Quarterly Balance of Payments

First Quarter, 2022

Balance of Payments

During the first quarter of 2022, the current account deficit narrowed by 39.7 per cent to KSh 95.0 billion from KSh 157.5 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2021, as shown in Table 1. In the same quarter, merchandise trade balance widened to a deficit of KSh 333.4 billion from a deficit of KSh 281.4 billion in the first quarter of 2021, an increase of 18.5 per cent. Over the same period, the value of imports on f.o.b basis increased by 14.5 per cent to KSh 542.5 billion, mainly due to increased imports of petroleum products. Similarly, export earnings grew by 8.8 per cent to KSh 209.1 billion in the first quarter of 2022 as a result of increase in value of exports of tea.

International trade in services receipts increased remarkably from KSh 110.9 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 221.5 billion in the first quarter of 2022. Similarly, services payments grew by 22.9 per cent to KSh 122.6 billion in the quarter under review. Consequently, the surplus in international trade in services grew significantly from KSh 11.2 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 98.9 billion in the same quarter of 2022. Transport and travel services receipts, which have continued to improve, were the major drivers in the review period. Remittance inflows continued to improve, increasing by 25.2 per cent from KSh 93.1 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 116.6 billion in the first quarter of 2022.

In the first quarter of 2022, net financial inflows declined by 14.0 per cent to a surplus of KSh 92.2 billion from a surplus of KSh 107.3 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2021. The stock of gross official reserves grew by 14.3 per cent to KSh 969.3 billion in the first quarter of 2022 from KSh 847.8 billion in the same quarter of 2021, partly as a result of the depreciation of the Kenya shilling to the dollar which exchanged at 114.95 from 109.51 to the dollar at the end of first quarters of 2022 and 2021, respectively. During the review period, there was significant draw down in gross official reserves to service external debt pushing the overall Balance of Payments position to a deficit of KSh 120.6 billion from a deficit of KSh 25.3 billion in the corresponding quarter of 2021.

Public and Publicly Guaranteed External Debt

Table 2 highlights the outstanding stock of Public & Publicly Guaranteed External debt from March 2020 to March 2022. The stock of debt, predominantly in form of loans continued to rise and amounted to KSh 4,209.6 billion by the end of March 2022 representing an increase of 11.7 per cent from the same period in 2021. Multilateral debt accounted for the bulk of outstanding external debt at 43.2 per cent, having risen by 21.5 per cent from March 2021.

Commercial banks were the second major source of credit with the stock of debt owed to these lenders accounting for 28.7 per cent of the total stock of external debt at KSh 1,208.2 billion at the end of March, 2022. The Eurobond was the major instrument held by Commercial Banks accounting for 67.6 per cent of the stock of Commercial debt for the period under review.

The stock of debt from bilateral sources rose from KSh 1,142.7 billion at the end of March 2021 to KSh 1,171.6 billion at the end of March 2022, accounting for 27.8 per cent of outstanding external Public & Publicly Guaranteed Debt.

International Merchandise Trade

During the first quarter of 2022, the volume of trade was KSh 802.0 billion compared to KSh 700.8 billion in the first quarter of 2021, representing an increase of 14.4 per cent. International merchandise trade balance deteriorated from a deficit of KSh 316.6 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to a deficit of KSh 384.4 billion in the quarter under review, as shown in Figure 1 and Table 3. This unbalanced growth was occasioned by a higher increase in the value of imports than in export earnings. Expenditure on imports in the first quarter of 2022 increased by 16.6 per cent from KSh 508.7 billion in

the corresponding quarter of 2021, while export revenue increased by 8.7 per cent during the same period. The rise in imports was largely attributable to increase in imports of petroleum products, whereas export earnings was driven majorly by increase in domestic exports of tea; and animal and vegetable oils.

Figure 1: International Merchandise Trade Balance, 1st Quarter, 2020-2022

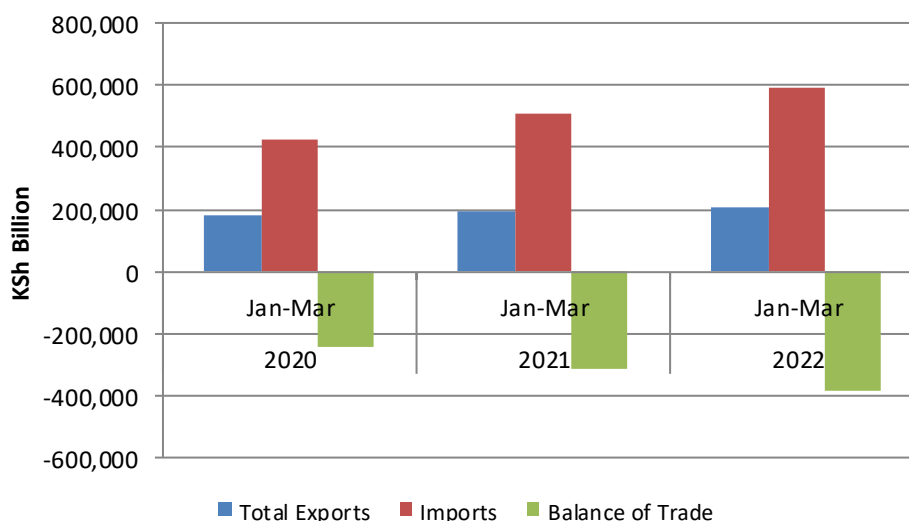

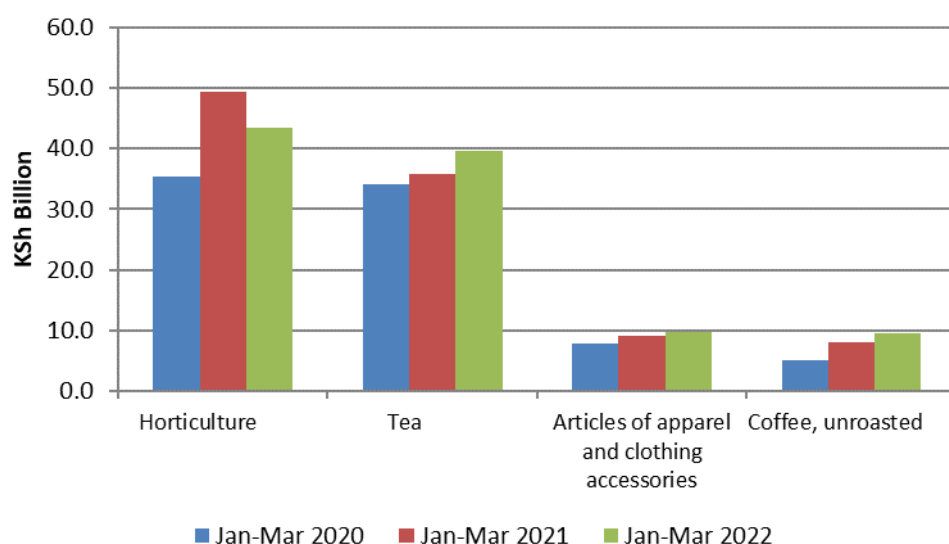

Value of Domestic Exports

In the first quarter of 2022, domestic exports earnings rose from KSh 171.0 billion in the same quarter of 2021 to KSh 183.8 billion. This was as a result of significant increase in exports of tea, coffee, iron and steel; and animal and vegetable oils as presented in Annex 1 and Figure 2. Earnings from exports of tea exports increased by 10.4 per cent following an increase in the price of black tea in the international market from KSh 233.89 per kilogramme in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 290.43 per kilogramme in the same quarter of 2022. Moreover, the value of animal and vegetable oils exports more than doubled to KSh 5.1 billion over the same period. In contrast, revenue from export of horticultural products declined from KSh 49.5 billion in first quarter of 2021 to KSh 43.5 billion in the same quarter of 2022, representing a 12.1 per cent decrease.

Analysis by Broad Economic Category (BEC) showed that earnings from domestic exports of food and beverage products accounted for the highest proportion of all domestic exports and amounted to KSh 79.9 billion in the period under review, as illustrated in Annex 7. Notably, domestic exports of non-food industrial supplies increased from KSh 40.2 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 50.0 billion in the corresponding period in 2022.

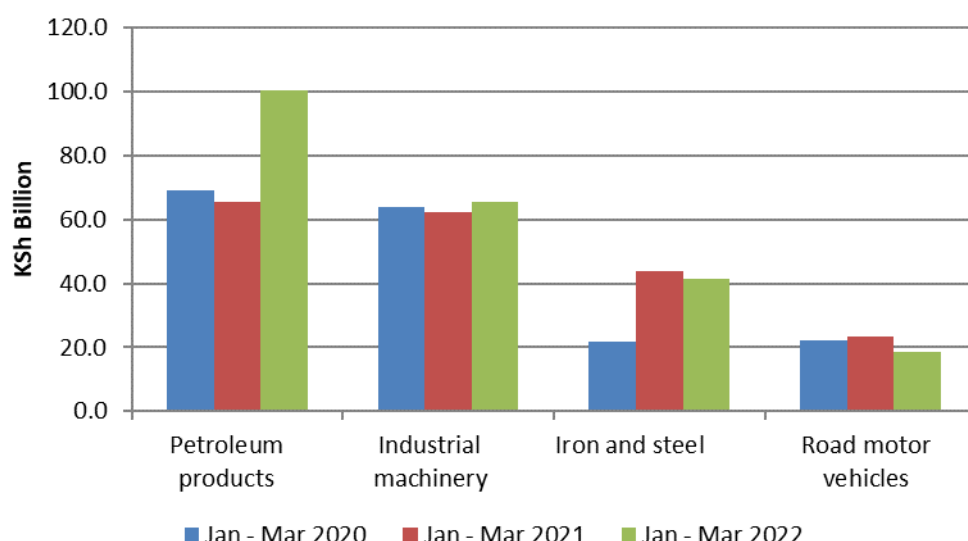
Value of Imports

Total imports increased from KSh 508.7 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 593.2 billion in the first quarter of 2022. This was mainly on account of increased import values of petroleum products, animal and vegetable oils; and medicinal and pharmaceutical products. Expenditure on imports of petroleum products increased from KSh 65.5 billion in first quarter of 2021 to KSh 100.2 billion in first quarter of 2022, while the import bill on animal and vegetable oils and; medicinal and pharmaceutical products increased by 33.8 per cent and 32.5 per cent to KSh 34.6 billion and KSh 28.5 billion, respectively, over the same period. Similarly, increased expenditure was recorded on imports of textile fabrics, paper and paperboard; and organic and inorganic chemicals by 50.2, 64.7 and 62.1 per cent, respectively, during the period under review.

The import value of road motor vehicles and; iron and steel went down from KSh 23.2 billion and KSh 43.9 billion in first quarter of 2021 to KSh 18.5 billion and KSh 41.2 billion, respectively, in first quarter of 2022. The quantity of imported wheat and rice declined by 35.4 per cent and 32.3 per cent, to 384.8 thousand tonnes and 132.6 thousand tonnes, respectively in the first quarter of 2022. In contrast, the volume of imported maize more than tripled from 37.1 thousand tonnes in the first quarter of 2021 to 116.2 thousand tonnes in the first quarter of 2022.

Imports of non-food industrial supplies under the Broad Economic Category classification accounted for 40.0 per cent of the total imports in first quarter of 2022 as shown in Annex 8. Fuel and lubricants registered the highest increase of 64.3 per cent in the first quarter of 2022 compared to the corresponding quarter of 2021 with the processed fuel and lubricants accounting for 89.6 per cent of the increase.

Direction of International Merchandise Trade

In the first quarter of 2022, total export earnings amounted to KSh 208.8 billion, representing a growth of 8.7 per cent compared to the first quarter of 2021, as shown in Annex 5. Africa continued to be the leading export destination accounting for 39.8 per cent of the total export earnings. This improvement was partly due to significant increase in exports to Tanzania which almost doubled. Total exports to Rwanda and Ethiopia which exhibited increases of 29.7 per cent and 62.4 per cent respectively. On the other hand, total exports to Uganda declined by 9.2 per cent to KSh 20.8 billion in the review period, largely attributable to decline in exports of crude palm oil and cement clinkers.

The value of total exports to the European Union slightly improved from KSh 33.1 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 34.0 billion in first quarter of 2022. The growth was largely boosted by increase in domestic exports of coffee to Belgium. Over the review period, export earnings from Asia exhibited an increase of 11.6 per cent from KSh 47.5 billion in first quarter of 2021, mainly on account of improvement in the domestic exports of tea and cut flowers to Pakistan and Saudi Arabia. Export earnings from the United States of America went up by 12.0 per cent in the first quarter of 2022 from KSh 14.8 billion in the first quarter of 2021. This rise was partly attributable to increase in domestic exports of titanium ores and concentrates and, articles of apparel and clothing accessories to this destination.

Expenditure on imports rose by 16.6 per cent in the first quarter of 2022 from KSh 508.7 billion in the first quarter of 2021, as shown in Annex 6. The bulk of the import bill was attributable to Asia accounting for 67.8 per cent, with China remaining the dominant source of imports from this region. Notably, imports from Malaysia and India increased by 87.9 per cent and 23.8 per cent, respectively. The increase was partly due to rise in imports of crude palm oil from Malaysia, and medicaments from India.

Imports from Africa registered an increase of 24.7 per cent from KSh 54.0 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 67.3 billion in the period under review. The increase was partly occasioned by increase in imports from South Africa and Tanzania, which exhibited an increase of 64.0 per cent and 23.7 per cent, respectively. Similarly, over the same period, imports from America recorded an increase of 35.1 per cent from KSh 32.9 billion in the first quarter of 2021. The growth was partly attributable to increase in imports of vaccines for human medicine and petroleum gases from the United States of America.

On the other hand, imports from Australia declined significantly from KSh 4.4 billion in the first quarter of 2021 to KSh 839.1 million in the period under review. The decline was partly occasioned by decrease in imports of wheat and meslin.
