February 2007 while its average auction price rose from KSh 201 per kilogram to KSh 211 per kilogram over the same period.

Quantity of processed tea declined significantly by 16.3 per cent from 41,606 MT in January 2007 to 34,839 MT in February 2007 while its auction price declined by KSh 3.82 from KSh 125.39 per kilogram in January 2007 to KSh 121.57 per kilogram in February 2007.

Average price for dry maize rose marginally from KSh 17.23 per kilogramme in January 2007 to KSh 17.28 per kilogramme in February 2007 while average price for dry beans declined from KSh 38.04 per Kilogram to KSh 37.96 per kilogramme in the same period.

b). International Trade

Quantity of coffee exported rose significantly by 37.6 per cent from 2,462.4 MT in January 2007 to 3,388.2 MT in February 2007 while its value rose by 44.4 per cent from KSh 452.6 million to KSh 479.4 million over the same period.

Quantity of tea exported rose further by 1.9 per cent from 35,974.2 MT in January 2007 to 36,657.9 MT in February 2007 while its value declined by 1.5 per cent from KSh 4,704.5 million to KSh 4,635.4 million over the same period.

Quantity of horticultural produce exported rose marginally by 0.33 per cent from 44,359 MT in the first quarter of 2006 to 44,501 MT in the same quarter of 2007. Export value of horticultural produce rose significantly by 77.1 per cent over the same period to stand at KSh 17,744.2 million in the first quarter of 2007. The increase in value of horticultural produce can be attributed to a high increase in the value of cut flowers in March 2007.

Volume of trade rose by 17.3 per cent from KSh 69,171.87 million in January 2007 to stand at KSh 81,133.95 in February 2007. Total Exports rose by 16.0 per cent from KSh 20,877.68 million in January 2007 to KSh 81,133.95 in February 2007 while total imports rose by 17.9 per cent to stand at KSh 56,917.28 million over the same period.

Food and Beverages with a share of 32.0 per cent was the main domestic exports for the country with a value of KSh 97.8 billion in 2006. Transport equipment, consumer goods not elsewhere specified and Non-food industrial supplies contributed 26.15, 20.78 and 17.60 per cent respectively to the total value of domestic exports which stood at KSh 305.2 billion in 2006.

Imports by Broad Economic Category saw Non-food industrial supply contribute 30.85 per cent of the total import bill which stood at KSh 521.5 billion in 2006 up from KSh 443.1 billion in 2005. Contribution by main categories in 2006 included; fuel and lubricants at 23.90 per cent, transport equipment at 18.34 per cent and, machinery and other equipments at 13.76 per cent.

c). Energy

Total electricity generation rose by 9.2 per cent from 1,417.5 million KWh in the first quarter of 2006 to 1,548.1 million KWh in the same quarter of 2007. Total domestic generation of electricity also rose by 9.2 per cent from 1,414.3 million KWh in the first quarter of 2006 to stand at 1,544.5 million KWh in the same quarter of 2007. Total domestic consumption of electricity rose by 6.8 per cent from 1,148.7 million KWh in the first quarter of 2006 to 1,226.8 million KWh in the same quarter of 2007. Power losses stood at 302.9 million KWh in the first quarter of 2007 compared to 262.8 million KWh in the first quarter of 2006.

Exports of electricity to Uganda stood at 18.4 million KWh in the first quarter of 2007 compared to 6.0 million KWh in the same quarter of 2006 while total electricity imports from Uganda and Tanzania stood at 3.6 million KWh in the first quarter of 2007 compared to 3.2 million KWh in the same quarter of 2006.

Total consumption of petroleum products rose by 5.4 per cent from 2,664.5 thousand MT in 2005 to 2,807.3 thousand MT in 2006.

In the domestic market, average retail prices for motor gasoline, light diesel oil and illuminating kerosene in Kenya declined marginally in March 2007 compared to February 2007. Motor gasoline was retailing at KSh 77.71 per litre in March 2007 compared to KSh 77.83 per litre in February 2007 while illuminating kerosene sold at KSh 55.99 per litre in March 2007 compare to KSh 56.14 per litre in February 2007.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil rose by 5.7 per cent from US Dollars 58.75 per barrel in February 2007 to US Dollars 62.10 per barrel in March 2007.

d). Manufacturing and, building and construction

Output of processed sugar rose by 25.9 per cent from 33,509 MT in December 2006 to 42,188 MT in January 2007. Production of soft drinks rose by 8.7 per cent from 257,024 MT in 2005 to 279,407 MT in 2006.

Quantity of cement produced declined by 8.5 per cent from 195,165 MT in December 2006 to 178,604 MT in January 2007. Consumption of cement rose 2.7 per cent to stand at 423,178 MT in the first quarter of 2007 up from 412,216 MT in the same quarter of 2006.

Milk deliveries in the formal milk sector rose significantly by 43.0 per cent to stand at 108.1 trillion litres in the first quarter of 2007 compared to 75.6 trillion litres in the same quarter of 2006.

e). Tourism and Transport

Number of visitors who arrived through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airports increased marginally from 99,002 visitors recorded in December 2006 to 99,602 visitors in January 2007.

The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) declined by 10.2 per cent from 136,700 persons in January 2007 to 122,713 persons in February 2007 while passengers who landed at the airport declined by 5.3 per cent from 130,794 persons to 123,898 persons over the same period.

Total number of vehicles registered declined by 30.8 per cent from 7,086 vehicles registered in January 2007 to 4,906 vehicles in February 2007.

FIG. 1: OVERALL MONTH ON MONTH AND UNDERLYING INFLATION RATES

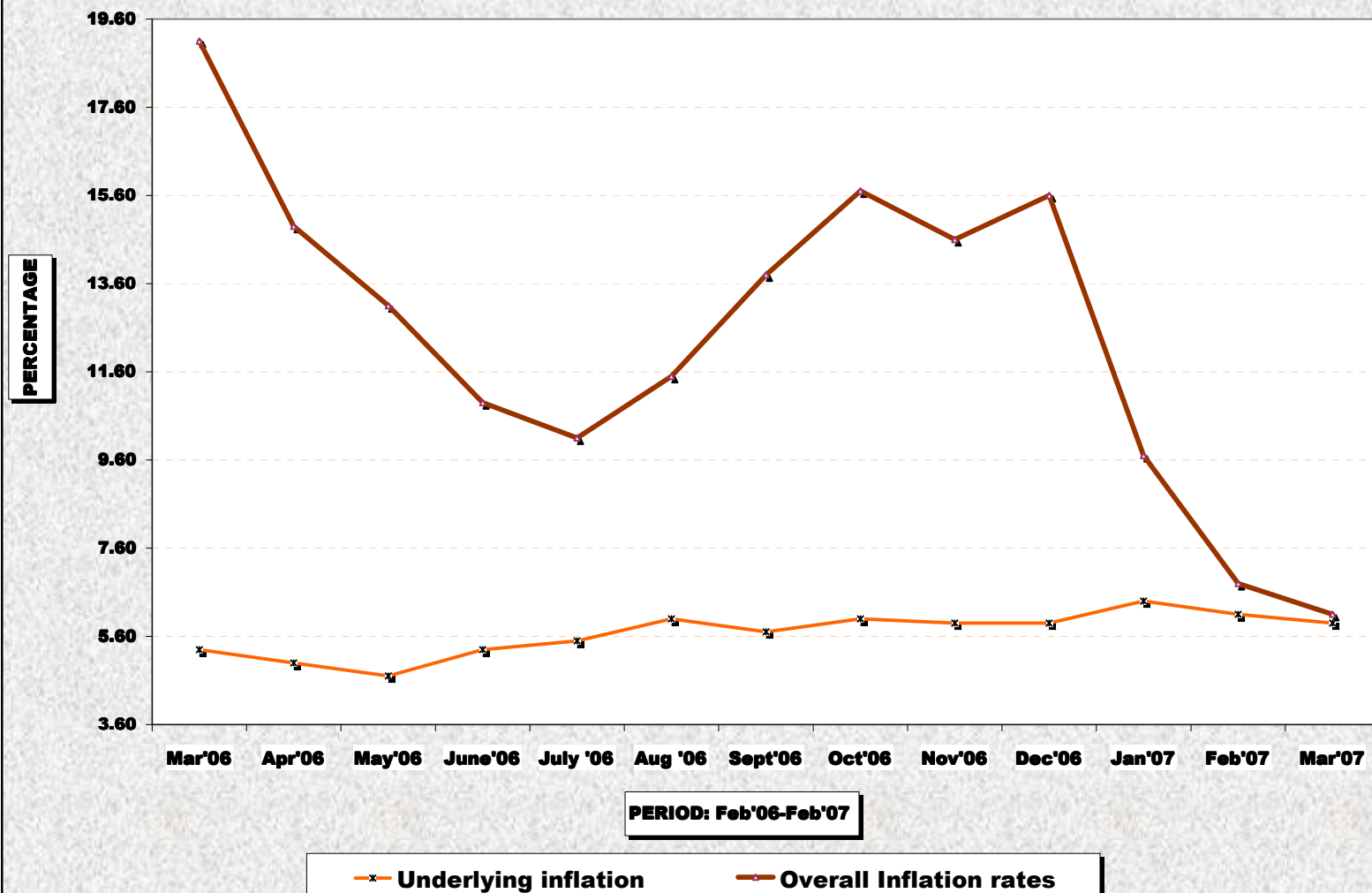

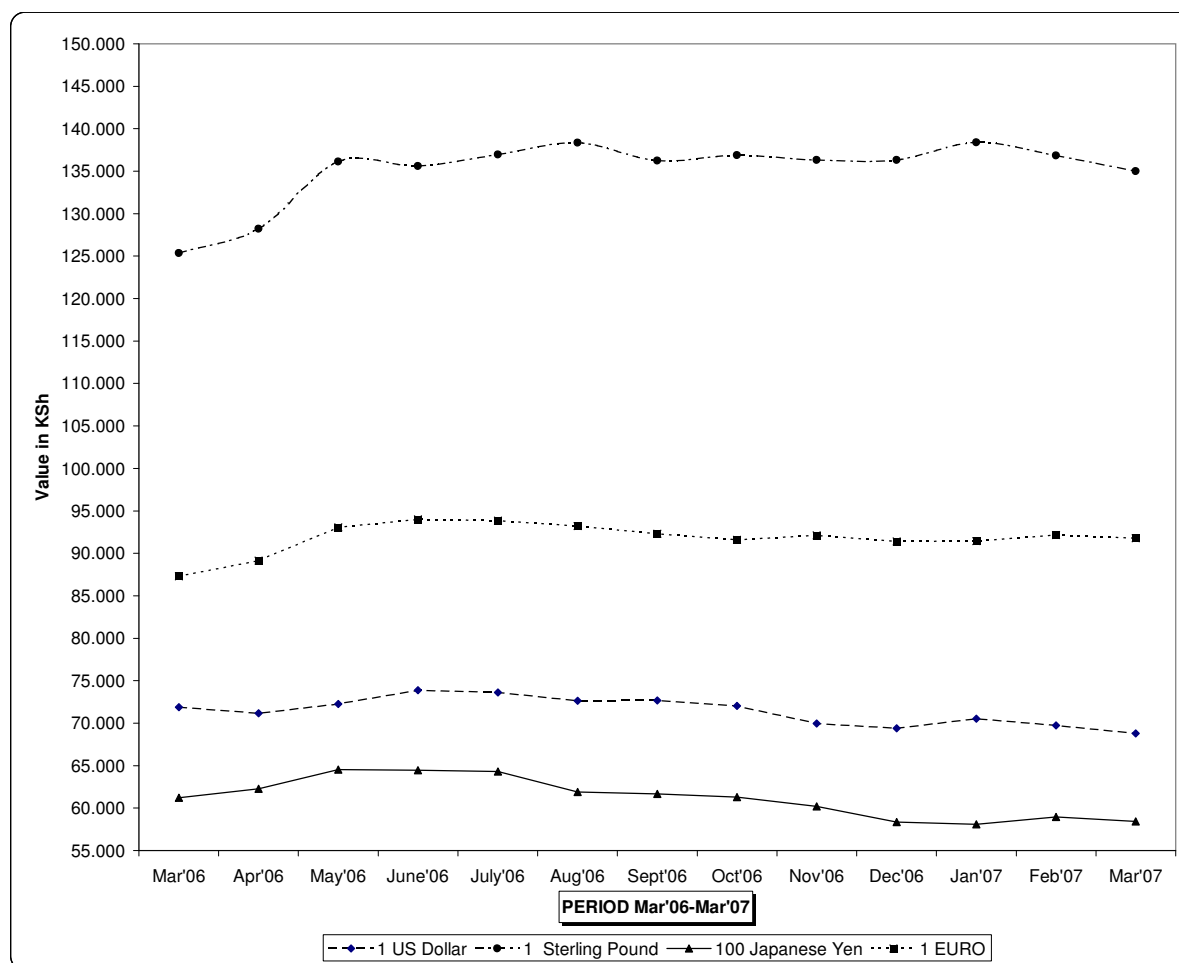

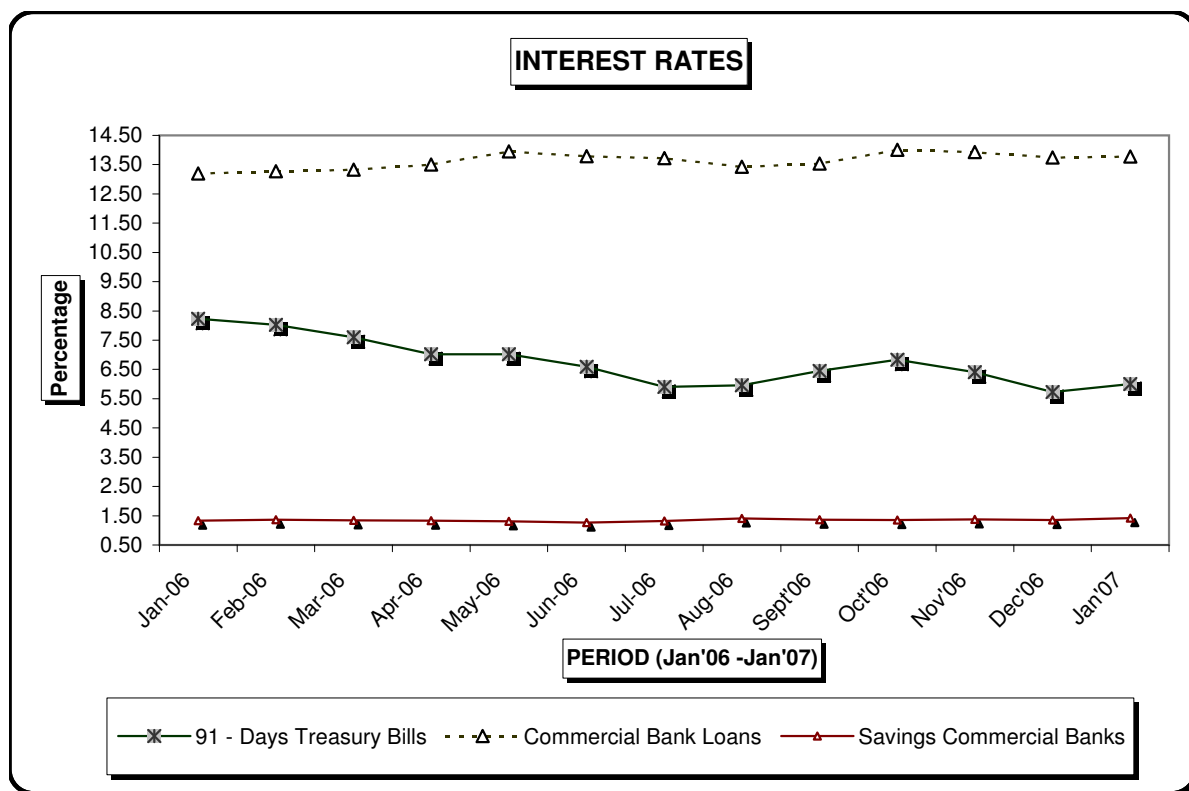

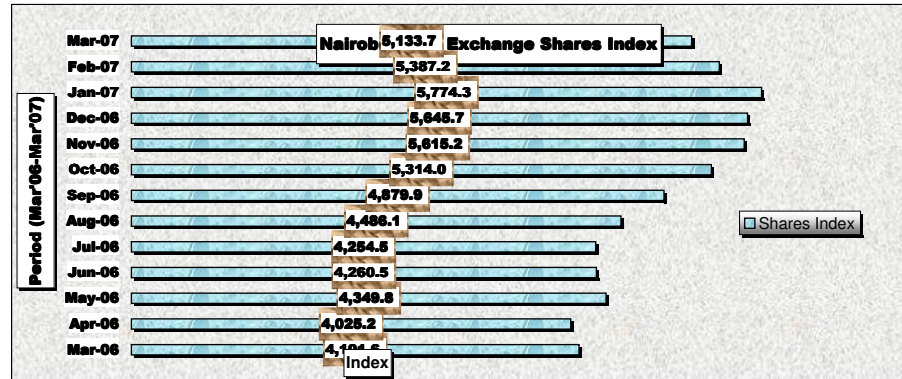

FIG. 5 Money Supply (M3)

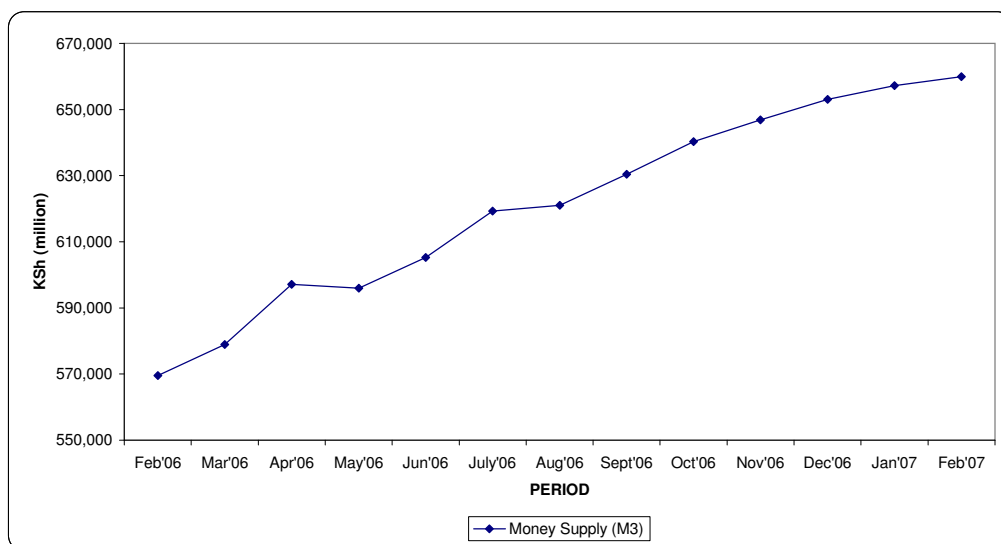

FIG. 6 FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

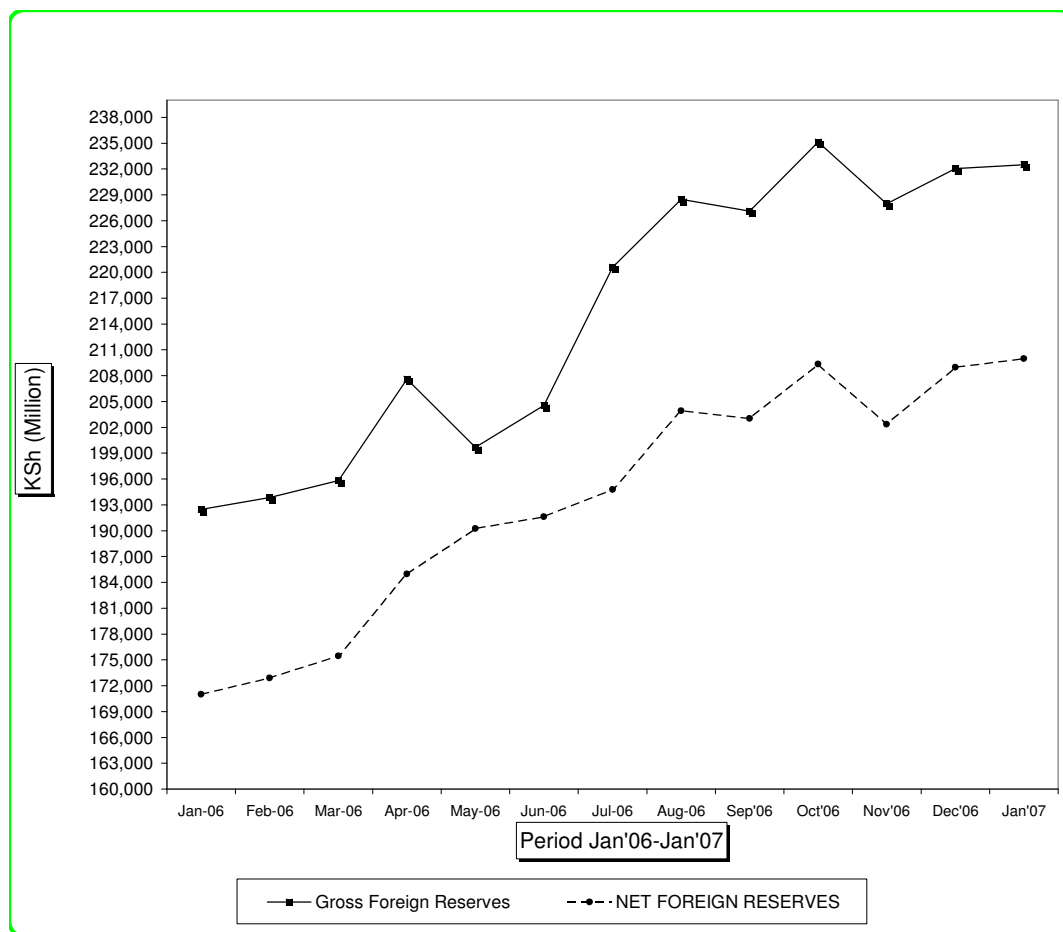

FIG 7: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE ,MARCH '06-MARCH '07

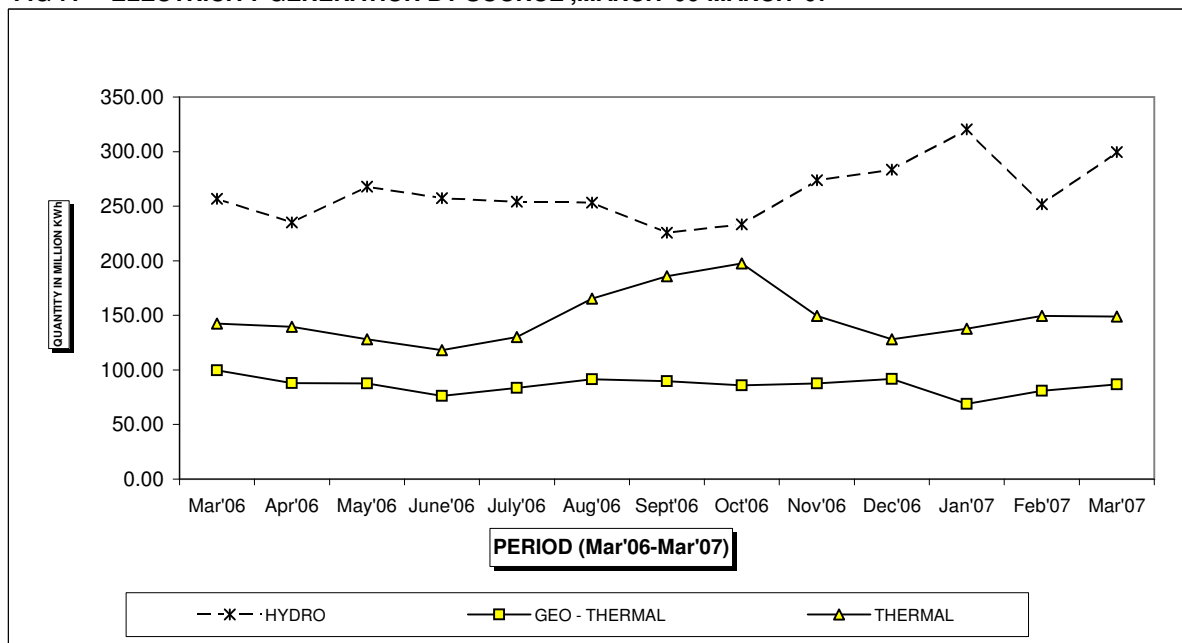

FIG 8: ELECTRICITY GENERATION , CONSUMPTION & POWER LOSSES.

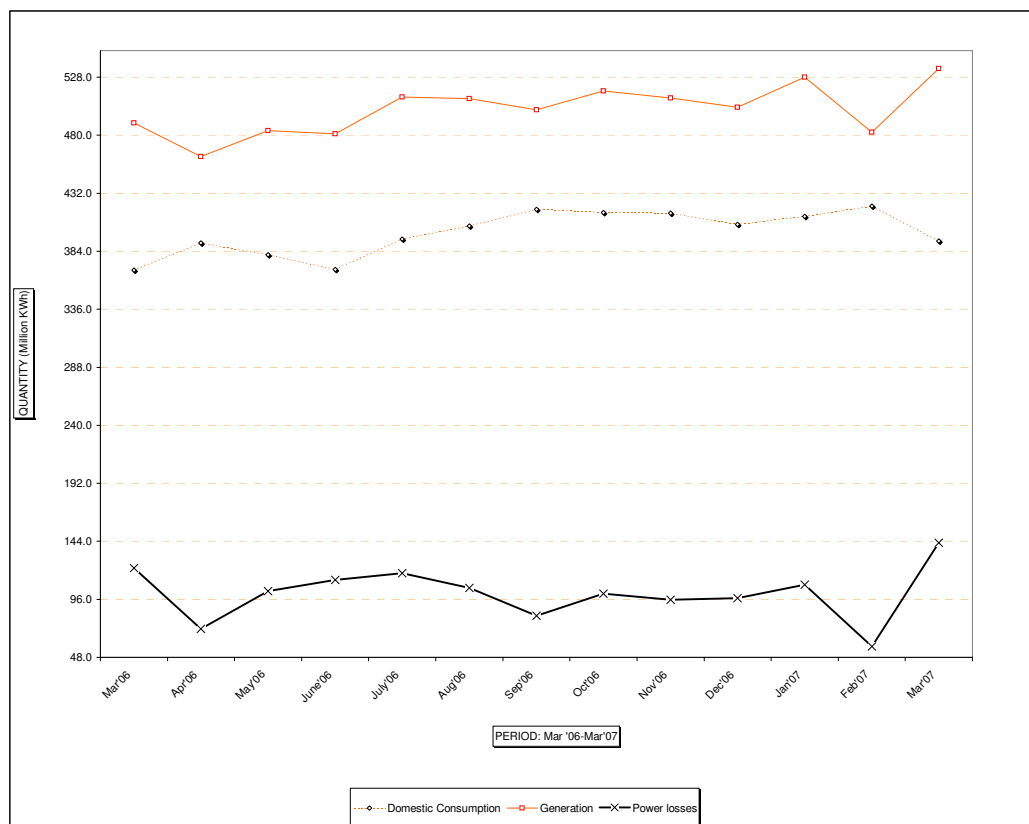

FIG 9(a): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS WITHIN NAIROBI

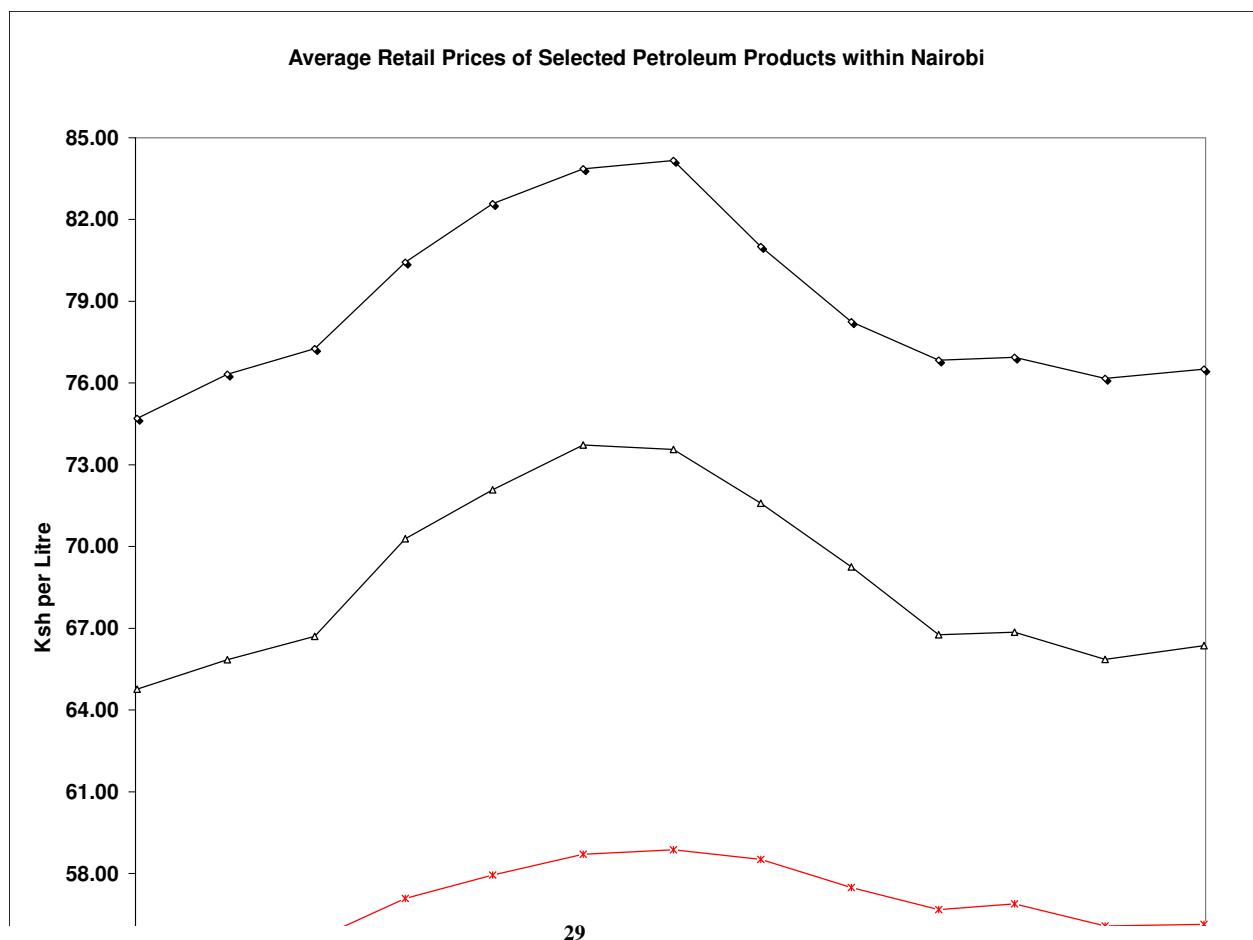

FIG 9(b): WEIGHTED AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

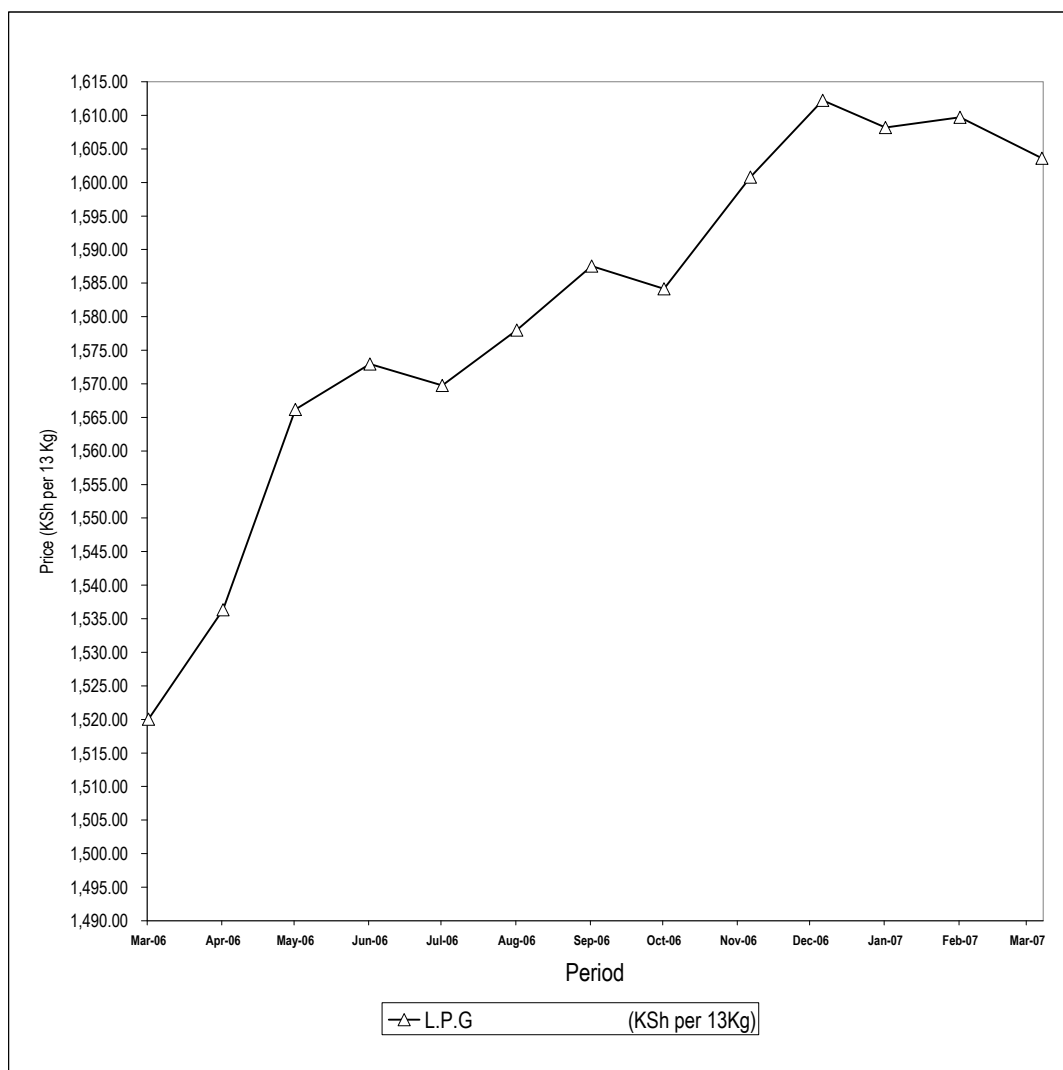

Fig10: TREND FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES (Mar'06-Mar'07)

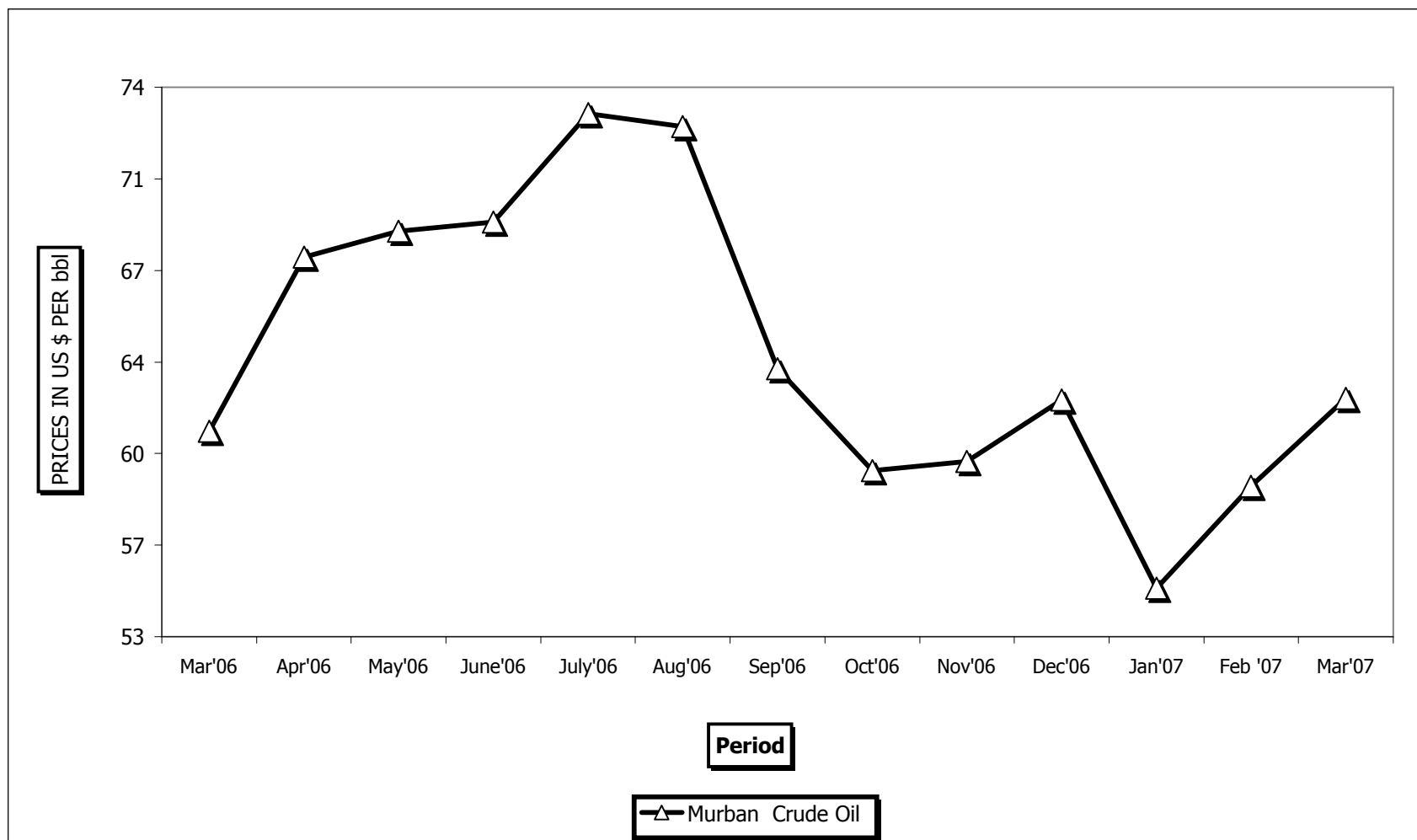

Fig10: TREND FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES (Mar'06-Mar'07)

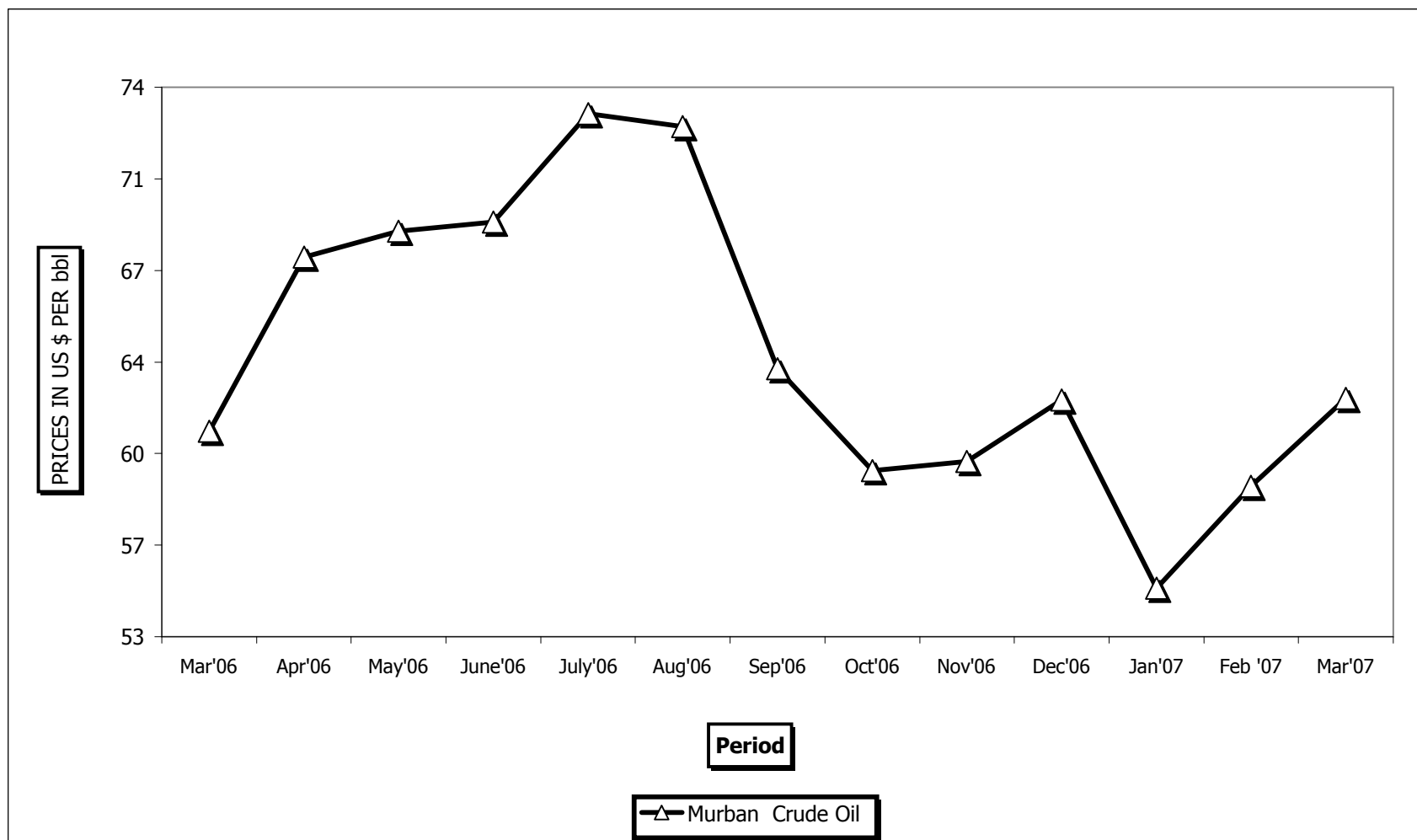

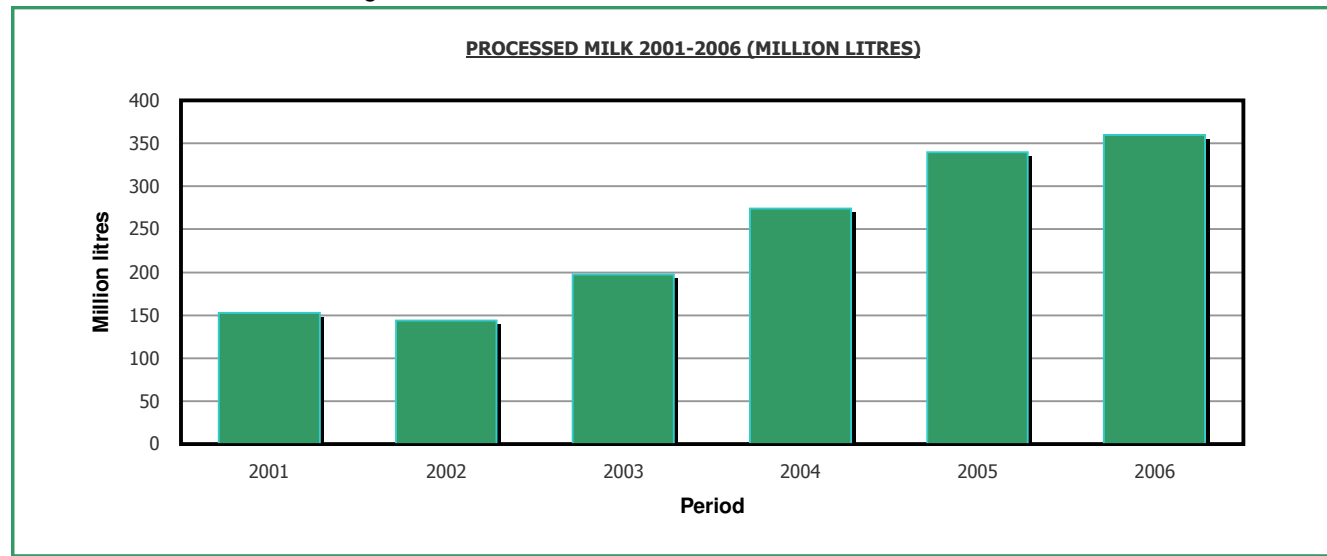

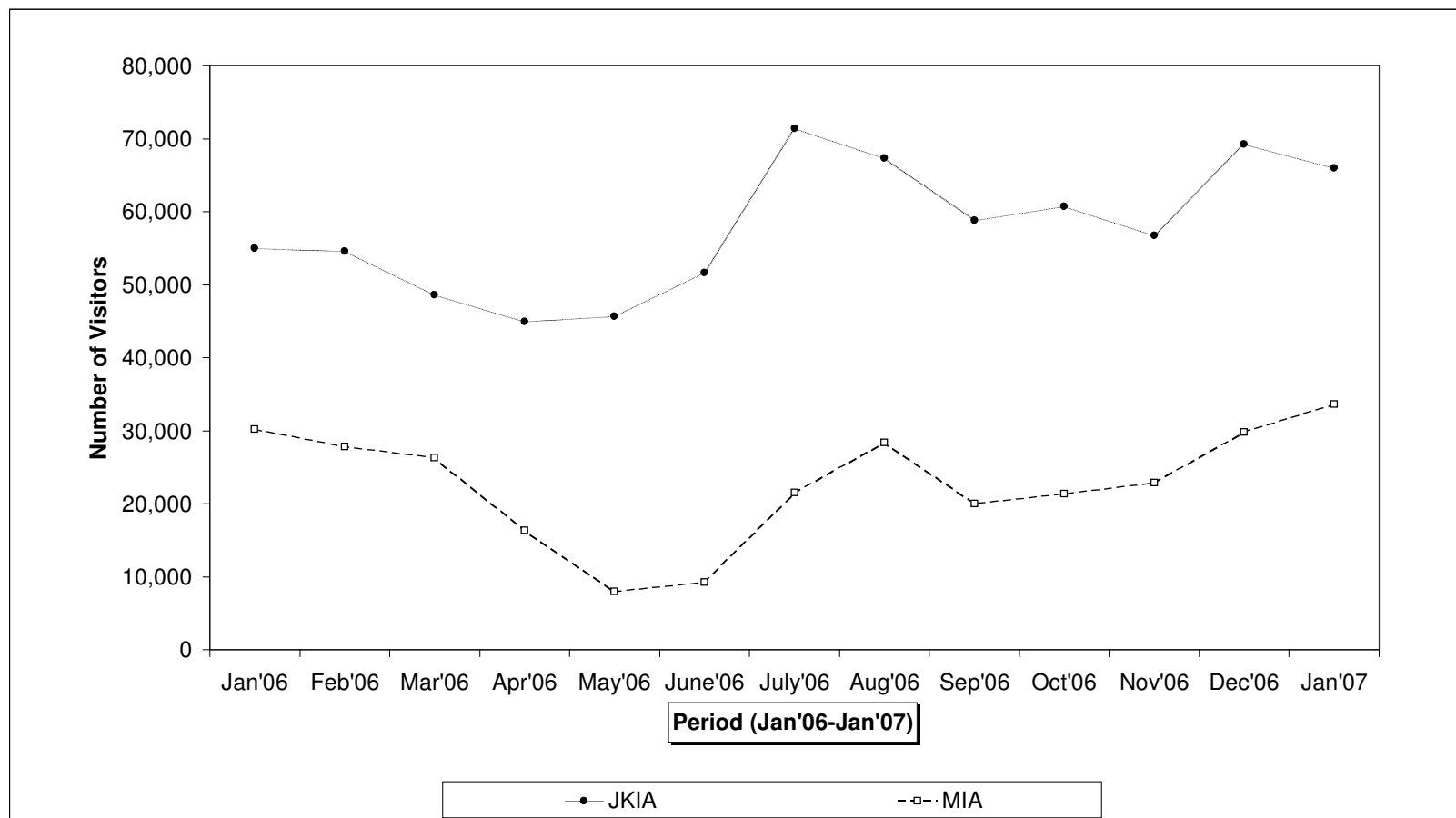

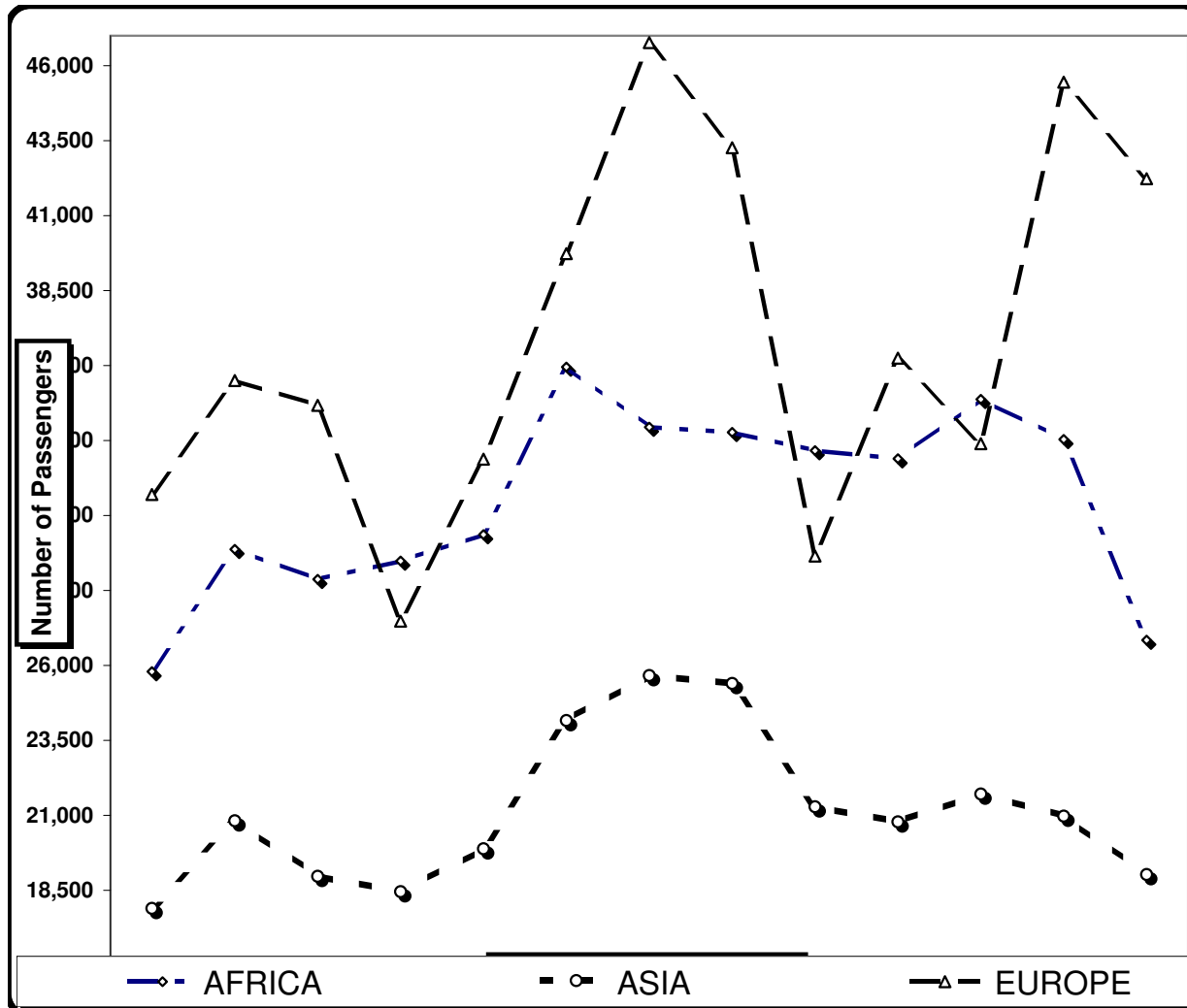

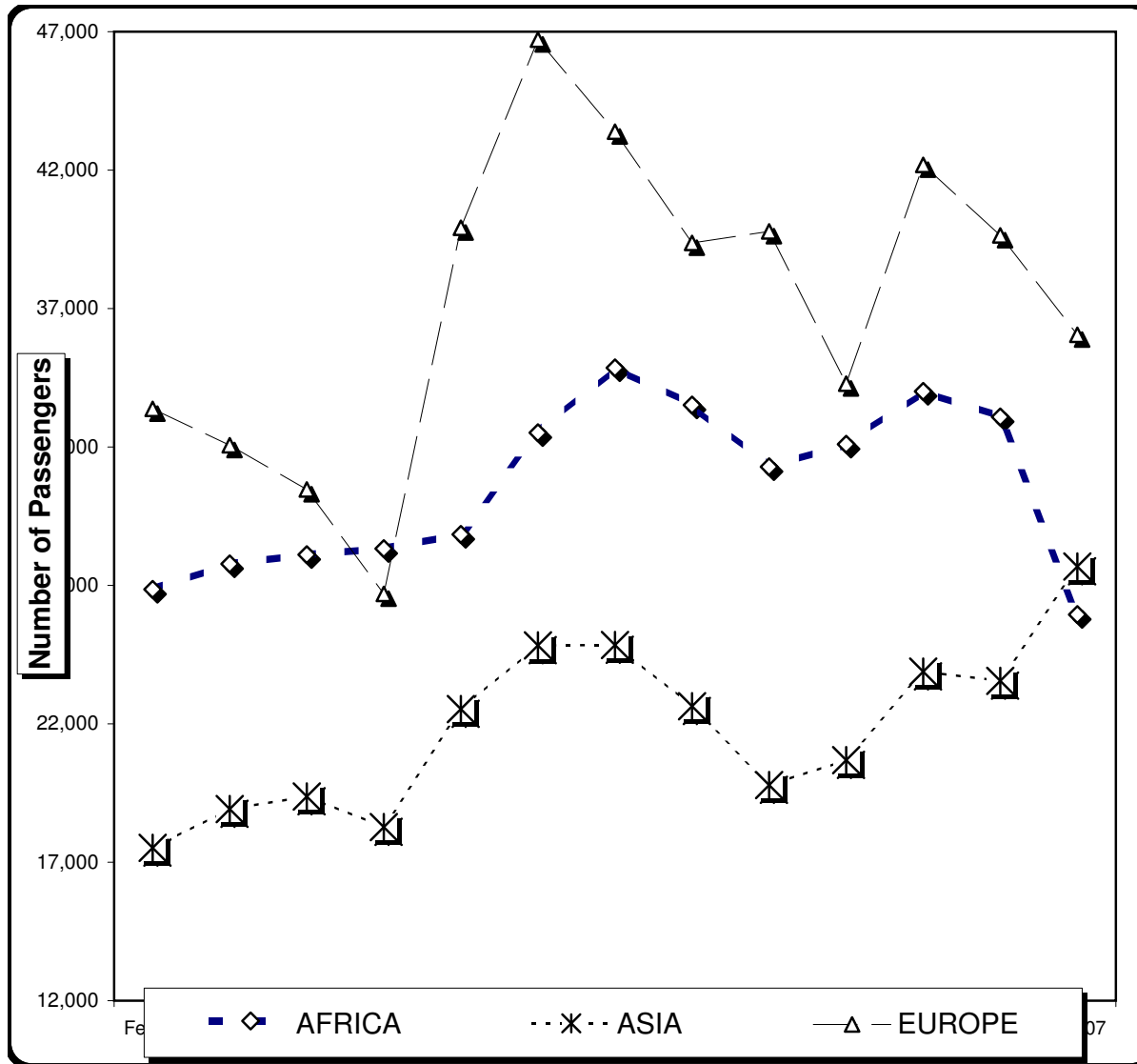
