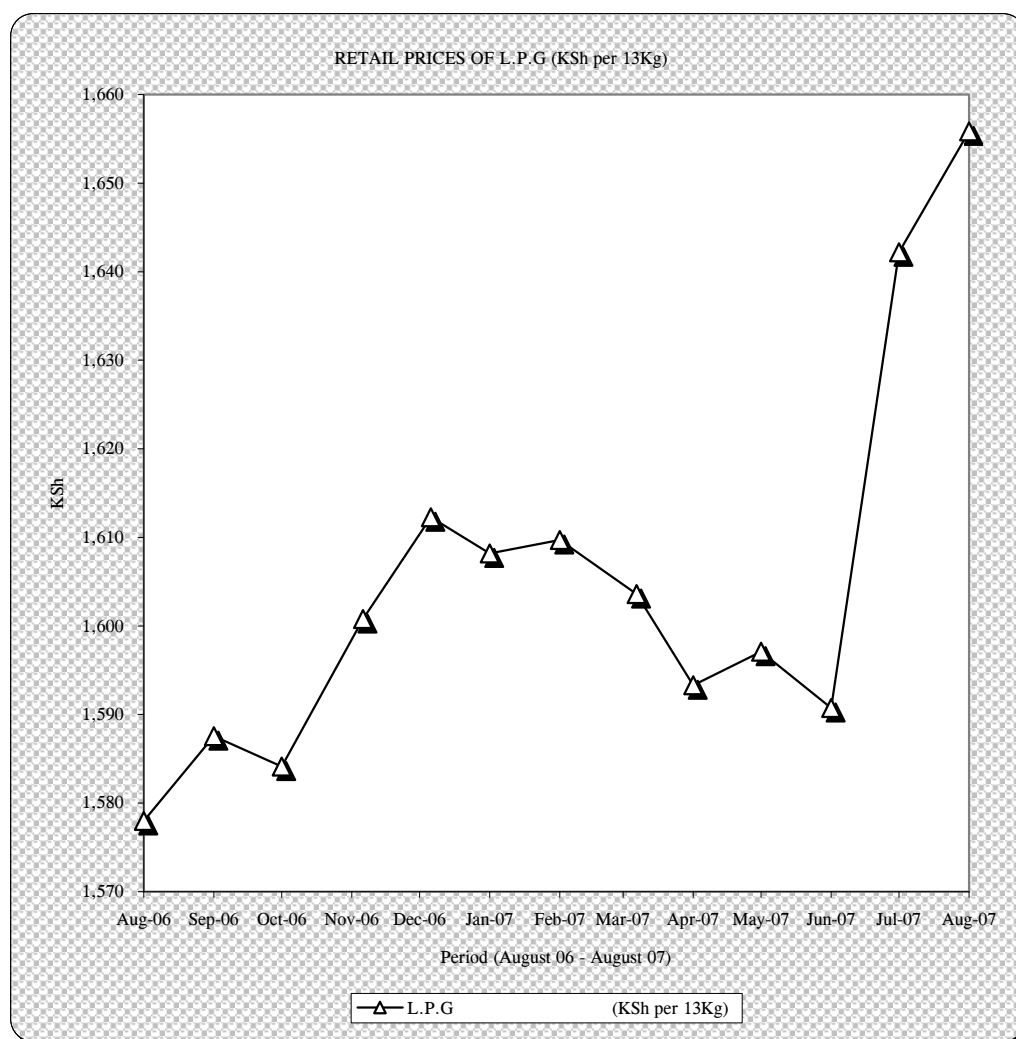

Key highlights on Leading Economic Indicators

Overview

The monthly Leading Economic Indicators Publication for August 2007 highlight trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

Macroeconomic Indicators and Financial Intermediation

Consumer Price Index (CPI) declined by 0.3 per cent from 226.6 points in July 2007 to 225.8 points in August 2007. Month-on-month overall inflation rate decelerated from 13.6 per cent in July 2007 to 12.4 per cent in August 2007. On the other hand, month-on-month underlying inflation rate which excludes food items from the CPI basket also declined from 5.6 per cent in July 2007 to 5.2 per cent in August 2007.

The Kenyan Shilling depreciated against all the major international currencies at the close of July 2007. The Shilling weakened against the US Dollar, the Sterling Pound, the Euro, Japanese Yen and the South Africa Rand in July 2007 to trade at KSh 67.509, KSh 136.985, KSh 92.476, KSh 56.821 and KSh 9.476, respectively. The Shilling appreciated against the Ugandan Shilling and the Tanzanian Shilling to trade at KSh 24.671 and KSh 18.872 in July 2007, respectively.

The benchmark 91-day Treasury bills declined further from 6.53 per cent in June 2007 to 6.52 per cent in July 2007. The weighted average lending rate by Commercial banks for loans and advances rose by 0.15 percentage points from 13.14 per cent in June 2007 to 13.29 per cent in July 2007. Savings rate rose marginally from 1.54 per cent in June 2007 to 1.65 per cent in July 2007.

The Nairobi Stock Exchange share index (NSE 20) accrued marginally by 2.9 per cent from 5,001.8 points in May 2007 to 5,146.7 points in June 2007. However, the value of shares traded declined by 2.3 per cent from KSh 6.22 billion in May 2007 to 6.08 billion in June 2007. The number of shares traded increased by 22.2 per cent from 123,724 thousand shares in May 2007 to 151,130 thousand shares in June 2007.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, expanded marginally by 0.7 per cent from KSh 708.1 billion in June 2007 to KSh 713.4 billion in July 2007 while money and quasi-money (M2) expanded by 1.4 per cent to stand at KSh 616.4 billion in July 2007.

Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded by 4.1 per cent from KSh 251.6 billion in June 2007 to KSh 262.2 billion in July 2007. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves also expanded by 2.8 per cent from KSh 223.5 billion to KSh 229.8 billion over the same period.

SECTORAL PERFORMANCES

a). Agriculture

Quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange declined further by 14.3 per cent from 5,451 MT in June 2007 to 4,669 MT in July 2007. The average auction price also declined further from KSh 145.61 per kilogram to KSh 141.77 per kilogram over the same period.

Quantity of processed tea rose significantly by 48.2 per cent from 134,134 MT in the first half of 2006 to 198,781 MT in the same half of 2007 while its average auction price declined from KSh 154.36 per kilogram to KSh 117.49 per kilogram over the same period.

Average price for dry maize declined from KSh 16.26 per kilogram in April 2007 to KSh 15.89 per kilogram in May 2007 while average price for dry beans rose from KSh 38.26 per Kilogram to KSh 38.31 per kilogram over the same period.

b). International Trade

Quantity of coffee exported rose by 3.8 per cent from 27,247.3 MT in the first half of 2006 to 28,274.5 MT in the same half of 2007 while its value declined by 1.2 per cent from KSh 5,664.3 million to KSh 5,598.5 million over the same period.

Quantity of tea exported rose significantly by 35.1 per cent from 151,662 MT in the first half of 2006 to 204,943.2 MT in the same half of 2007 while its value also

increased by 17.4 per cent from KSh 22,001.5 million to KSh 25,821.5 million over the same period.

Quantity of horticultural produce exported rose by 5.8 per cent from 85,578 MT in the first half of 2006 to 90,502 MT in the same half of 2007. Export value of horticultural produce rose significantly by 57.0 per cent from KSh 19,863.9 million to KSh 31,177.4 million over the same period. The increase in value of horticultural produce can be attributed to a high increase in the value of cut flowers.

Volume of trade rose by 17.6 per cent from KSh 368.3 billion in the first half of 2006 to KSh 433.3 billion in the same half of 2007. Total exports rose by 16.6 per cent from KSh 117.4 billion in the first half of 2006 to KSh 136.9 billion in the same half of 2007 while imports rose by 18.1 per cent from KSh 250.9 billion to KSh 296.3 billion over the same period.

Exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) show Food and Beverages with a share of 41.4 per cent of the total exports being the main domestic exports for the country with a value of KSh 8,132.6 million in April 2007. Consumer goods not elsewhere specified, Transport equipment and Fuel and lubricants contributed 28.86, 23.79 and 3.11 per cent, respectively to the total value of domestic exports.

Imports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) show Non-food industrial supply contribute 37.9 per cent of the total import bill which stood at KSh 43,589.49 million in April 2007. Major contributors by main categories in April 2007 included; machinery and other equipments, fuel and lubricants, transport equipment, Consumer goods not elsewhere specified and food and beverages at 17.7, 16.3, 10.8, 9.0 and 8.2 per cent, respectively.

c). Energy

Total electricity generation declined marginally by 0.4 per cent from 543.6 million KWh in June 2007 to 541.6 million KWh in July 2007 while total domestic electricity generation also declined marginally by 0.4 per cent from 541.9 million KWh in July 2007 to 539.3 million KWh in July 2007. Total domestic consumption of electricity declined by 4.3 per cent from 435.0 million KWh in June 2007 to 416.2 million KWh

in July 2007. Power losses rose by 15.7 per cent from 102.6 million KWh in June 2007 to 118.7 million KWh in July 2007.

Exports of electricity to Uganda rose by 10.9 per cent from 6.04 million KWh in June 2007 to 6.71 million KWh in July 2007 while total imports of electricity from Uganda and Tanzania also rose from 1.7 million KWh in June 2007 to 2.3 million KWh in July 2007.

Total consumption of petroleum products declined marginally by 2.4 per cent from 1,378.0 thousand MT in the first half of 2006 to 1,344.5 thousand MT in the same half of 2007.

In the domestic market, average retail prices for motor gasoline, light diesel oil and illuminating kerosene in Kenya were higher in August 2007 compared to July 2007. Motor gasoline, light diesel oil and illuminating kerosene retailed at KSh 80.00 per litre, KSh 68.17 per litre and KSh 57.58 per litre in August 2007 compared to KSh 79.74 per litre, KSh 68.15 per litre and KSh 57.32 per litre in July 2007, respectively. The price of LPG has been in an upward trend since June 2007 due to reported shortages.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil declined by 2.6 per cent from US Dollars 73.70 per barrel in July 2007 to US Dollars 71.75 per barrel in August 2007.

d). Manufacturing and, building and construction

Domestic production of sugar declined marginally by 0.3 per cent from 259,635 MT in the first half of 2006 to 258,918 MT in the same half of 2007. Production of soft drinks declined by 4.7 per cent from 86,556 MT in the first quarter of 2006 to 82,459 MT in the same quarter of 2007.

Production of assembled vehicles declined by 72 vehicles from 532 assembled vehicles in April 2007 to 460 assembled vehicles in May 2007. Production of galvanized sheets rose by 20.3 per cent from 39,021 MT in the first quarter of 2006 to 46,948 MT in the same quarter of 2007.

Quantity of cement produced rose by 10.8 per cent from 484,598 MT in the first quarter of 2006 to 536,952 MT in the same quarter of 2007. Consumption of cement rose by 2.7 per cent to stand at 423,178 MT in the first quarter of 2007 up from 412,216 MT in the same quarter of 2006.

Milk deliveries in the formal milk sector rose marginally by 0.2 per cent from 33,092.5 thousand litres in June 2007 to 33, 147.8 thousand litres in July 2007.

e). Tourism and Transport

The number of visitors who arrived through Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) and Moi International Airport rose by 13.6 per cent from 418,251 visitors in the first half of 2006 to 475,206 visitors in the same half of 2007.

The number of passengers who embarked at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) rose by 8.6 per cent from 117,968 persons in June 2007 to 128,163 persons in July 2007 while passengers who landed declined by 2.2 per cent from 119,445 persons to 116,841 persons over the same period.

Total number of vehicles registered increased by one vehicle to register 5,713 vehicles in April 2007 compared to March 2007.

FIG. 1: OVERALL MONTH ON MONTH AND UNDERLYING INFLATION RATES

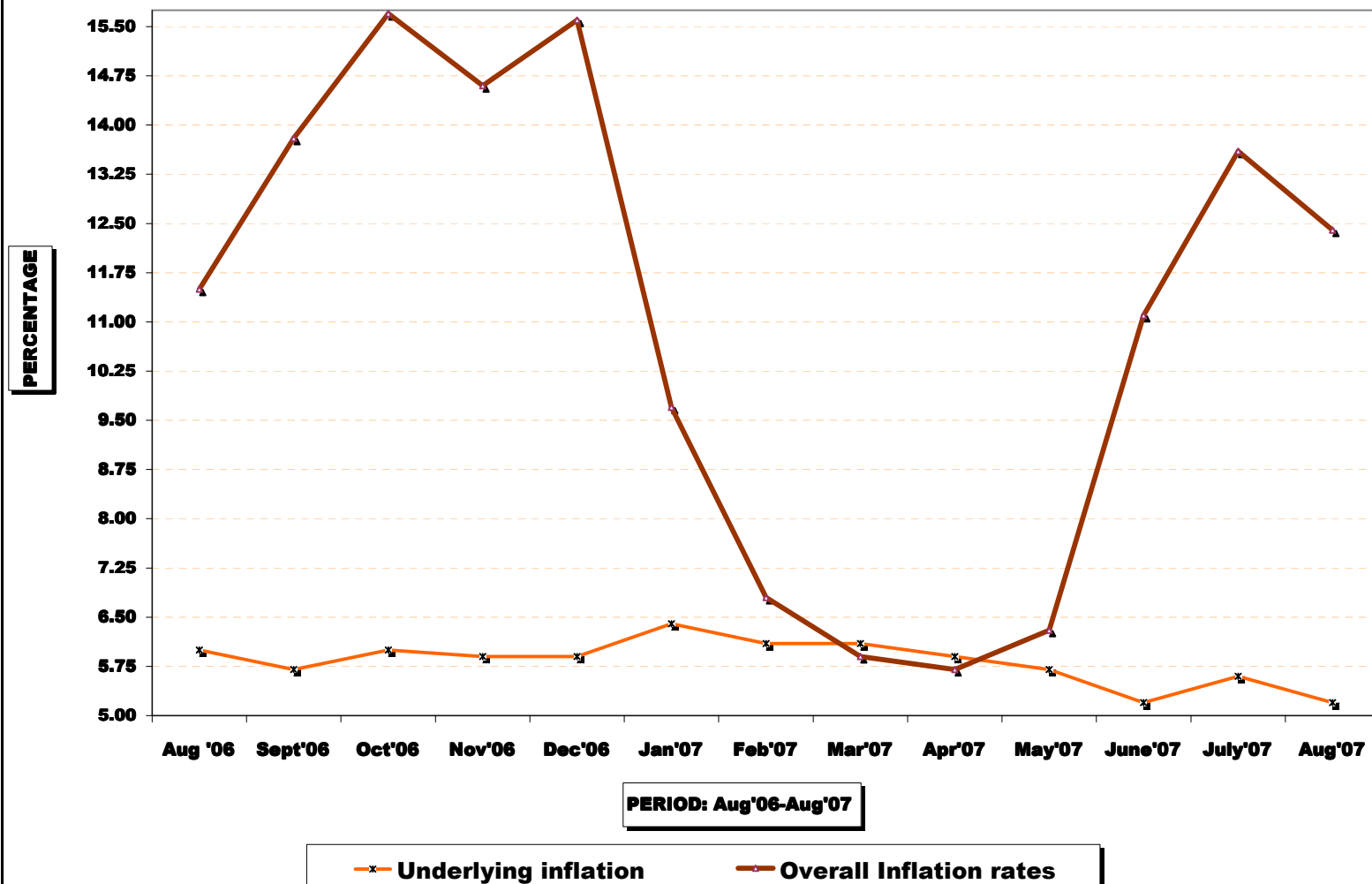

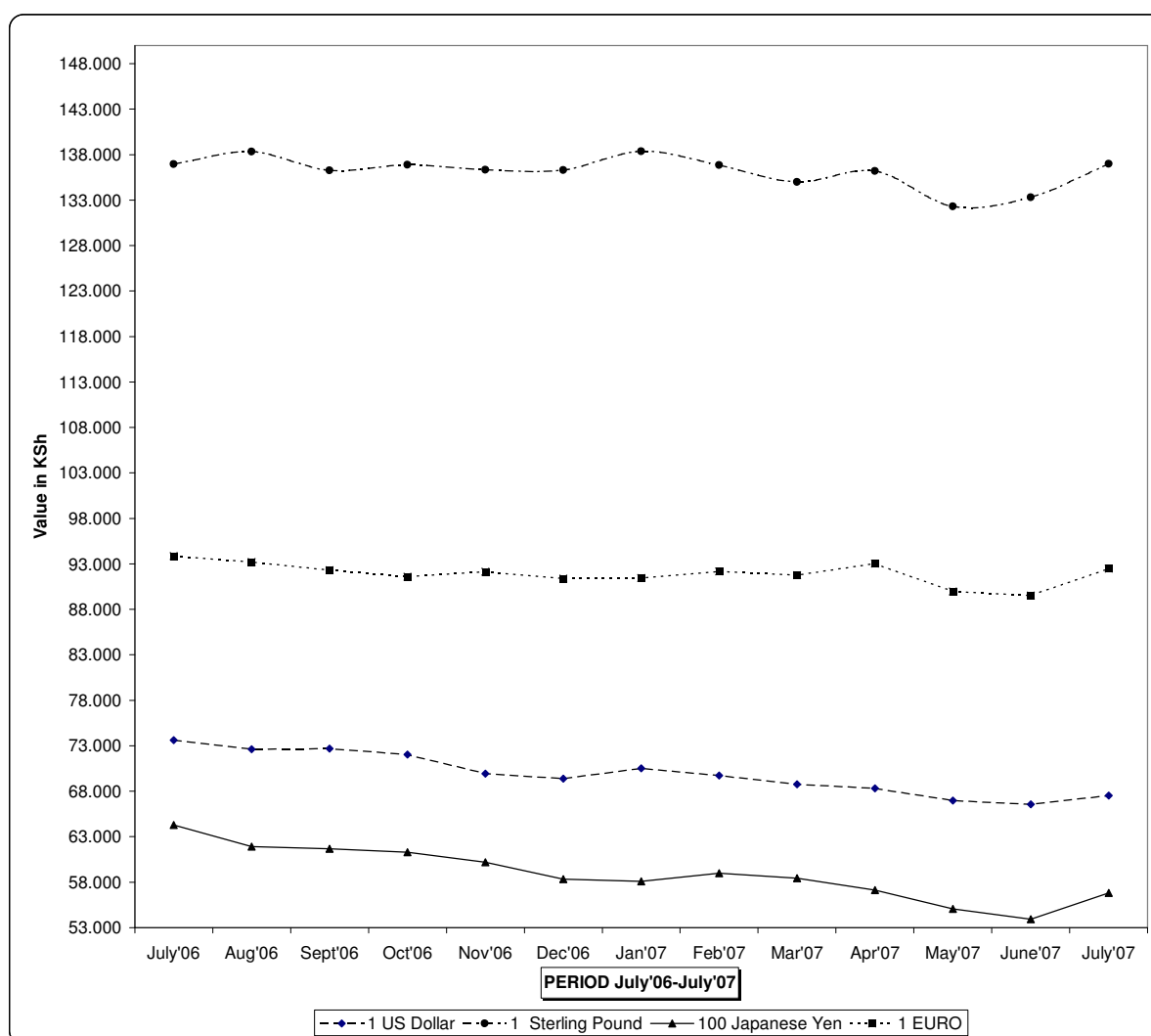

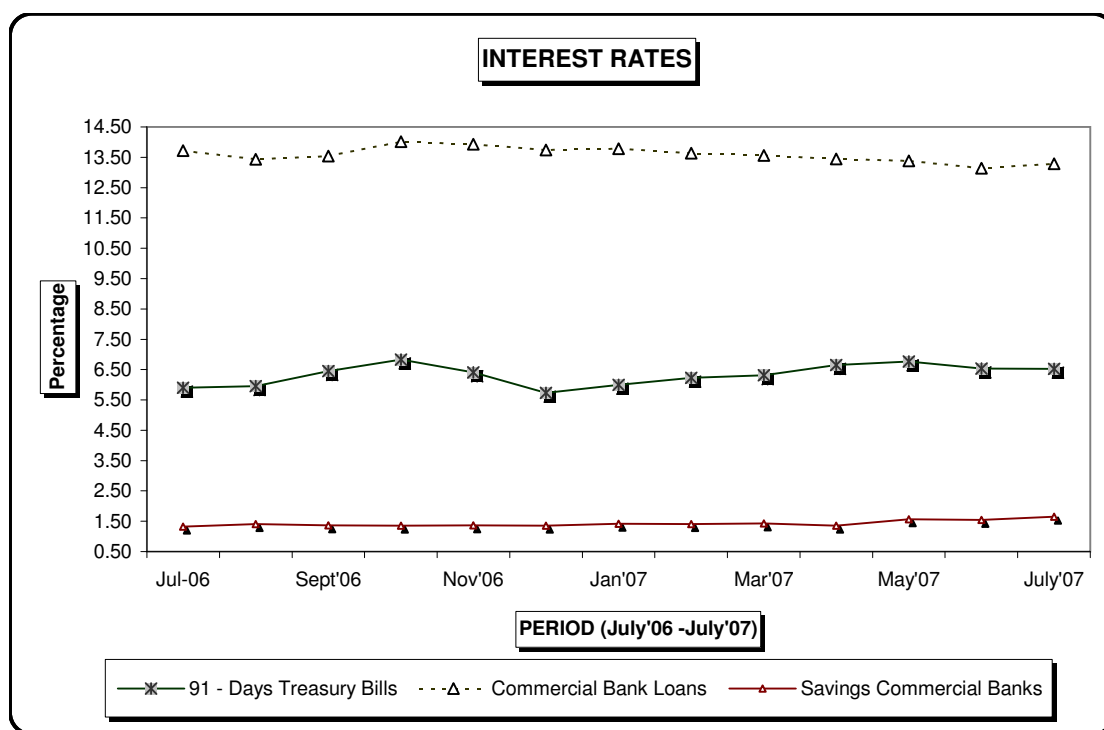

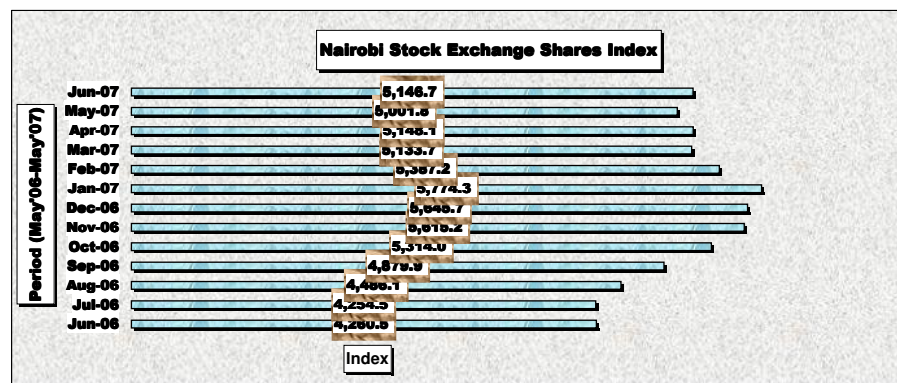

FIG. 5 Money Supply (M3)

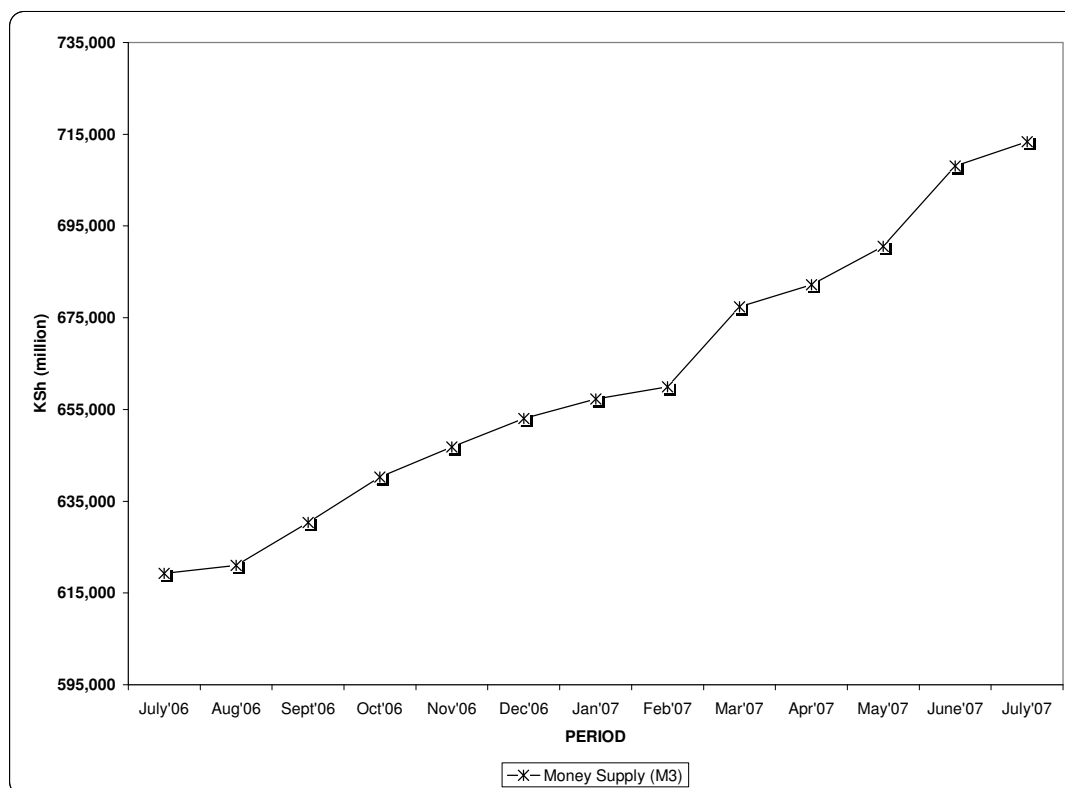

FIG. 6 FOREIGN EXCHANGE RESERVES

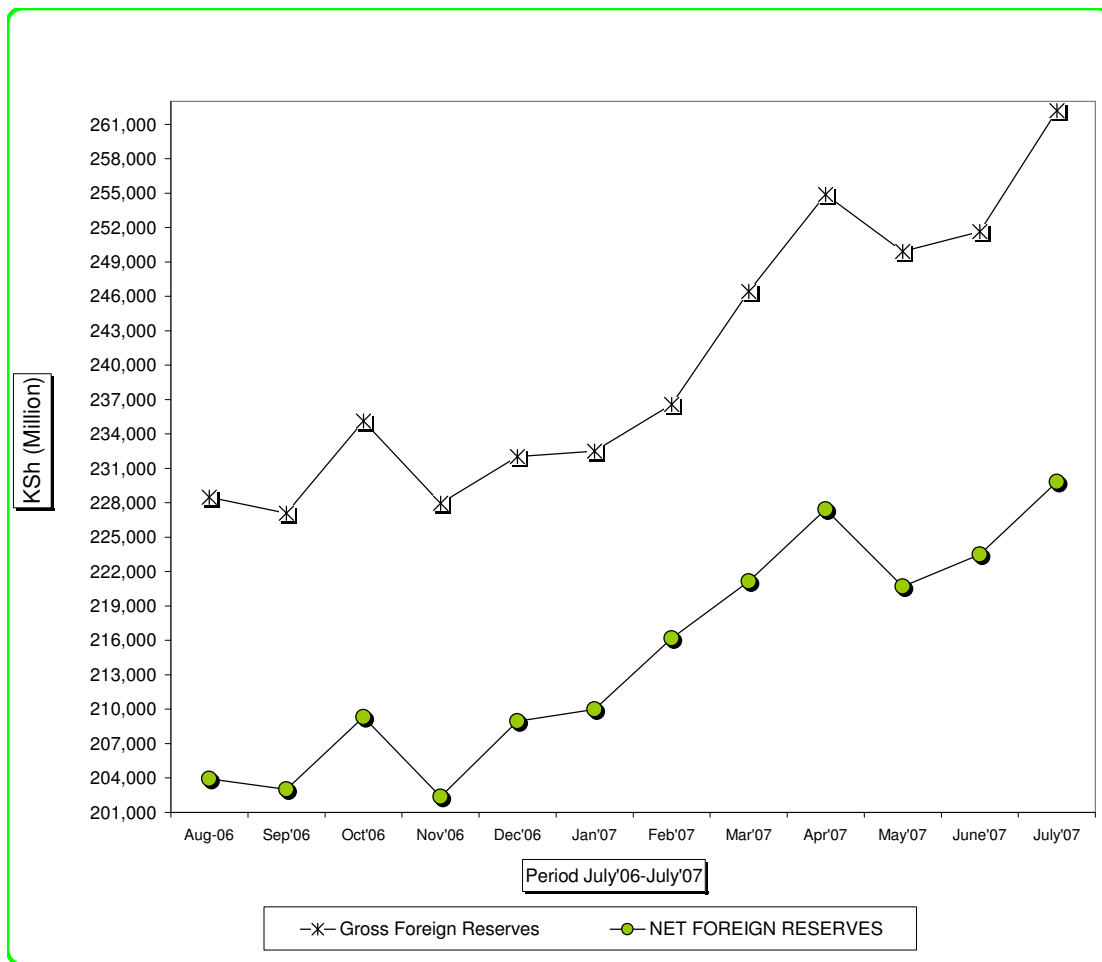

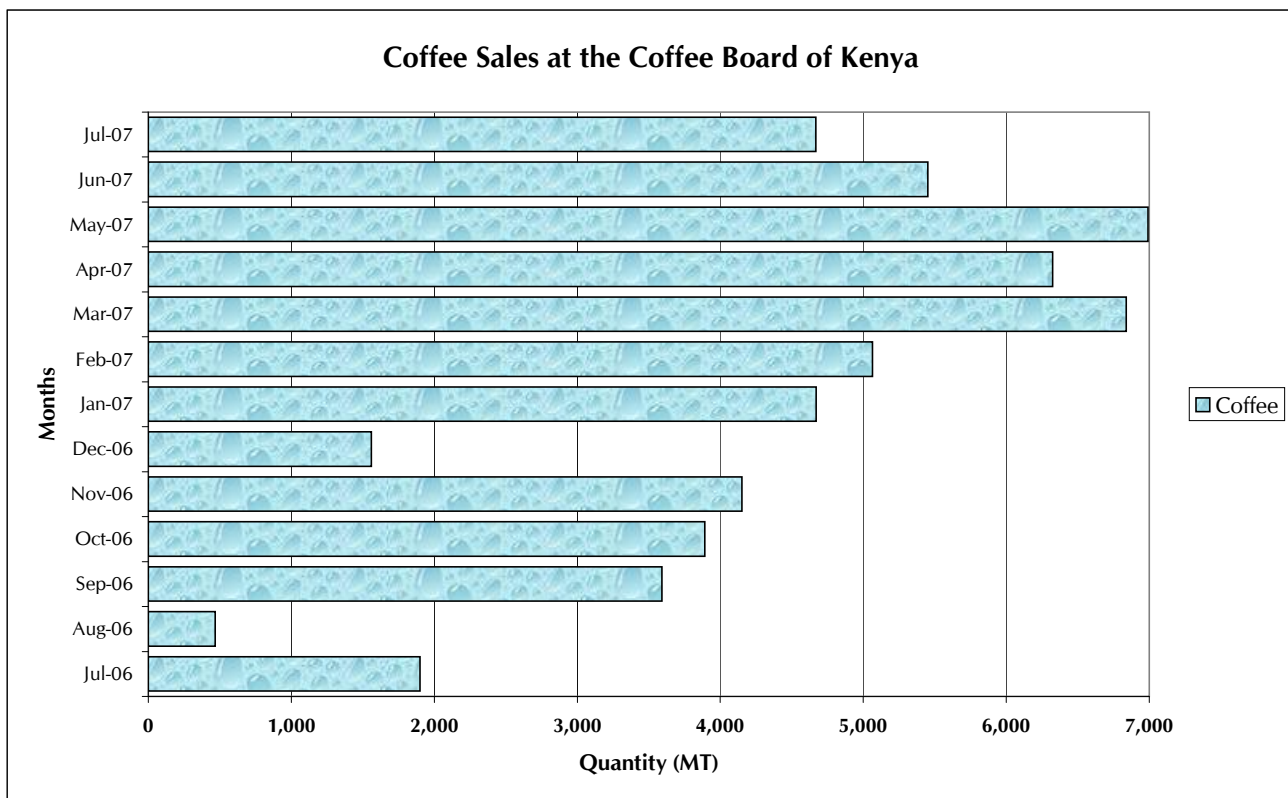

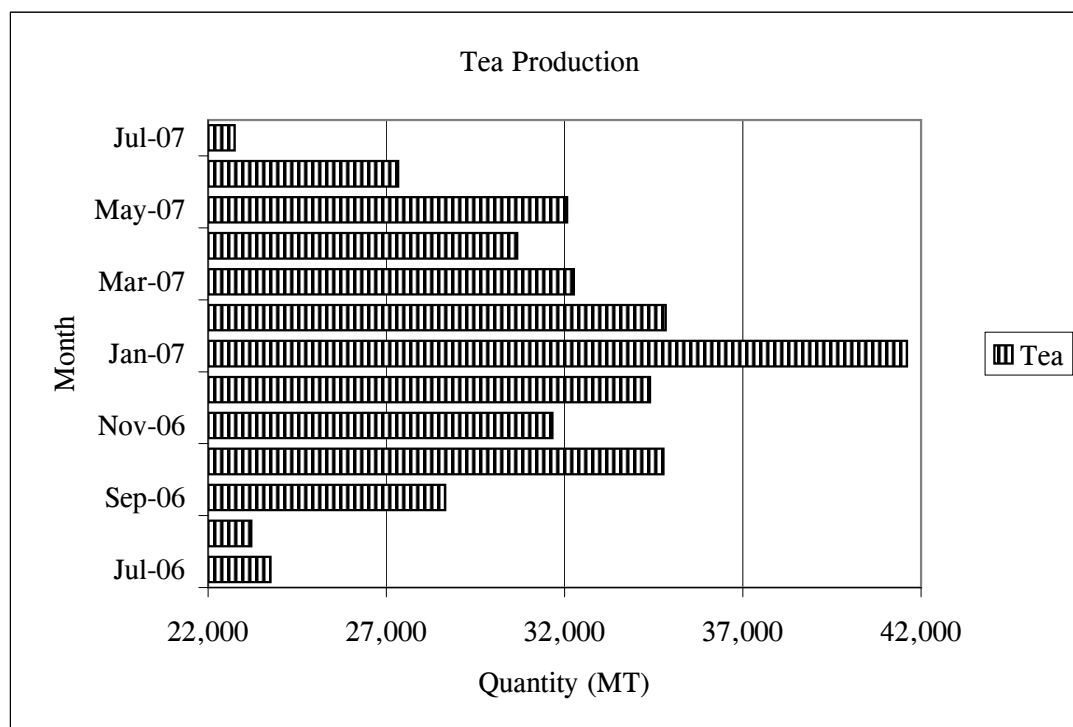

FIG 7: ELECTRICITY GENERATION BY SOURCE ,JUL '06-JUL '07

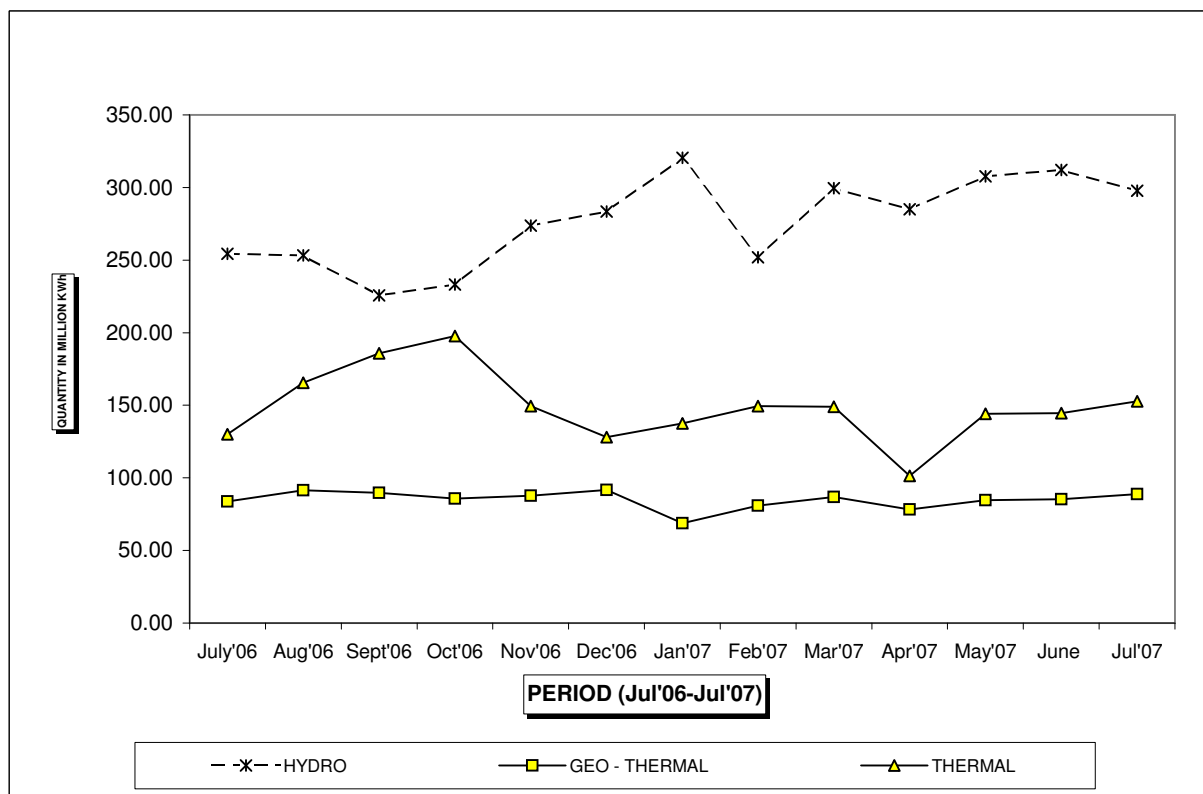

FIG 8: ELECTRICITY GENERATION , CONSUMPTION & POWER LOSSES.

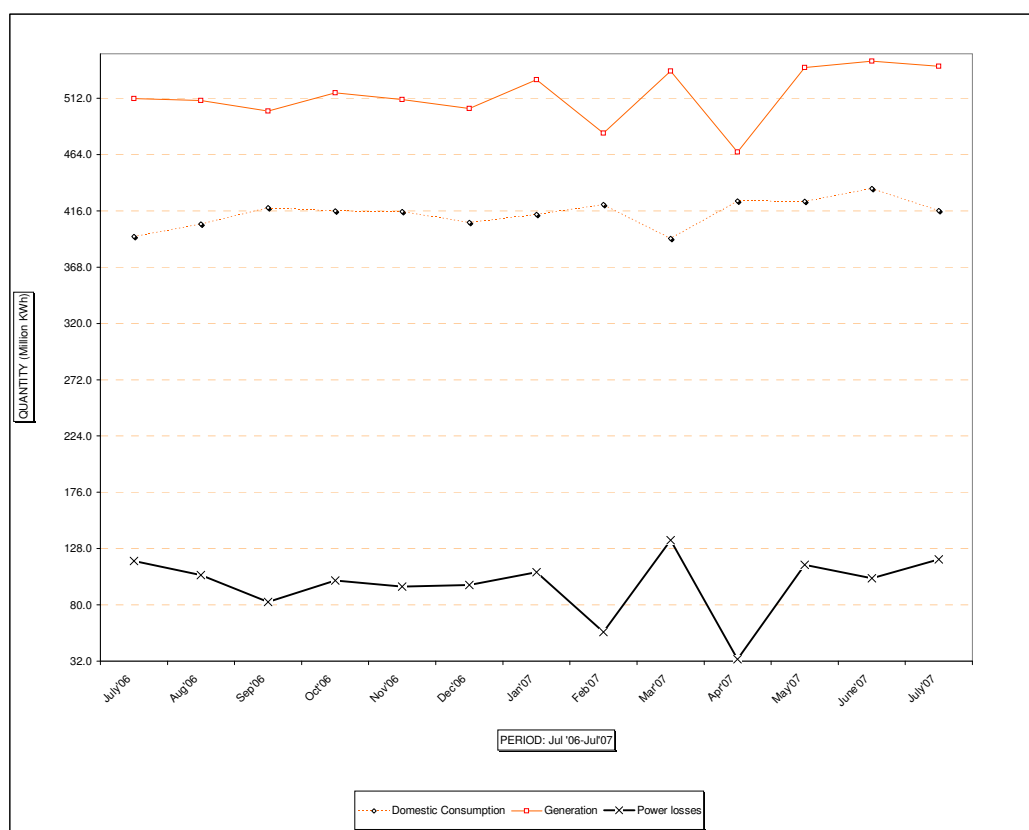

FIG 9(a): AVERAGE RETAIL PRICES OF SELECTED PETROLEUM PRODUCTS WITHIN NAIROBI

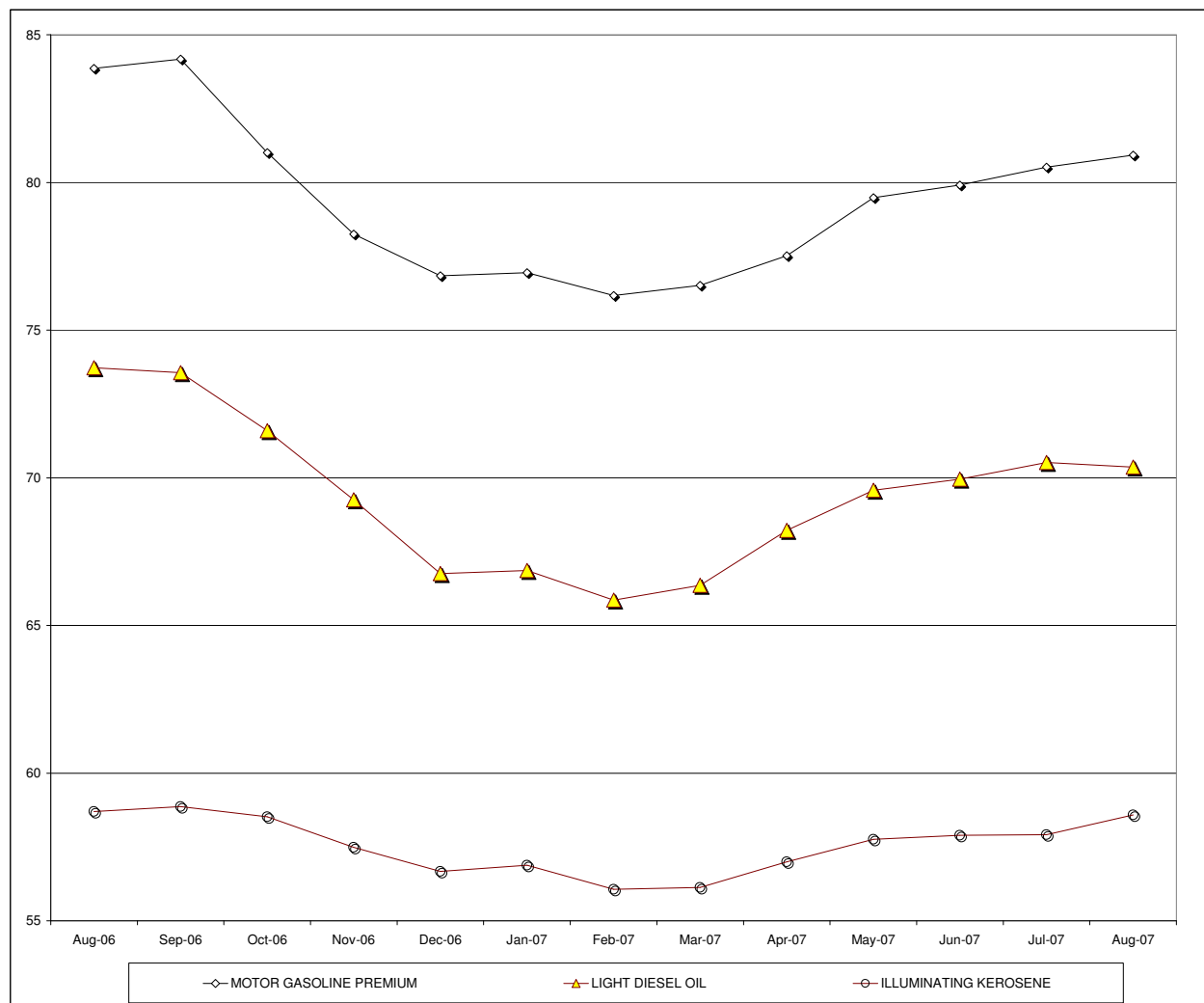

FIG 9(b): WEIGHTED AVERAGE PRICES FOR LPG IN KENYA

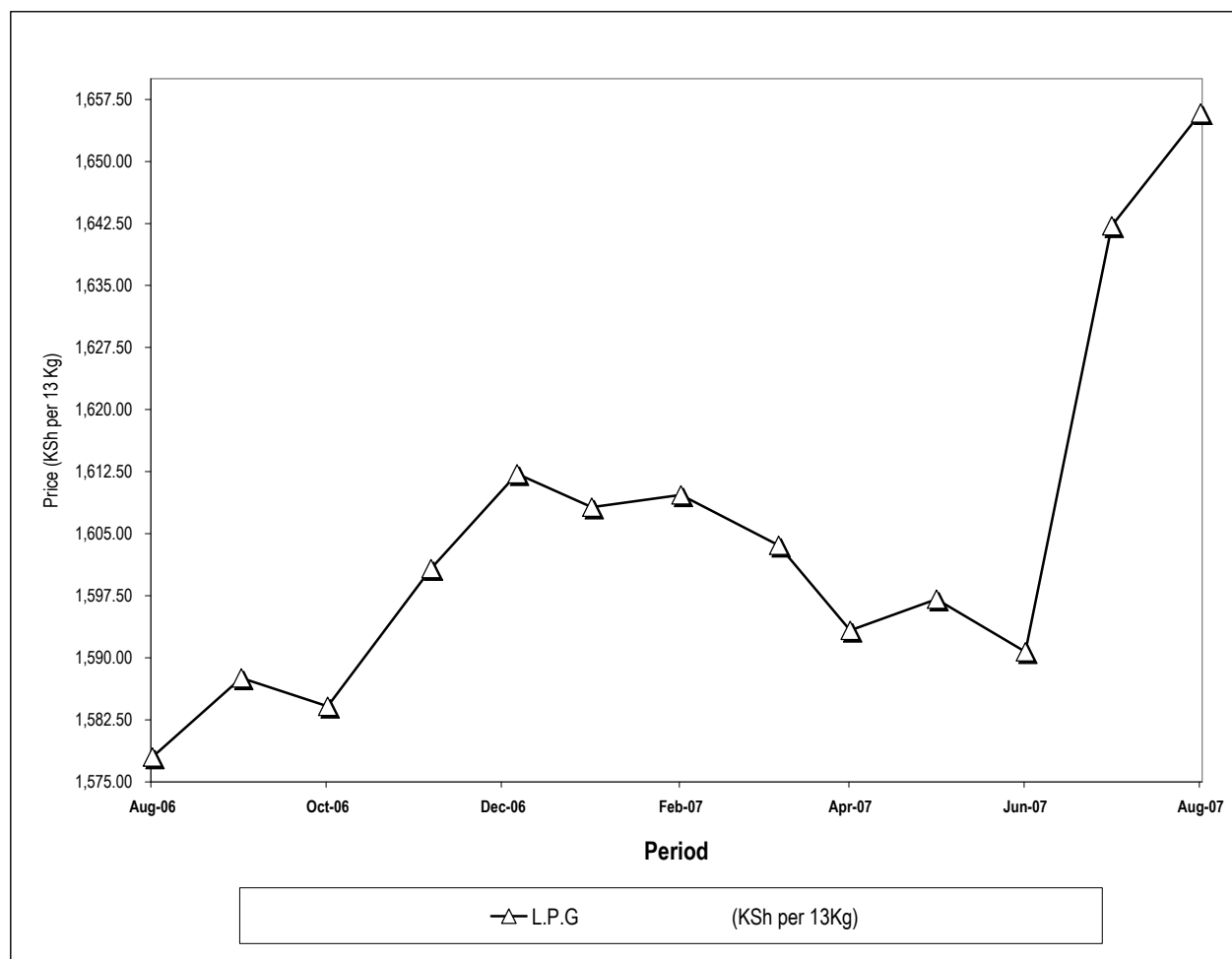

Fig10: TREND FOR MURBAN ADNOC CRUDE OIL PRICES (June '06-June'07)

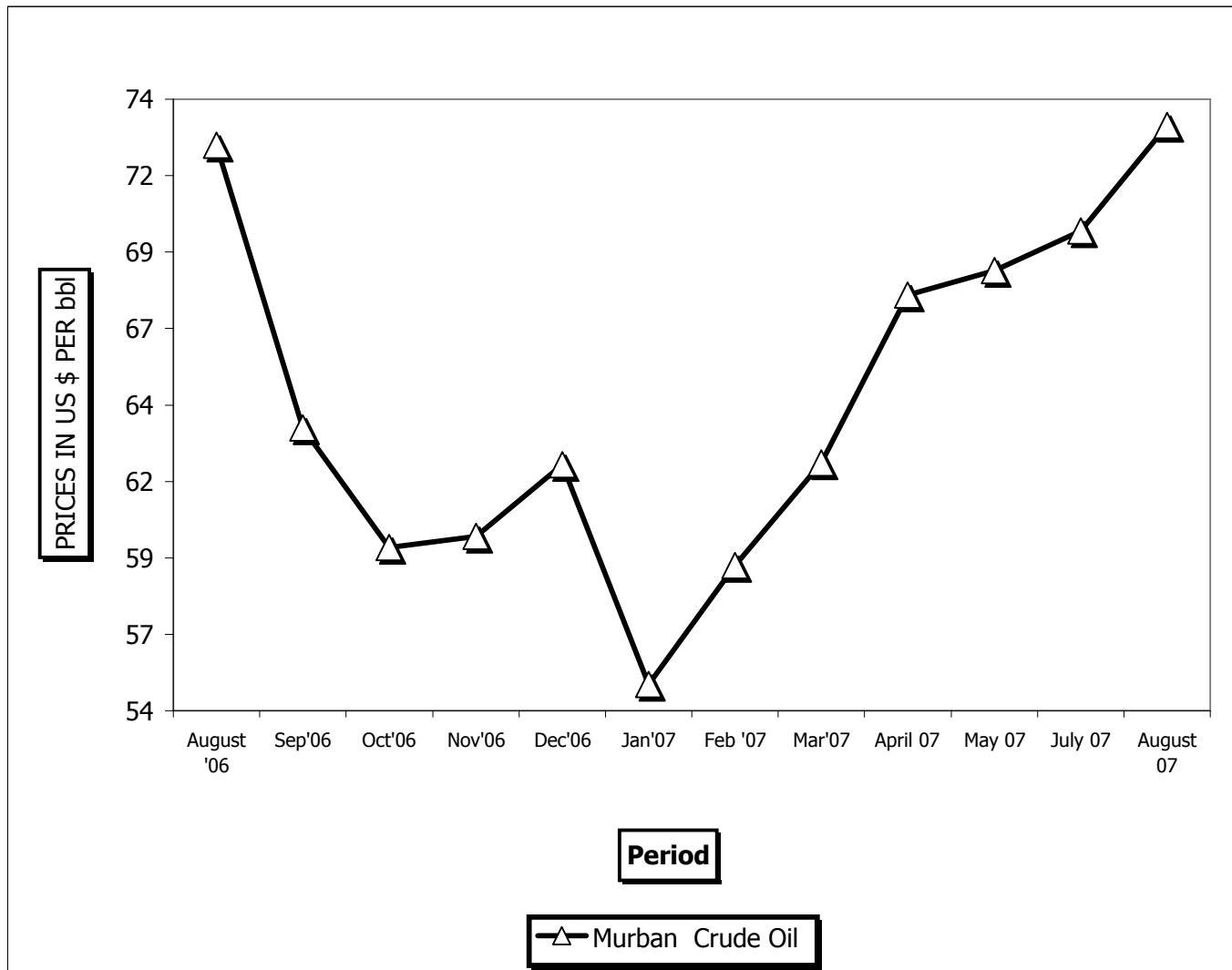

Fig 11: Processed Milk (Apr 06 - Apr 07)

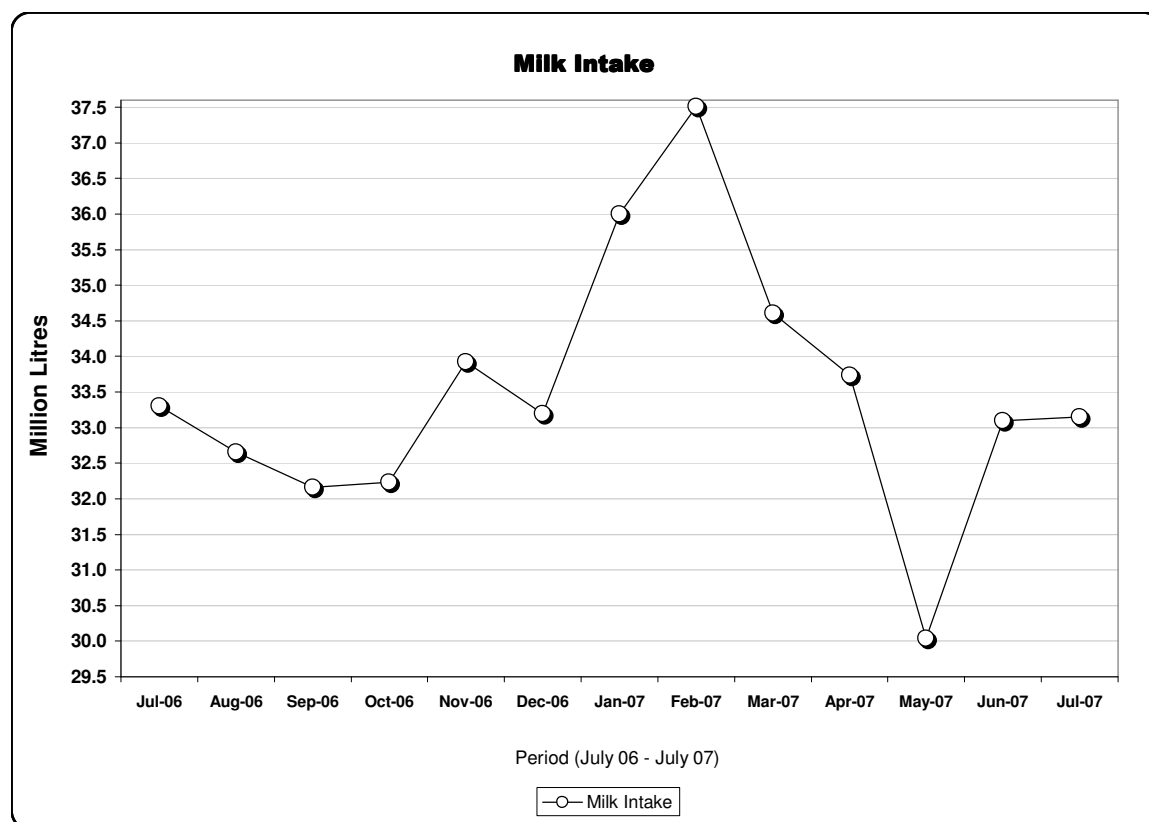


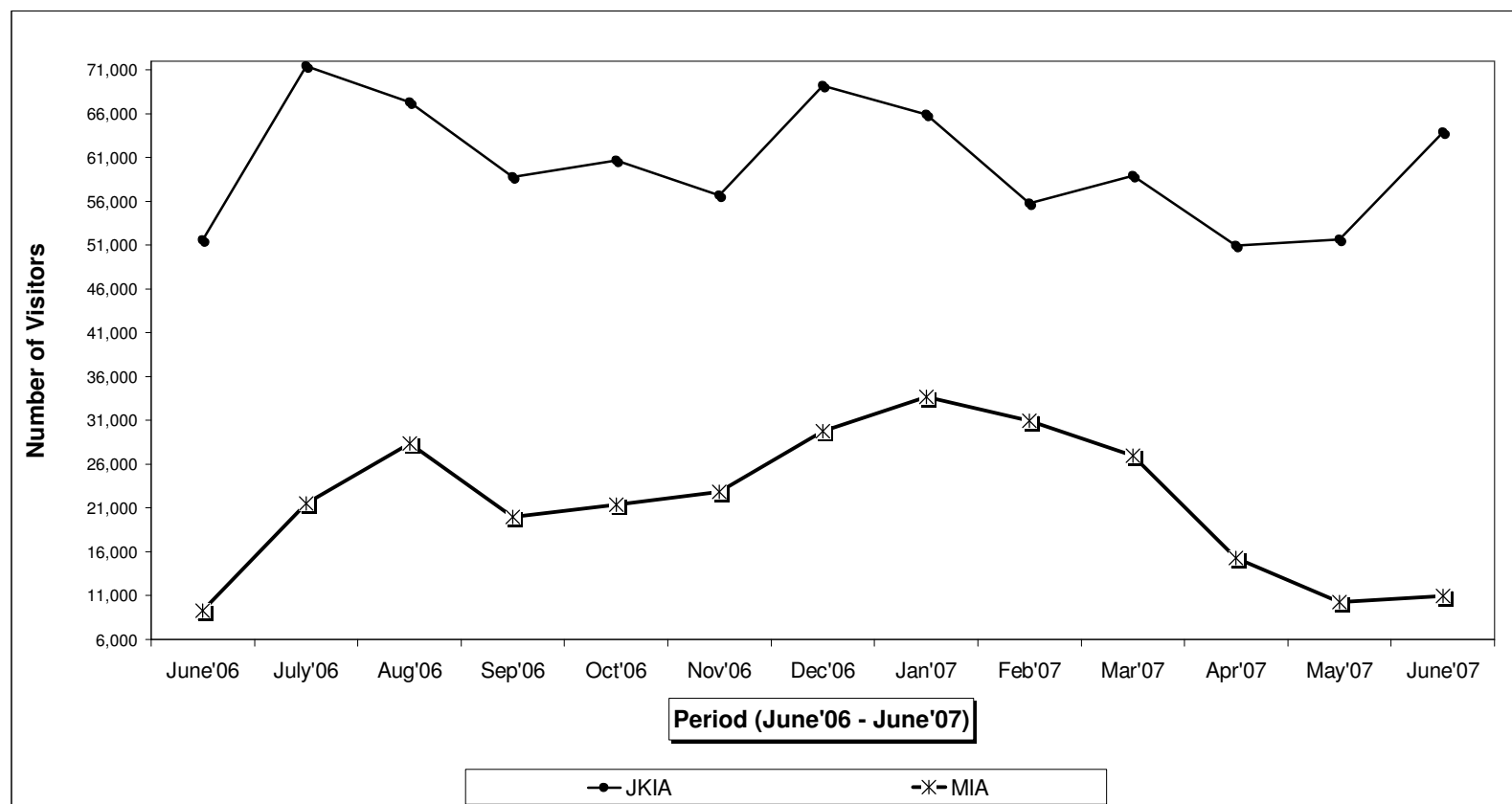

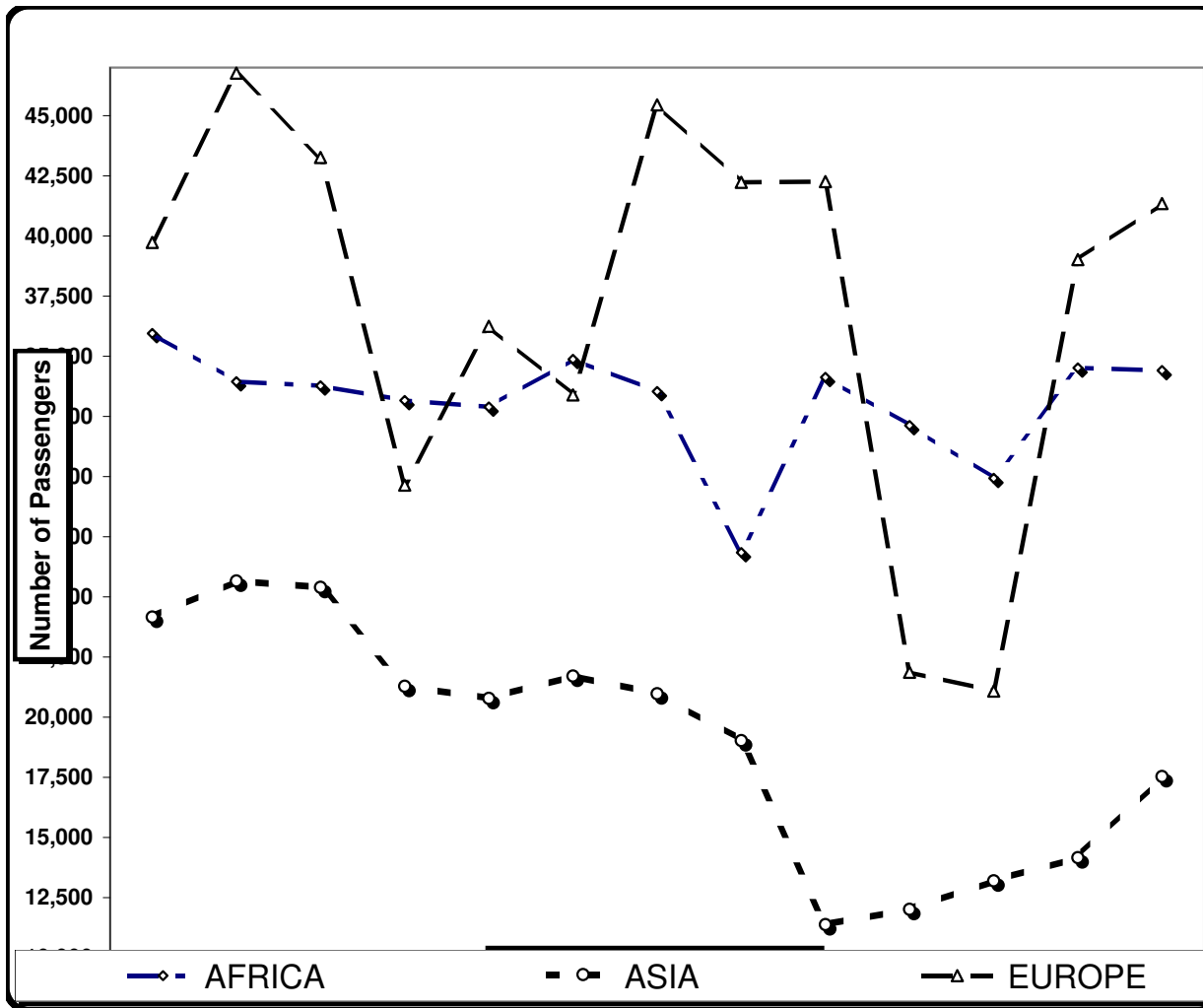

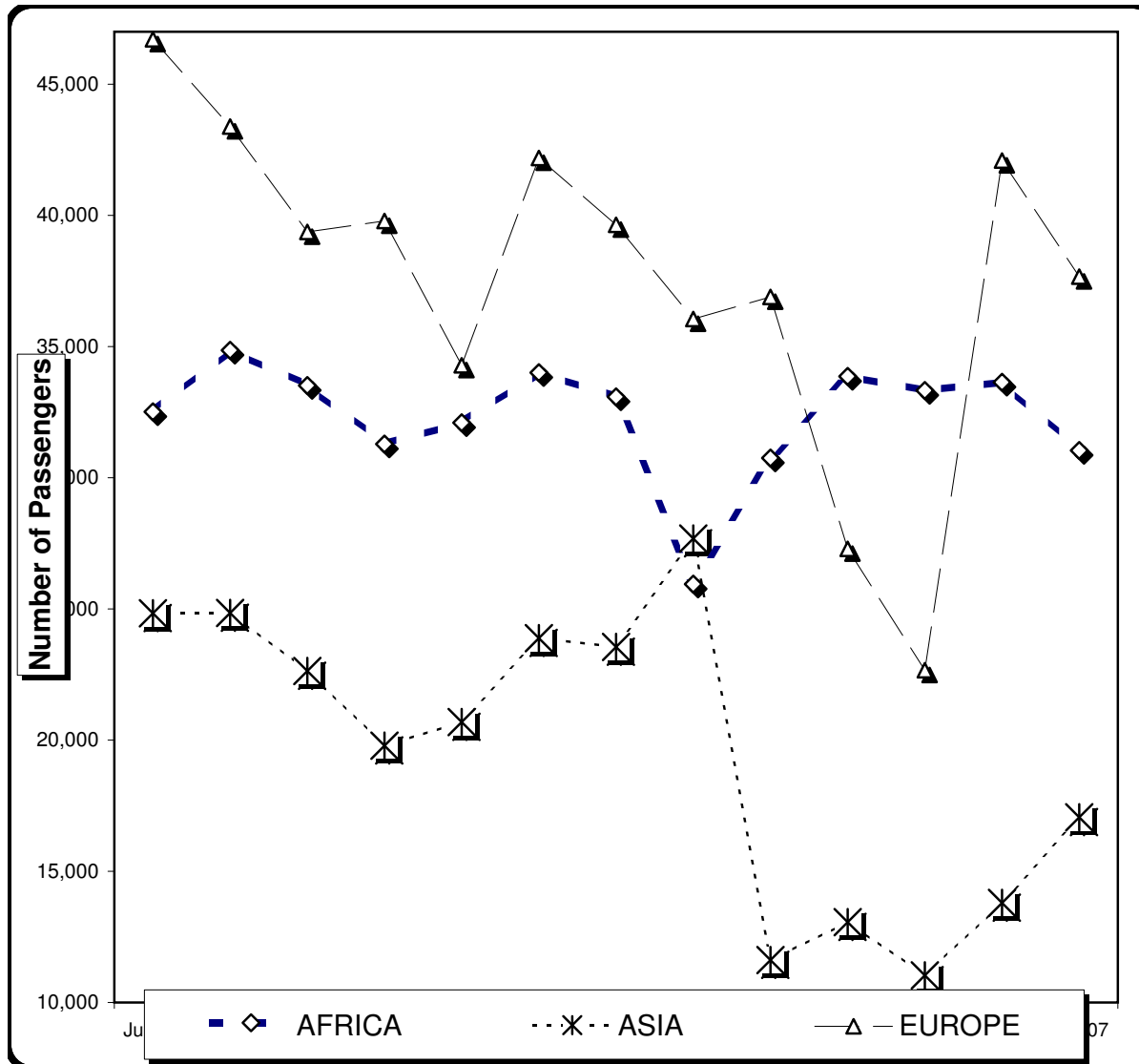
