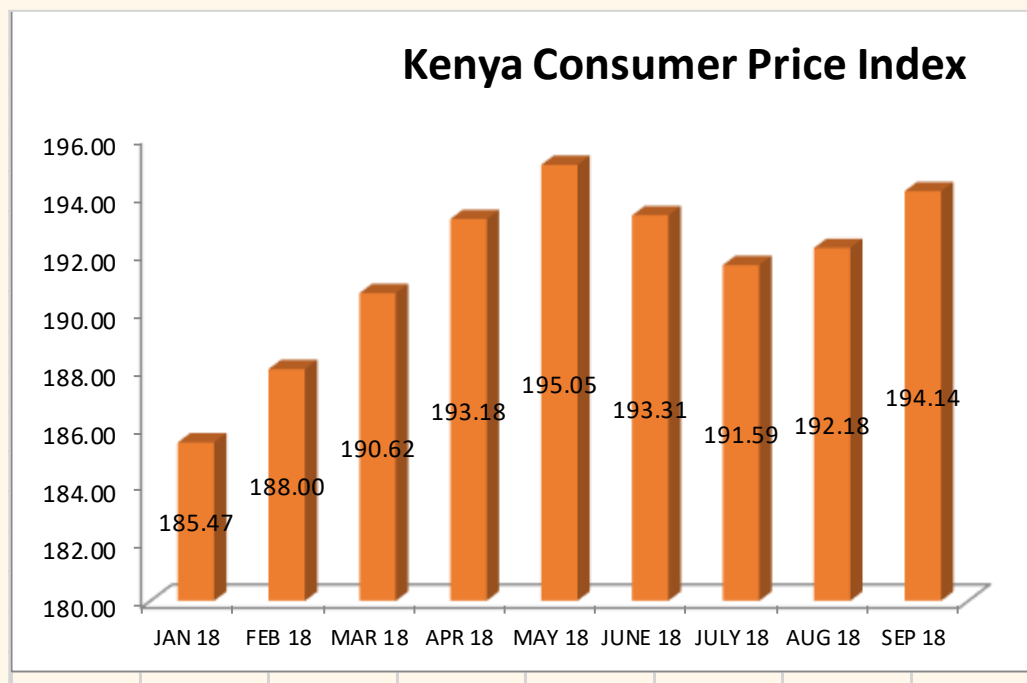


Leading Economic Indicators



SEPTEMBER 2018

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KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The Leading Economic Indicators report highlights changes in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation-rates, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport on a monthly basis.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased from 192.18 points in August 2018 to 194.14 points in September 2018. The overall rate of inflation rose from 4.04 per cent to 5.70 per cent during the same period. In September 2018, the Kenyan Shilling depreciated against the major trading currencies except for the Japanese Yen, the SA Rand and the Ugandan Shilling. The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates remained at 7.64 per cent in September 2018, while the inter-bank rate dropped from 6.52 per cent in August 2018 to 4.28 per cent in September 2018.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 share index decreased from 3,203 points in August 2018 to 2,876 points in September 2018, while the total number of shares traded rose from 329 million shares to 392 million shares during the same period. The total value of NSE shares traded increased from KSh 10.24 billion in August 2018 to KSh 11.95 billion in September 2018.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation, increased from KSh 3,240.02 billion in August 2018 to KSh 3,241.38 billion in September 2018. Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves increased from KSh 1,205.98 billion in August 2018 to KSh 1,222.52 billion in September 2018. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves increased from KSh 735.06 billion in August 2018 to KSh 745.63 billion in September 2018.



The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange was 2,299.09 MT in September 2018 while the average auction price stood at KSh 288.68 per kilogram over the same period. The quantity of produced tea increased from 37,432.60 MT in August 2018 to 42,530.86 MT in September 2018. The price of processed tea rose from KSh

241.20 to KSh 243.34 per kilogram over the same period. The amount of cane deliveries increased from 316.08 thousand tonnes in June 2018 to 382.28 thousand tonnes in July 2018. The average monthly price per Kg for maize was 35.79 KSh in August 2018. Bean prices averaged at KSh 77.69 per Kg during the same month.

The quantity of cut-flower horticultural exports in August 2018 was at 11,560.38 MT while its' value of exports was KSh 10,669.69 million during the same period. The volume of vegetable exports increased from 4,421.85 MT in July 2018 to 7,090.14 MT in August 2018. The value of vegetable exports increased from KSh 1,387.96 million in July 2018 to KSh 2,842.46 million in August 2018.

INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported decreased from 2,972.69 MT in August 2018 to 2,519.53 MT in September 2018, while its value went down from KSh 1,546.91 million to KSh 1,141.39 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported increased from 38,022.53 MT in August 2018 to 40,267.54 MT in September 2018, while its value increased from KSh 9,919.47 million to KSh 10,478.62 million over the same period.

Volume of trade dropped from KSh 200.81 billion in August 2018 to KSh 176.55 billion in September 2018. The value of Total exports decreased to KSh 46.76 billion in September 2018 from 50.99 billion in August 2018 while the value of imports dropped from KSh 149.82 billion in August 2018 to KSh 129.80 billion in September 2018.

Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages was the main export category in September 2018 accounting for 47.22 per cent of exports, while non-food industrial supplies and consumer goods not elsewhere specified accounted for 23.22 per cent and 26.85 per cent of the value of total domestic exports, respectively.

Imports by BEC indicate that non-food industrial supplies was the main import category in September 2018 with a share of 35.04 per cent. Machinery & other capital equipment; fuel and lubricants; and transport equipment constituted 18.26, 17.77 and 9.86 per cent of the total value of imports, respectively. Imports of food and beverage recorded a share of 8.62 per cent of the total imports while consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 9.24 per cent in September 2018.

ENERGY



Total local electricity generation decreased from 963.72 million KWh in August 2018 to 924.69 million KWh in September 2018. In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil decreased from an average of US Dollars 76.00 per barrel in July 2018 to US Dollars 74.91 per barrel in August 2018.

The national average domestic retail oil prices of motor gasoline premium rose from KSh 114.58 per litre in August 2018 to KSh 117.54 per litre in September 2018. The price of light diesel oil rose to retail at KSh 108.97 in September 2018. The average price for Kerosene rose to retail at KSh 109.25 in September 2018 up from 85.90 in August 2018. Charcoal prices averaged KSh 141.24 per 4KG tin in September 2018. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,187.21 in September 2018.

MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION



The quantity of cement produced decreased from 473,861 MT in August 2018 to 460,546 MT in September 2018. Consumption of cement dropped from 466,909 MT in August 2018 to 456,473 MT in September 2018. Sugar production increased from 30,105 Metric tonnes in July 2018 to 35,553 Metric tonnes in August 2018. Production

of assembled vehicles decreased from 498 units in July 2018 to 303 units in August 2018. Milk uptake in the formal sector rose from 52.22 million litres in June 2018 to 55.48 million litres in July 2018.

ICT, TOURISM AND TRANSPORT



The total number of mobile money transactions was 145.99 million transactions in September 2018 while their value stood at KSh 327.66 billion over the same period. The value of imports for telecommunication equipment dropped from KSh 2,762.25 million in July 2018 to KSh 2,341.38 million in August 2018.

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports (MIA) decreased to 114,989 in August 2018 from 126,797 persons in July 2018.

The number of passengers who landed at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) decreased from 304,406 in August 2018 to 270,188 in September 2018, while passengers who embarked decreased from 203,220 persons to 176,029 persons during the same period.

Fig. 1: Inflation rates

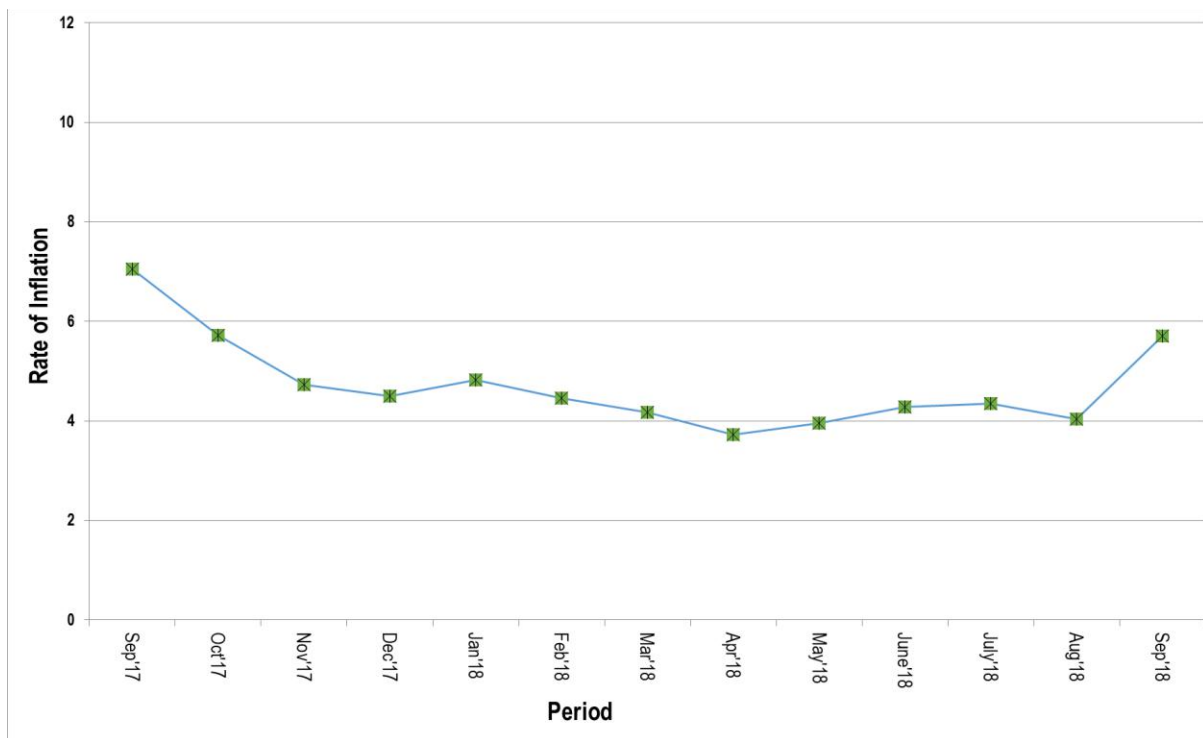

Fig. 2: End of Month Mean Exchange rate of Kenya Shillings against Major Selected Currencies

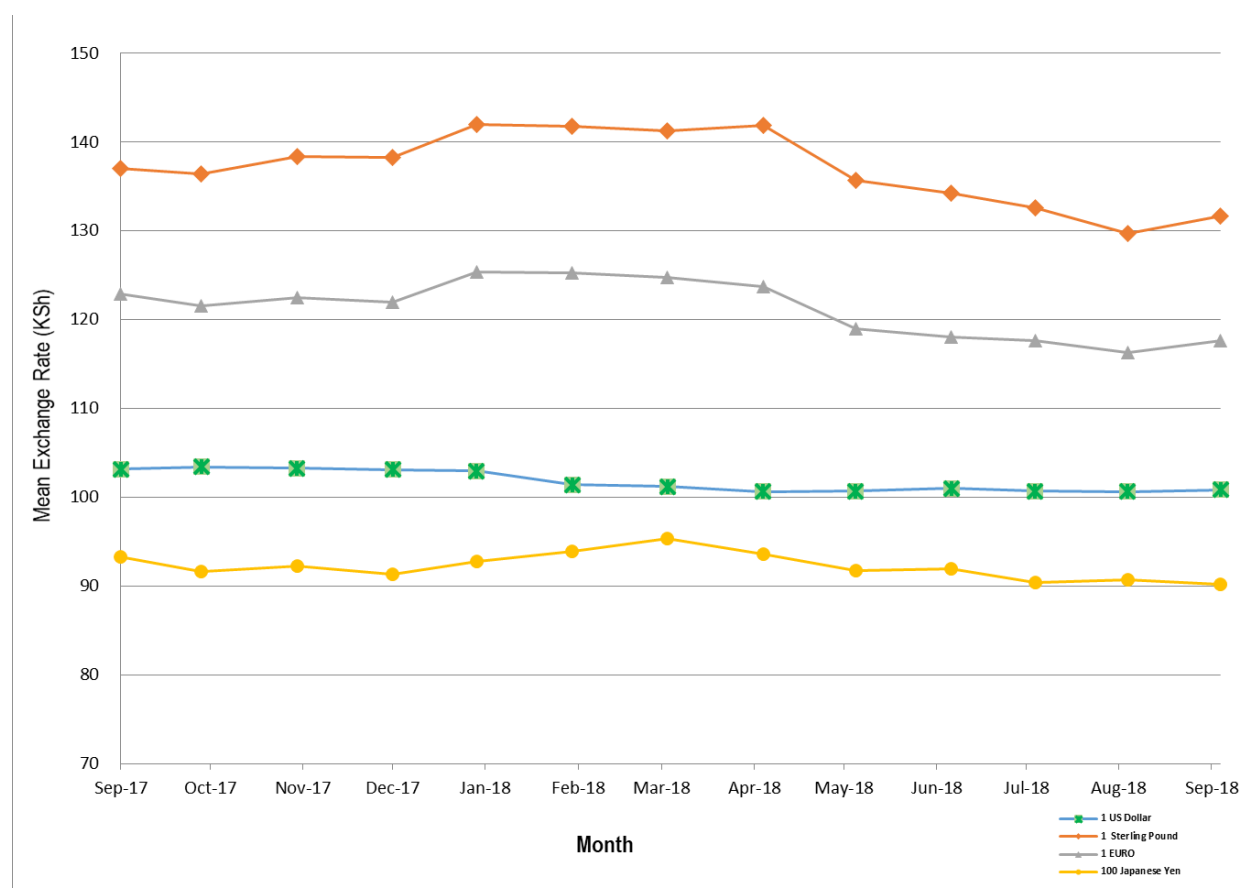

Fig. 3: Nairobi Securities Exchange 20 Share Index

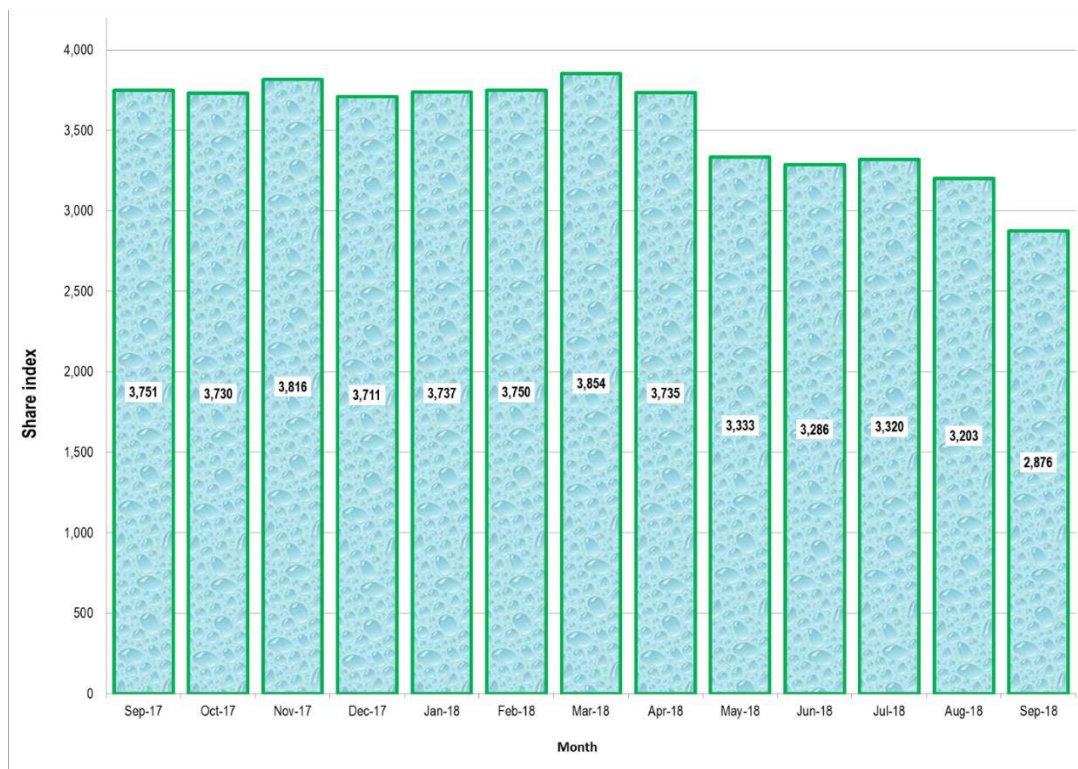

Fig. 4: Coffee Sales at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange

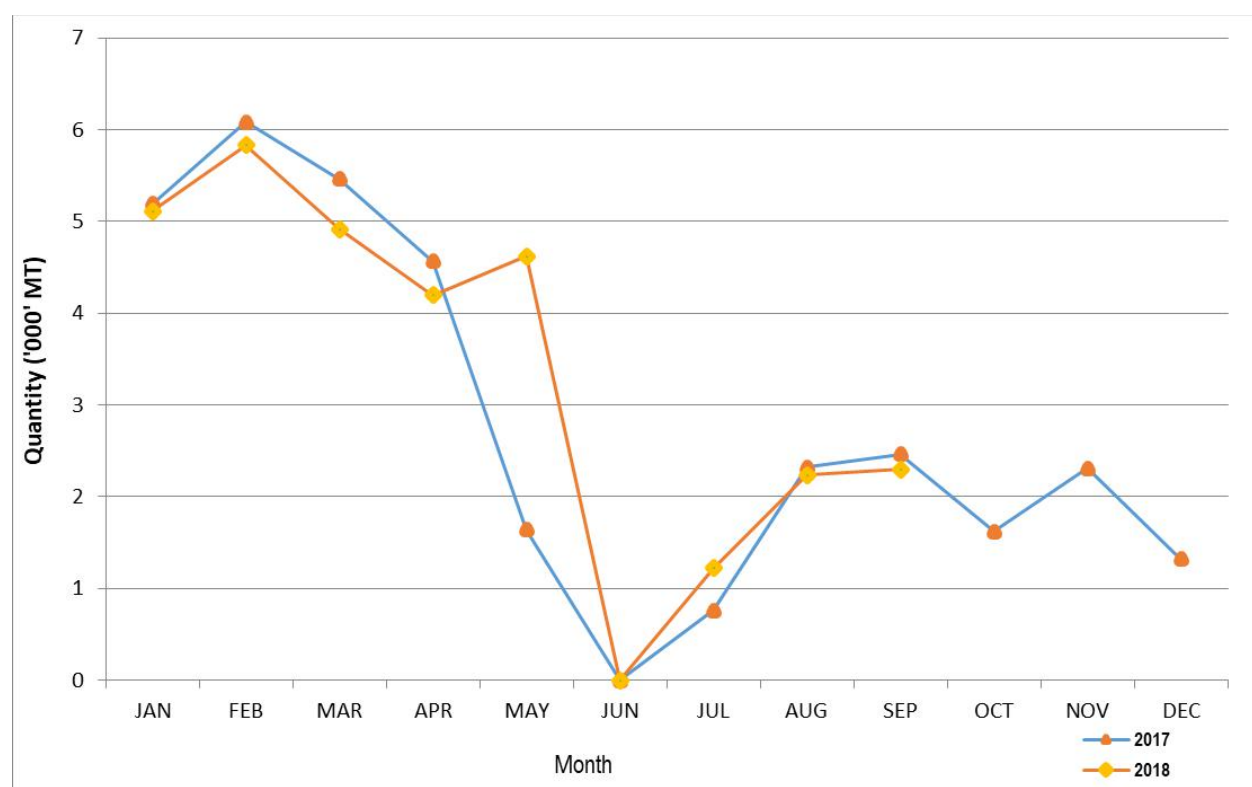

Fig. 5: Tea Production

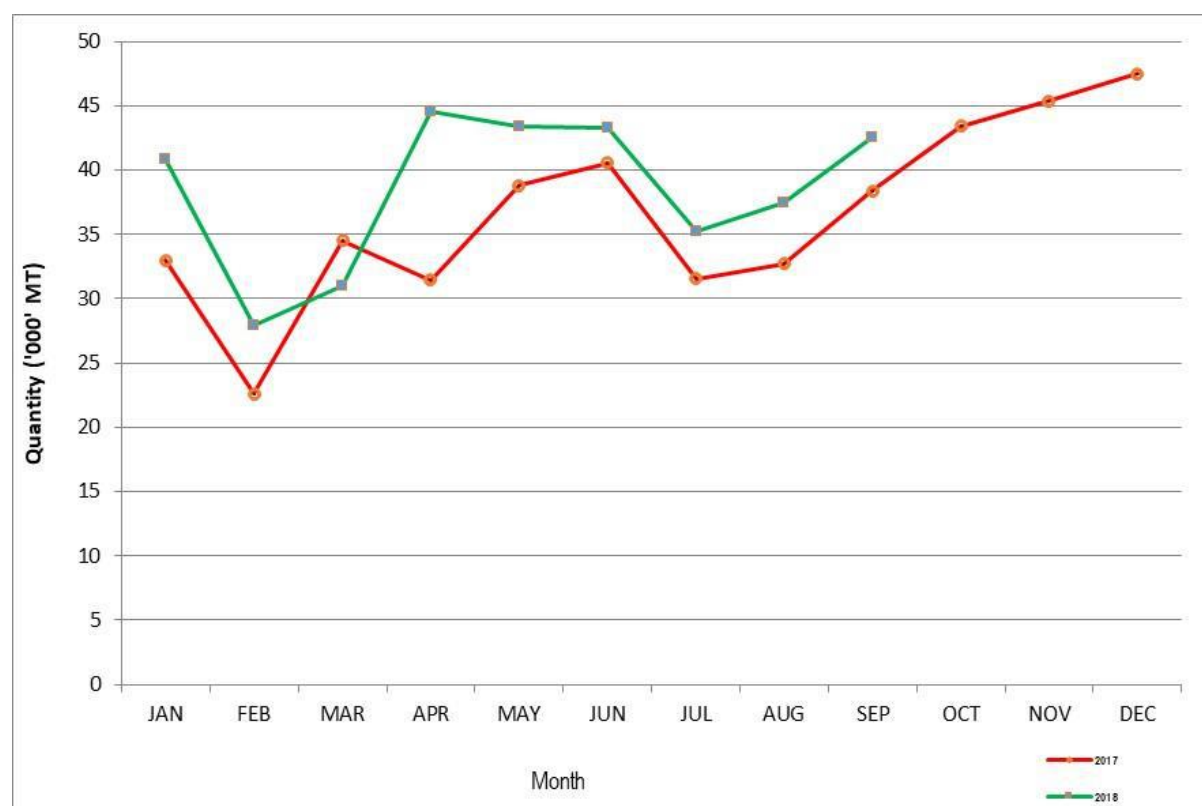

Fig. 6: Cane Deliveries

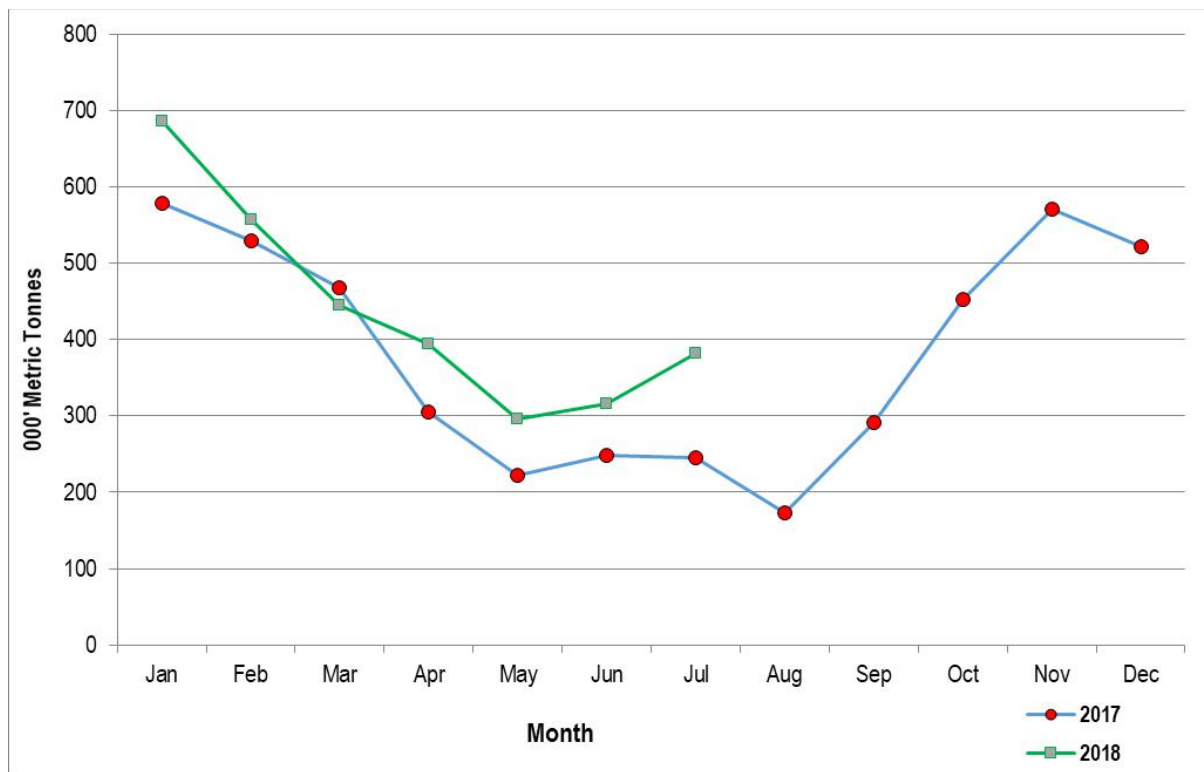

Fig. 7: Electricity Generation by Source

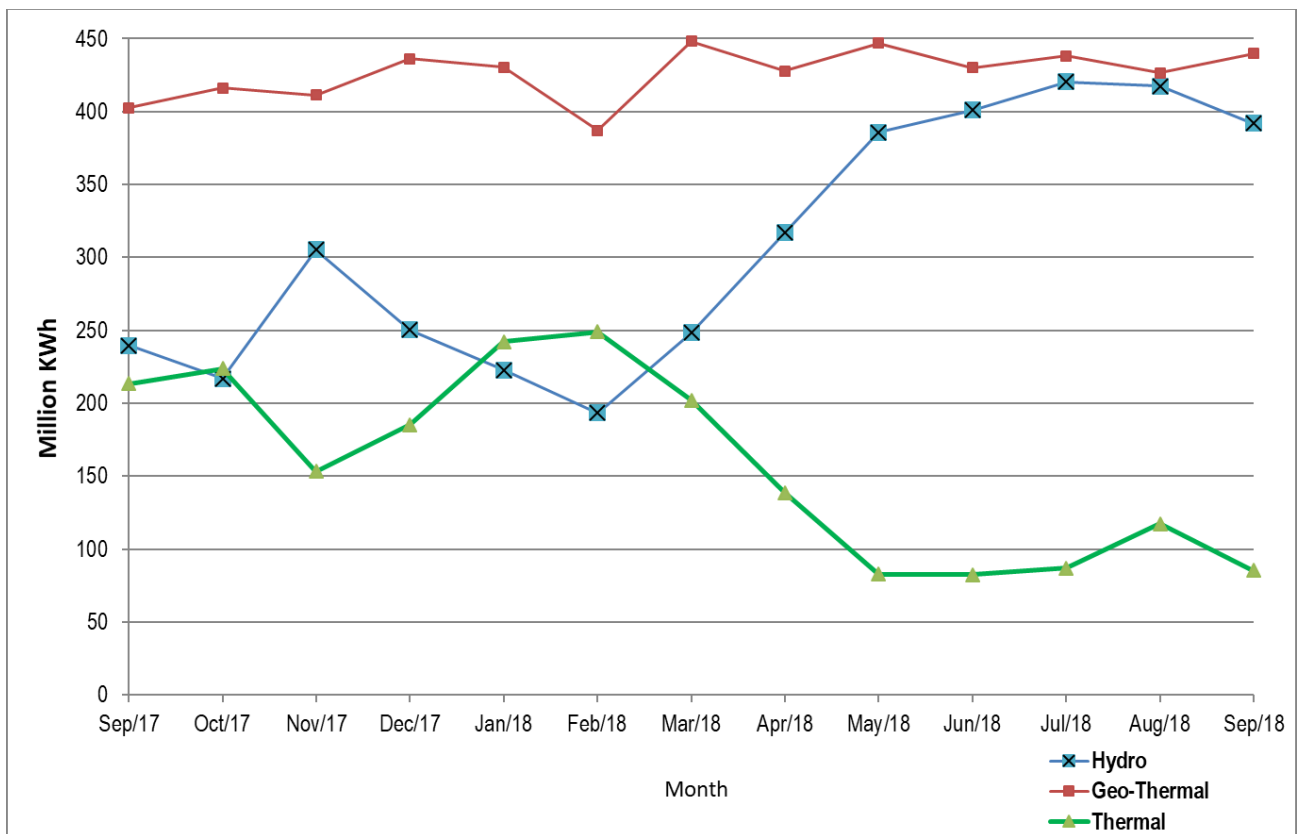

Fig. 9: Average Prices for Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Kenya ('000 KSh per 13 Kg cylinder)

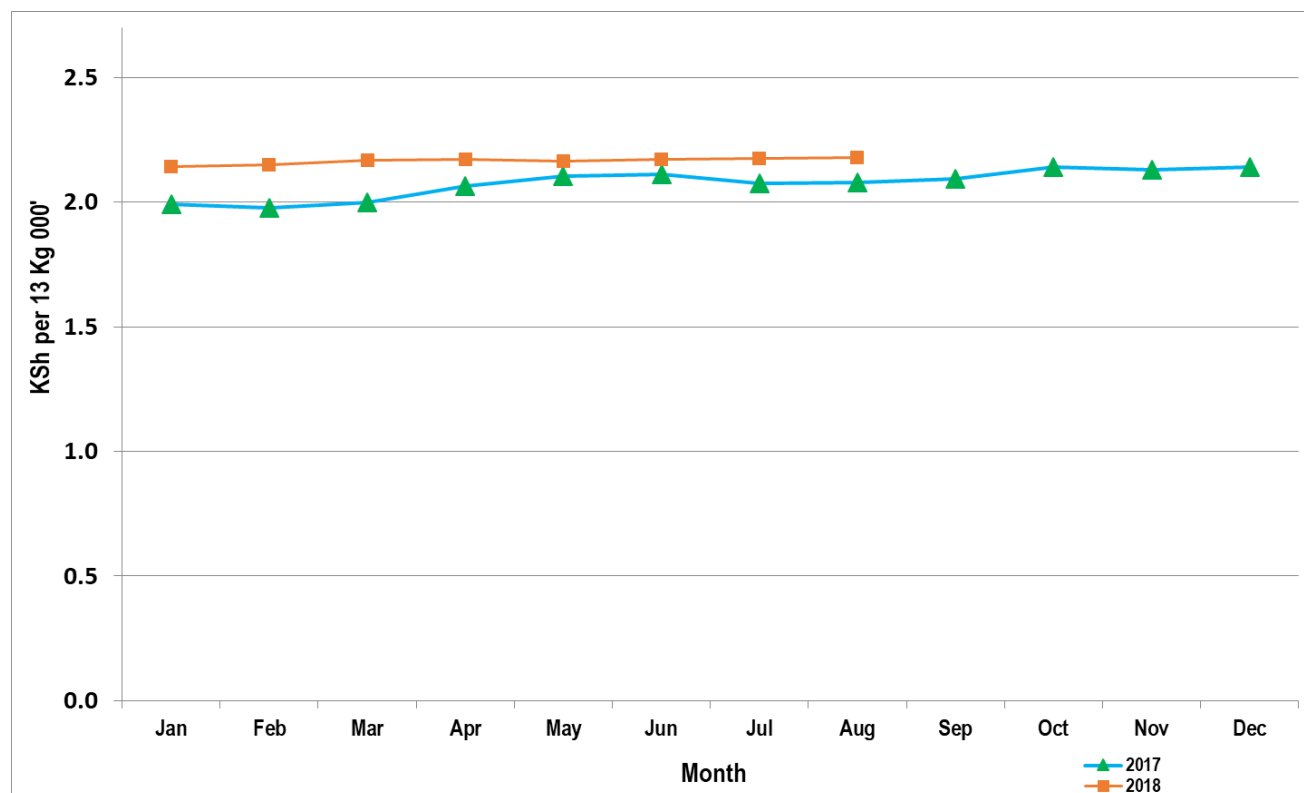

Fig. 10: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector

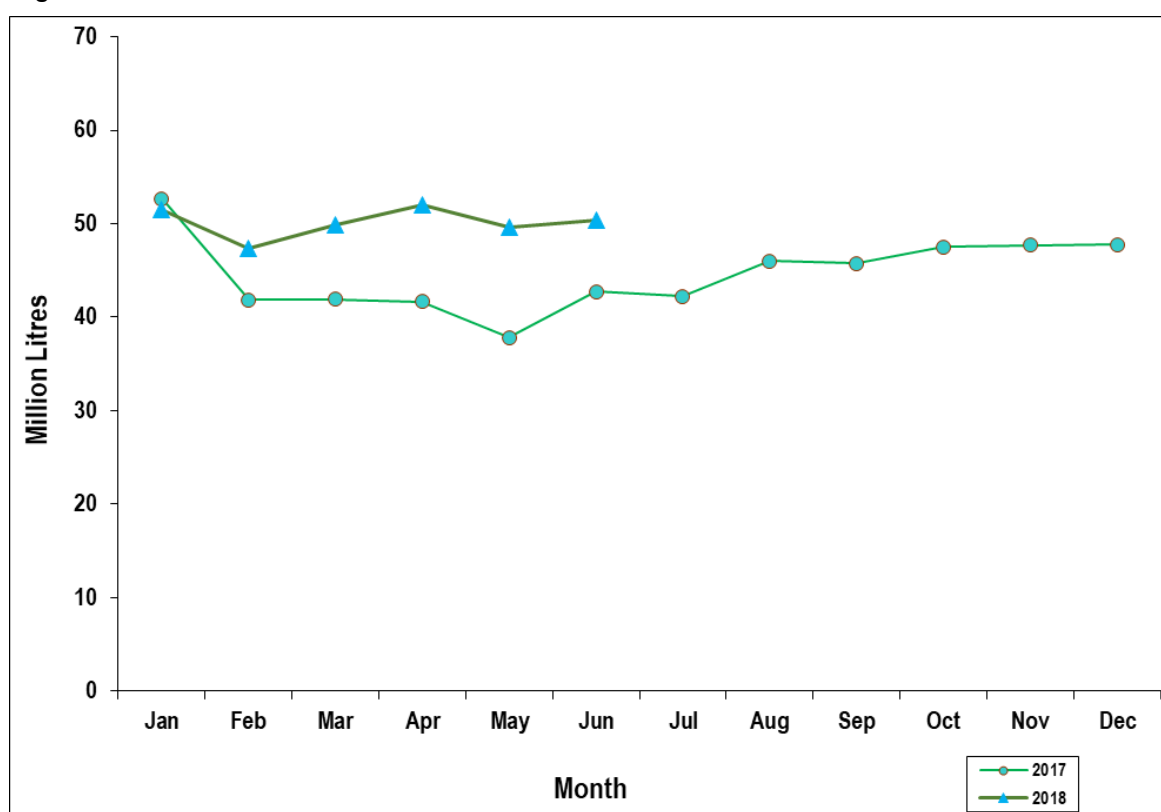

Fig. 11: Visitor Arrivals through J.K.I.A and M.I.A

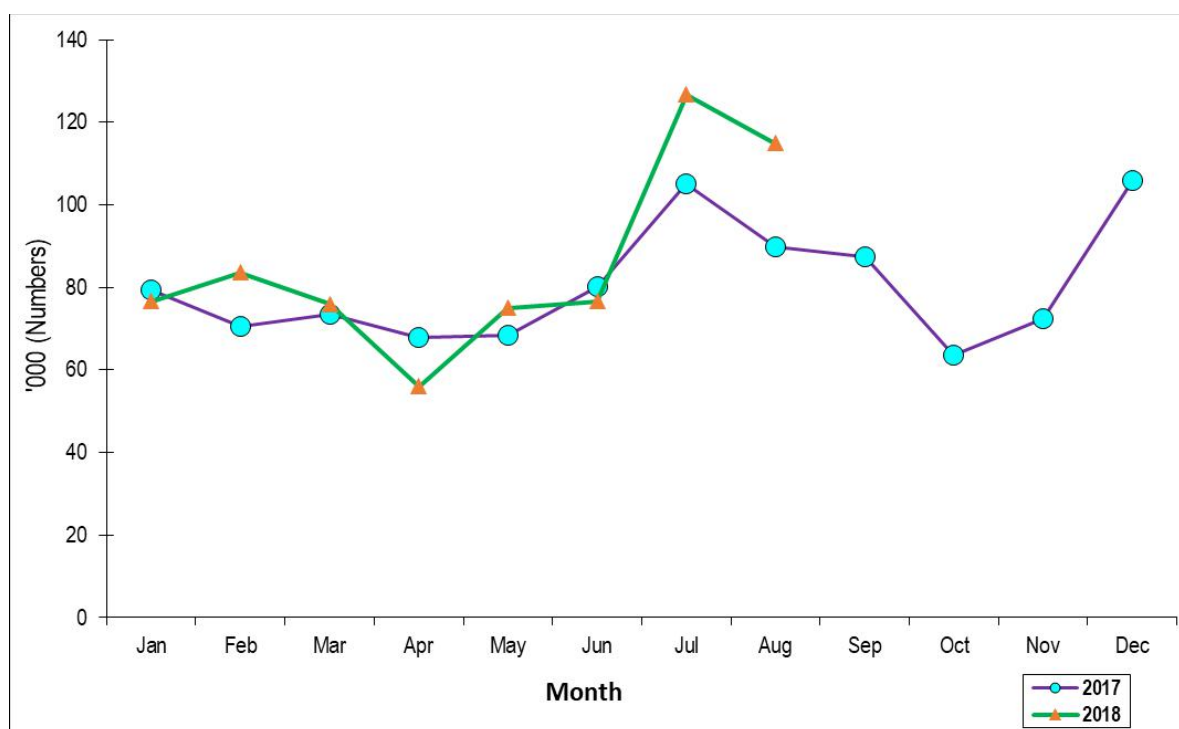
