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KEY HIGHLIGHTS

OVERVIEW

The Leading Economic Indicators highlights trends in Consumer Price Indices (CPI) and inflation, interest rates, exchange rates, international trade, agriculture, energy, manufacturing, building and construction, tourism and transport.

MACROECONOMIC INDICATORS

Consumer Price Index (CPI) expanded from 167.99 points in May 2016 to 169.76 points in June 2016. The overall rate of inflation increased from 5.00 per cent to 5.80 per cent during the same period. In June, 2016 the Kenyan Shilling appreciated against the Sterling Pound, the Euro and the Uganda shilling while depreciating against the US Dollar, the Japanese Yen and the South African Rand.

The average yield rate for the 91-day Treasury bills, which is a benchmark for the general trend of interest rates, fell from 8.15 per cent in May 2016 to 7.25 per cent in June 2016 while the inter-bank rate rose to 4.87 in June 2016 from 3.61 per cent in May 2016.

The Nairobi Securities Exchange (NSE) 20 share index contracted from 4,009 points in April 2016 to 3,868 points in May 2016, while the total number of shares traded decreased from 426 million shares to 384 million shares during the same period. The total value of NSE shares traded dropped from KSh 10.07 billion in April 2016 to KSh 9.72 billion in May 2016.

Broad money supply (M3), a key indicator for monetary policy formulation rose from KSh 2,709.00 billion in May 2016 to KSh 2,754.14 billion in June 2016.

Gross Foreign Exchange Reserves declined from KSh 1,010.85 billion in May 2016 to KSh 1,055.01 billion in June 2016. Net Foreign Exchange Reserves expanded from KSh 511.34 billion in May 2016 to KSh 560.34 billion in June 2016.

A). AGRICULTURE

The quantity of coffee auctioned at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange decreased from 4,730.8 MT in May 2016 to 1,717.3 MT in June 2016 while the average auction price increased from KSh 262.90 per kilogram to KSh 268.44 per kilogram over the same period. The quantity of processed tea dropped from 37,571MT in April 2016 to 36,573 MT in May 2016. The price of the processed tea increased from KSh 213.89 to KSh 222.84 per kilogram over the same period.

The amount of cane deliveries decreased from 576.69 thousand tonnes in April 2016 to 520.58 thousand tonnes in May 2016. Average price for dry maize fell from KSh 35.66 per kilogram in May 2016 to KSh 33.77 per kilogram in June 2016. The average price per Kilogram for dry beans in the month of June 2016 was KSh 75.43. Milk deliveries to formal processors declined from 54.2 million litres in April 2016 to 50.1 million litres in May 2016.

B). INTERNATIONAL TRADE

Quantity of coffee exported increased from 4,803.8 MT in April 2016 to 4,814.0 MT in May 2016 while its value fell from KSh 2,540.4 million to KSh 2,170.5 million over the same period. The quantity of tea exported expanded from 39,312.6 MT in April 2016 to 44,901.2 MT in May 2016, while its value rose from KSh 9,516.8 million to KSh 10,657.7 million over the same period.

Volume of trade contracted from KSh 171.5 billion in April 2016 to KSh 166.0 billion in May 2016. The total value of exports rose to KSh 49.86 billion while the value of imports decreased from KSh 124.9 billion in April 2016 to KSh 116.2 billion in May 2016.

Domestic exports by Broad Economic Category (BEC) indicated that food and beverages was the main export category in May 2016 accounting for 43.7 per cent of exports, while the value of non-food industrial supplies and consumer goods not elsewhere specified registered 22.7 and 26.7 per cent shares, respectively. BEC imports indicate that industrial supplies not elsewhere specified was the main import category in May 2016 with a share of 35.8 per cent, while the values of machinery & other capital equipment, fuel and lubricants and transport registered shares of 19.7, 14.1 and 10.4 per cent, respectively. Food and beverage recorded a share of 9.2 per cent while consumer goods not elsewhere specified recorded a share of 8.9 per cent.

C). ENERGY

Total electricity generation declined to 813.49 million KWh in June 2016 from 839.42 in May 2016. Domestic consumption of electricity went up from 734.45 million KWh in May 2016 to 748.31 million KWh in June 2016.

In the international market, the price of Murban crude oil increased from an average of US Dollars 47.35 per barrel in May, 2016 to US Dollars 49.05 per barrel in June 2016. The national average domestic retail oil prices of motor gasoline premium increased from KSh 85.14 per litre in May, 2016 to KSh 87.07 per litre retailed in June, 2016. The price of light diesel oil rose to retail at KSh 74.69 in June 2016 from KSh 71.34 in May, 2016. The average price for Kerosene rose to retail at KSh 59.10 in June 2016. Charcoal prices averaged KSh 78.71 during the period. The price of a 13-Kg cylinder of gas averaged KSh 2,231.38 in June, 2016.

D). MANUFACTURING, BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION

The quantity of cement produced increased from 535,147 MT in April 2016 to 536,074 MT in May 2016. Consumption of cement dropped from 505,012 MT in April 2016 to 501,646 MT in May 2016. Sugar production decreased from 48,800 Metric tonnes in April 2016 to 45,122 Metric tonnes in May 2016. Production of assembled vehicles increased from 650 units in March 2016 to 658 units in April 2016.

E). TOURISM AND TRANSPORT

The total number of visitors arriving through Jomo Kenyatta (JKIA) and Moi International Airports (MIA) increased to 62,872 in May 2016 from 55,180 in April 2016. The number of passengers who landed at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport (JKIA) decreased from 179,879 in February 2016 to 180,339 in March 2016, while passengers who embarked contracted from 180,712 persons to 180,396 persons in the same period. The total number of vehicles registered rose from 10,280 in March 2016 to 13,693 in April 2016. Motorcycles accounted for about 52 per cent of total motor vehicles registered in April 2016.

Fig. 1: Inflation rates

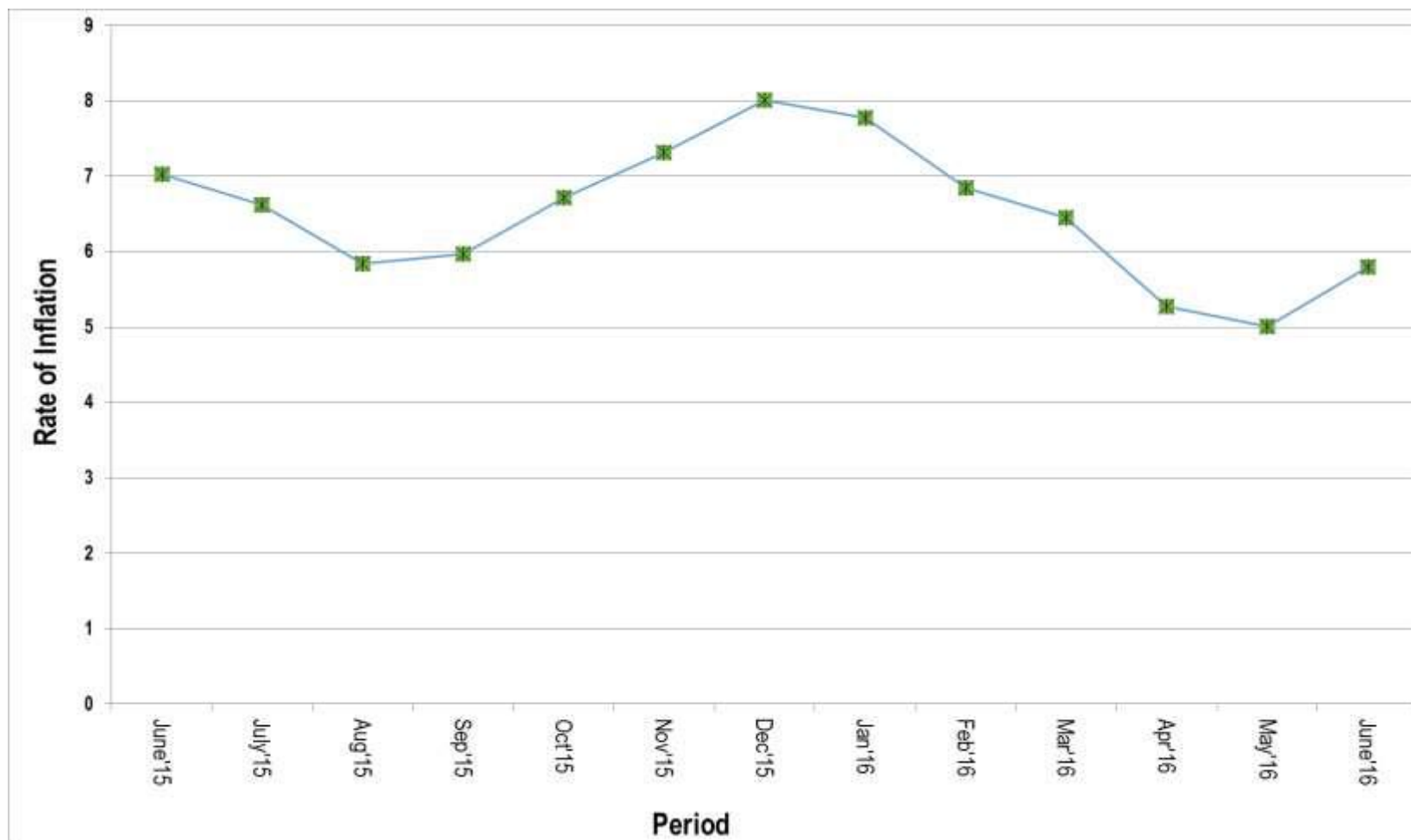

Fig 2: End of Month Mean Exchange rate of Kenya Shillings against Major Selected Currencies

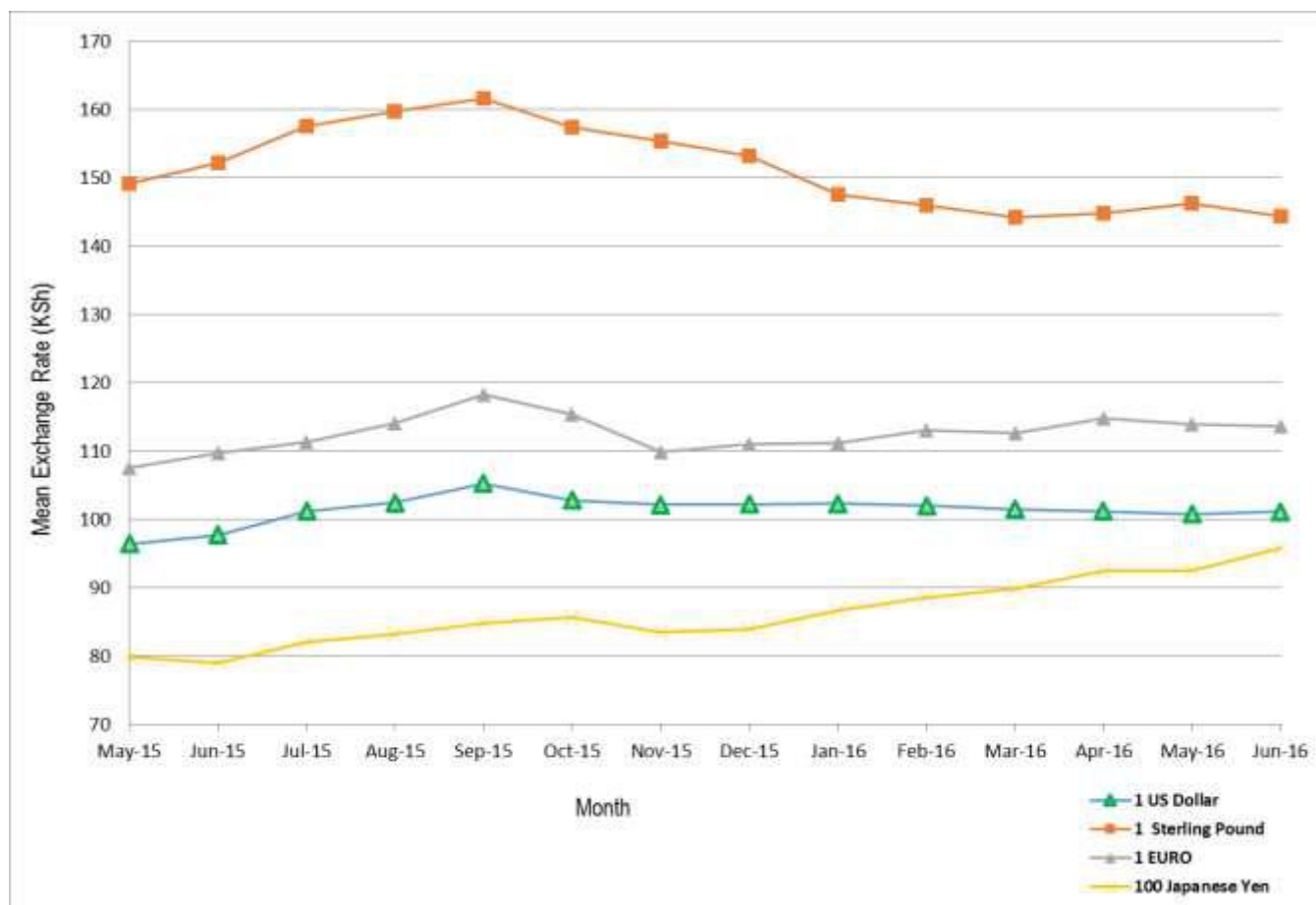

Fig. 3: Nairobi Securities Exchange 20 Share Index

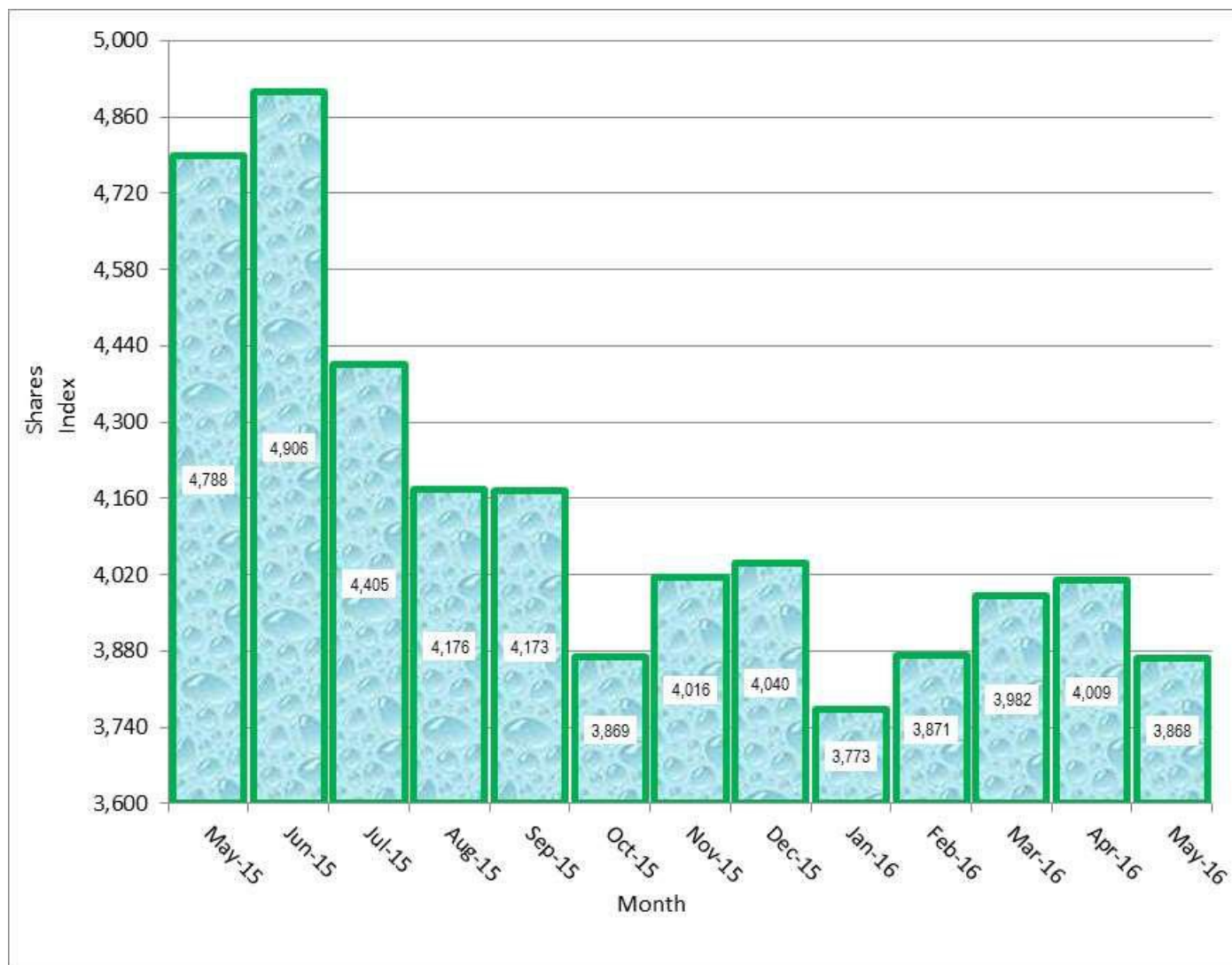

Fig 4: Foreign Exchange Reserves

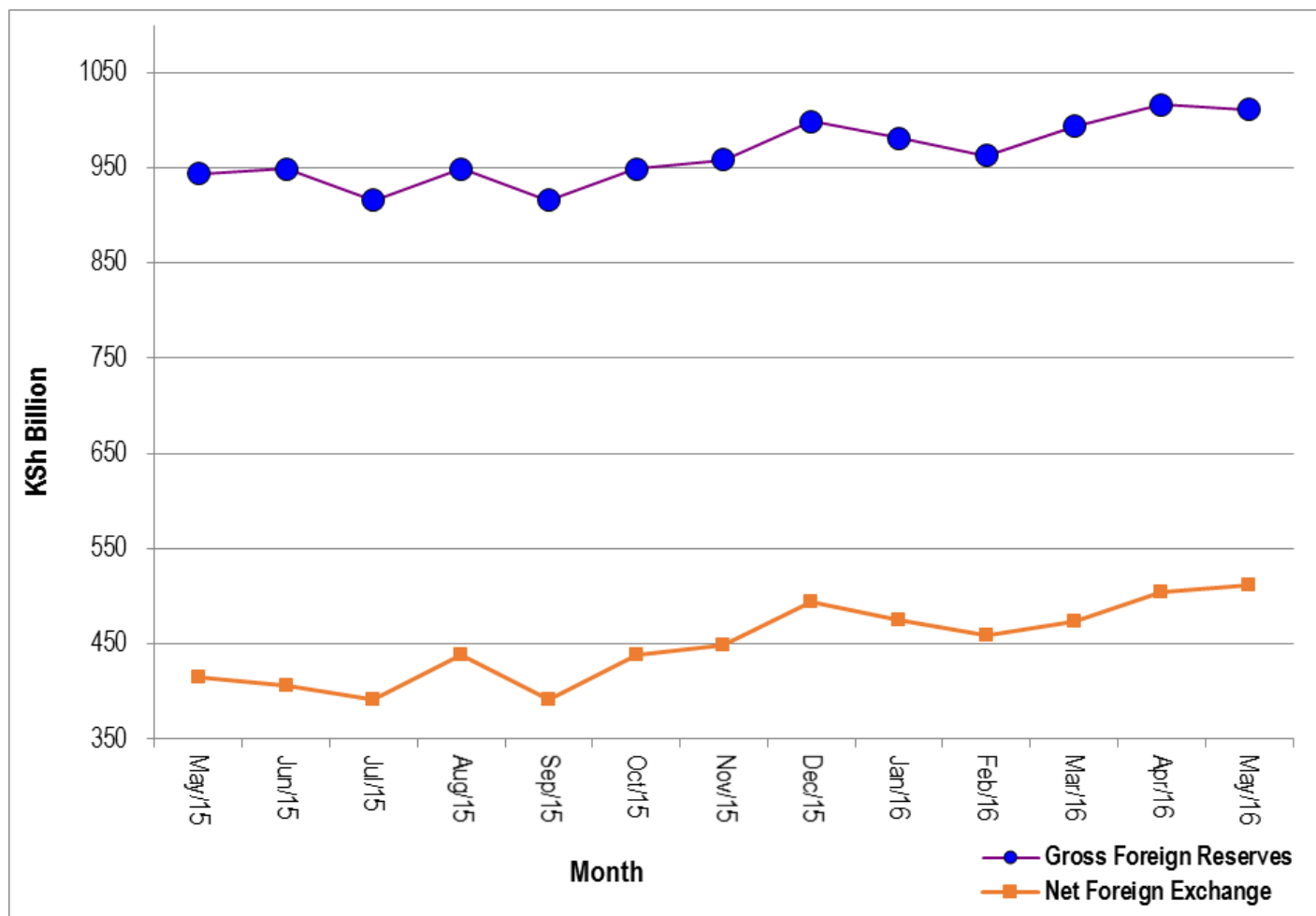

Fig.5: Coffee Sales at the Nairobi Coffee Exchange

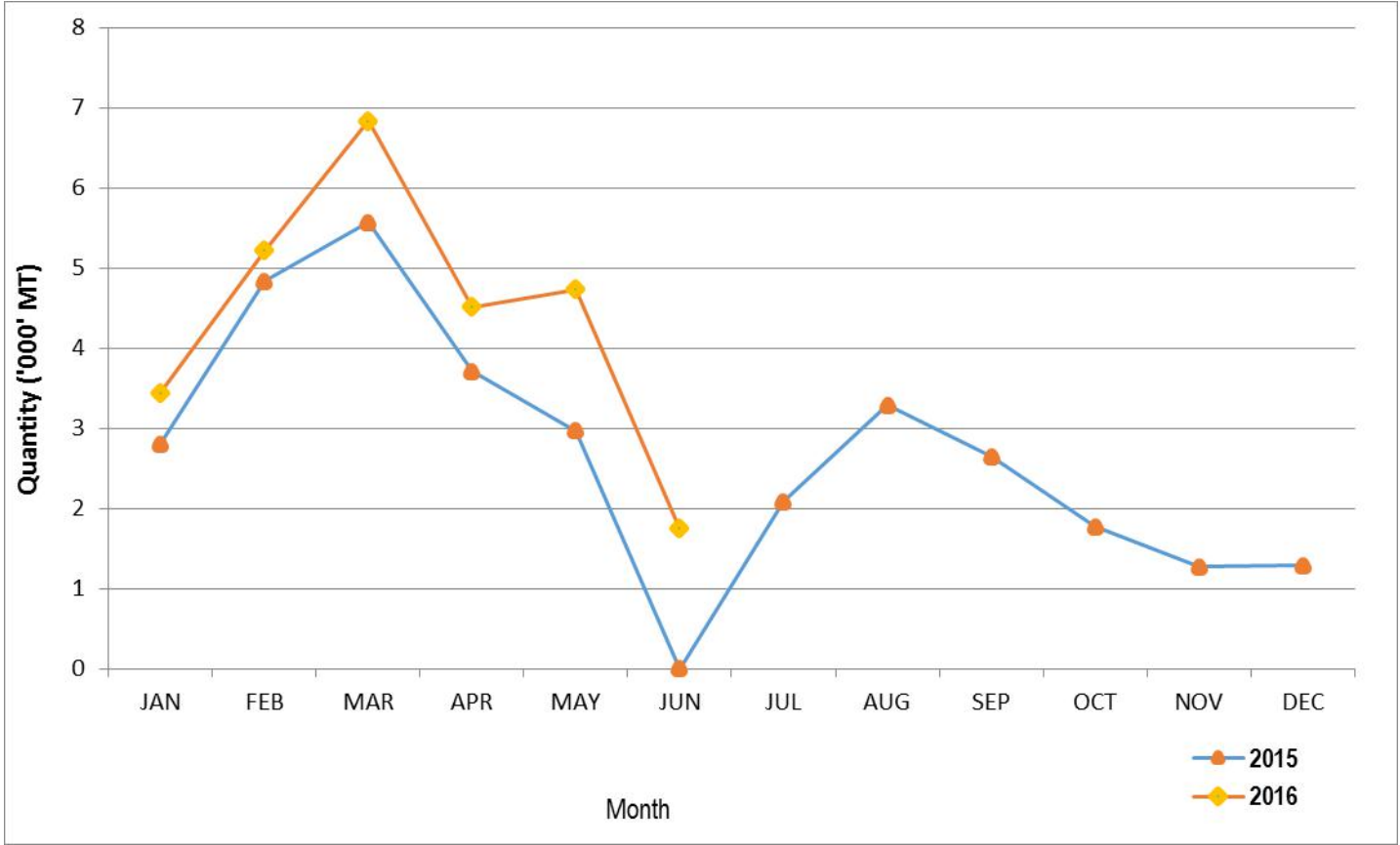

Fig.6: Tea Production

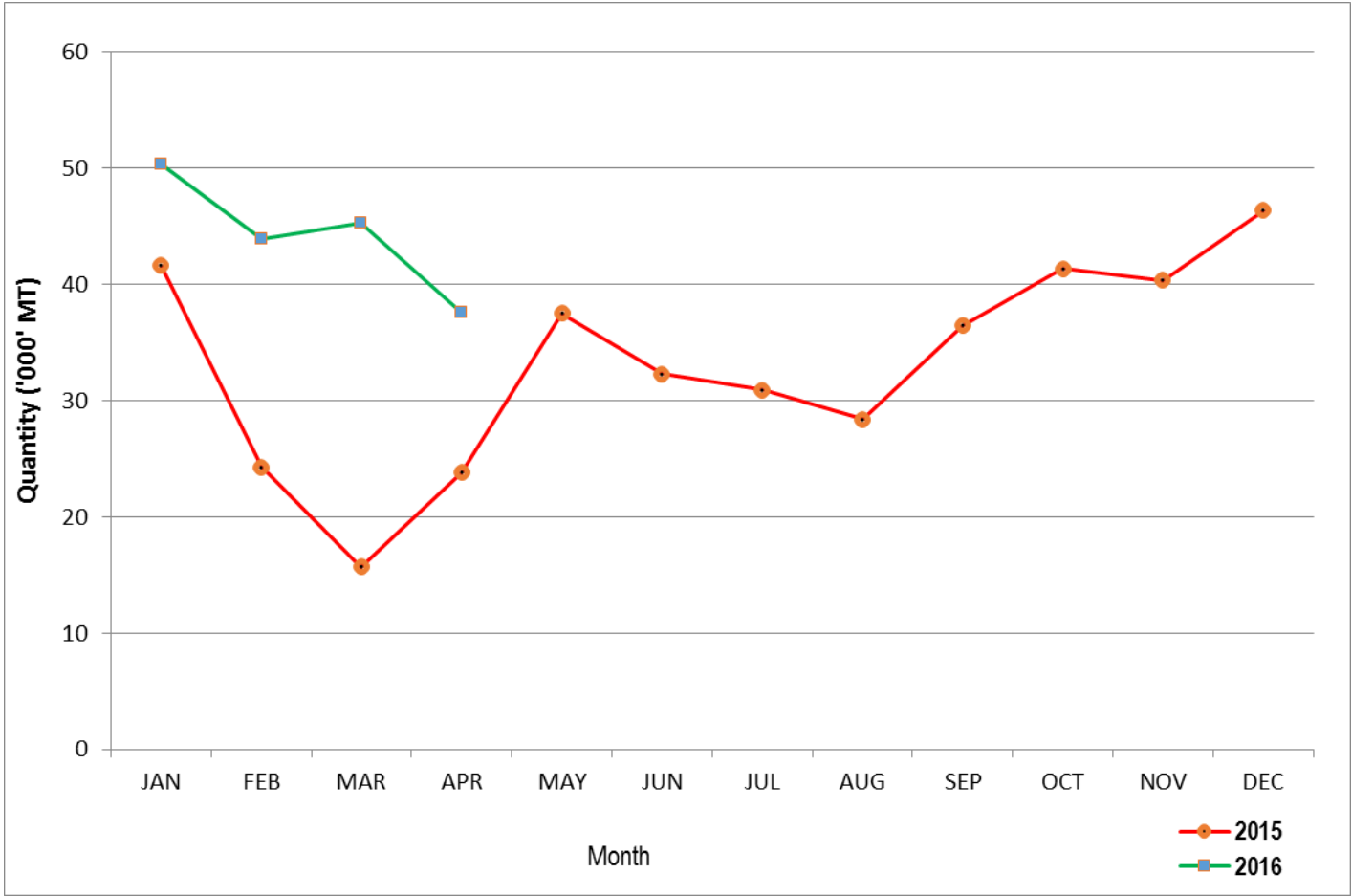

Fig.7: Cane Deliveries

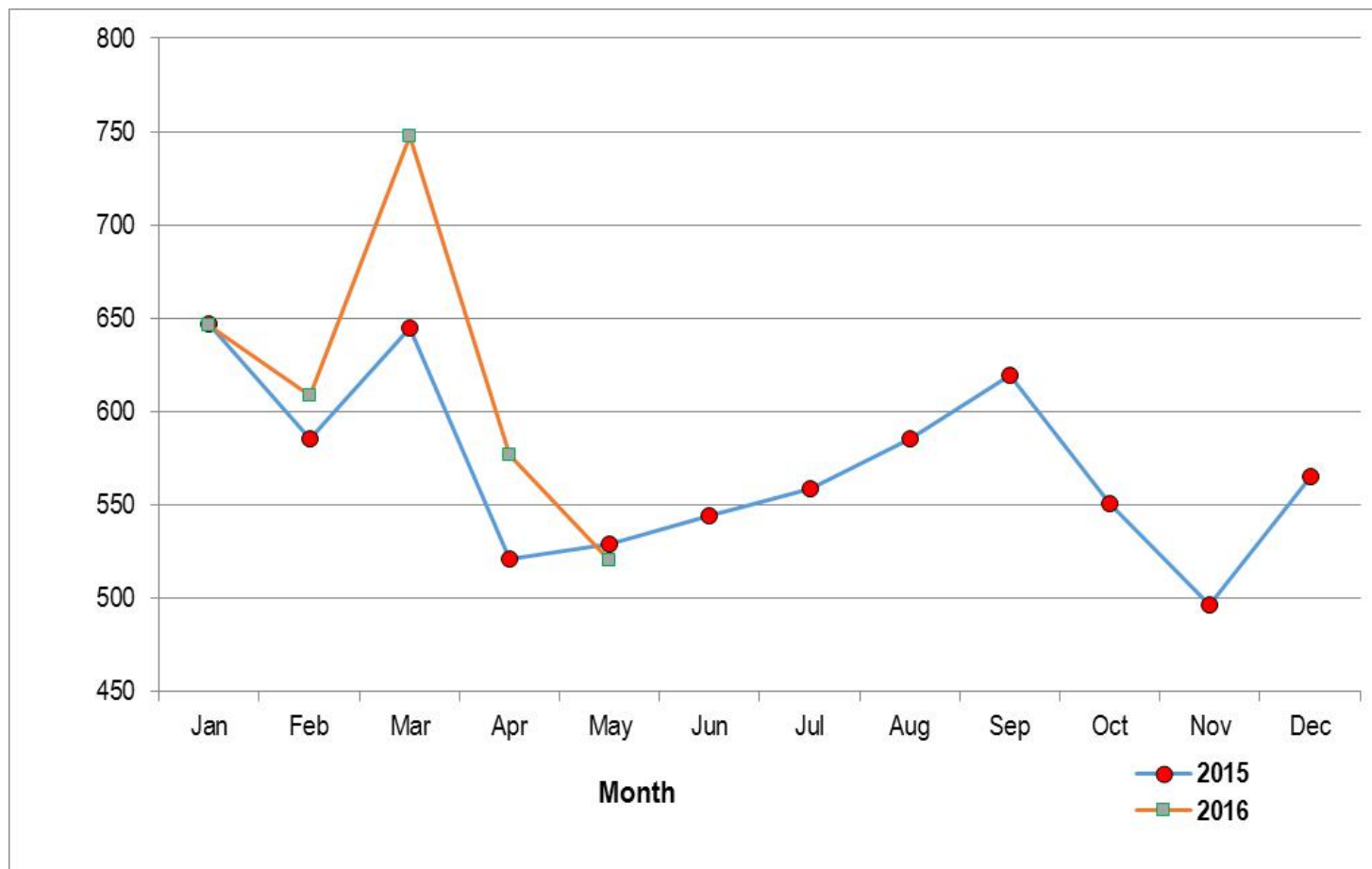

Fig. 8: Electricity Generation by Source

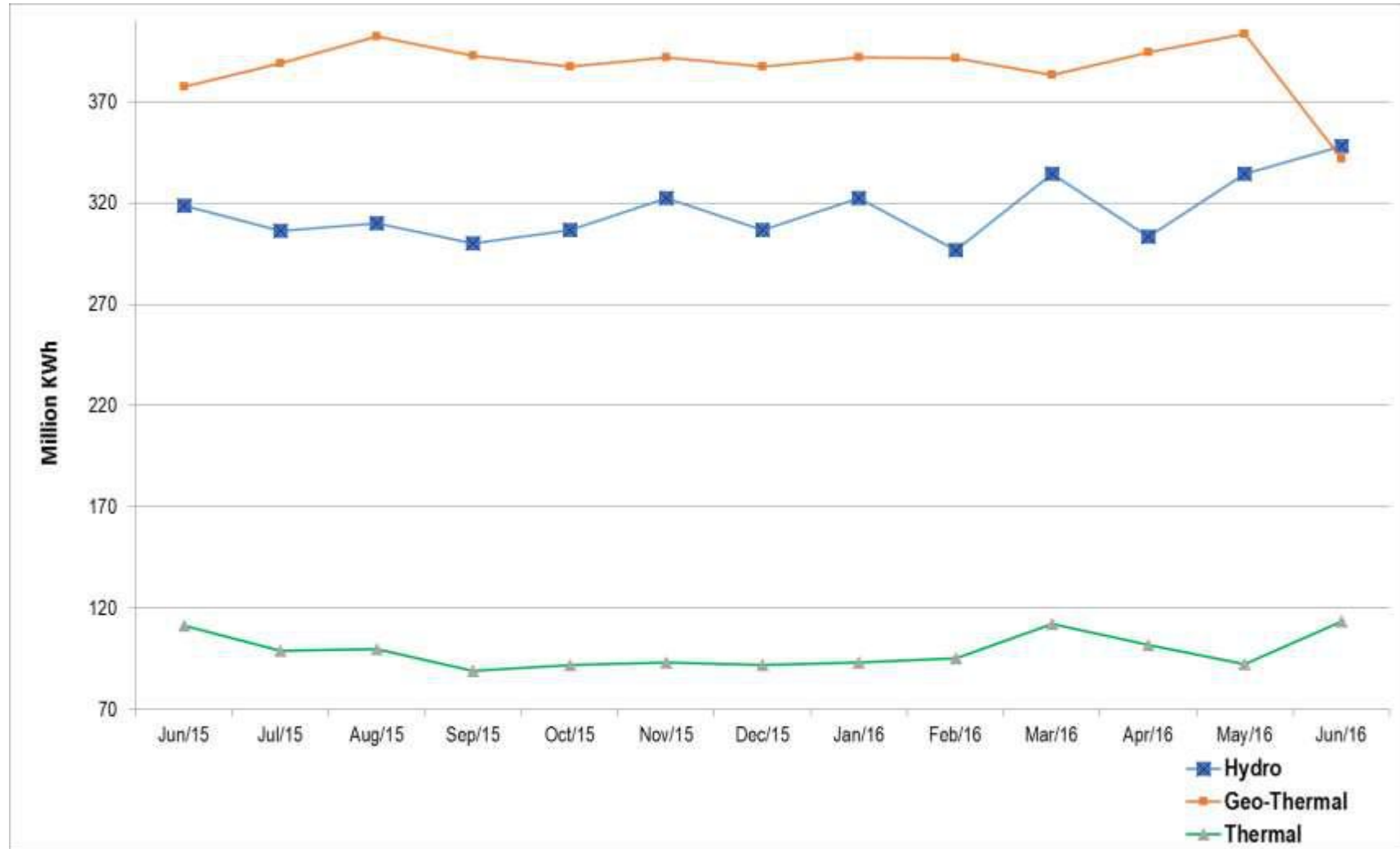

Fig.9: Electricity Generation, Consumption and Power Losses

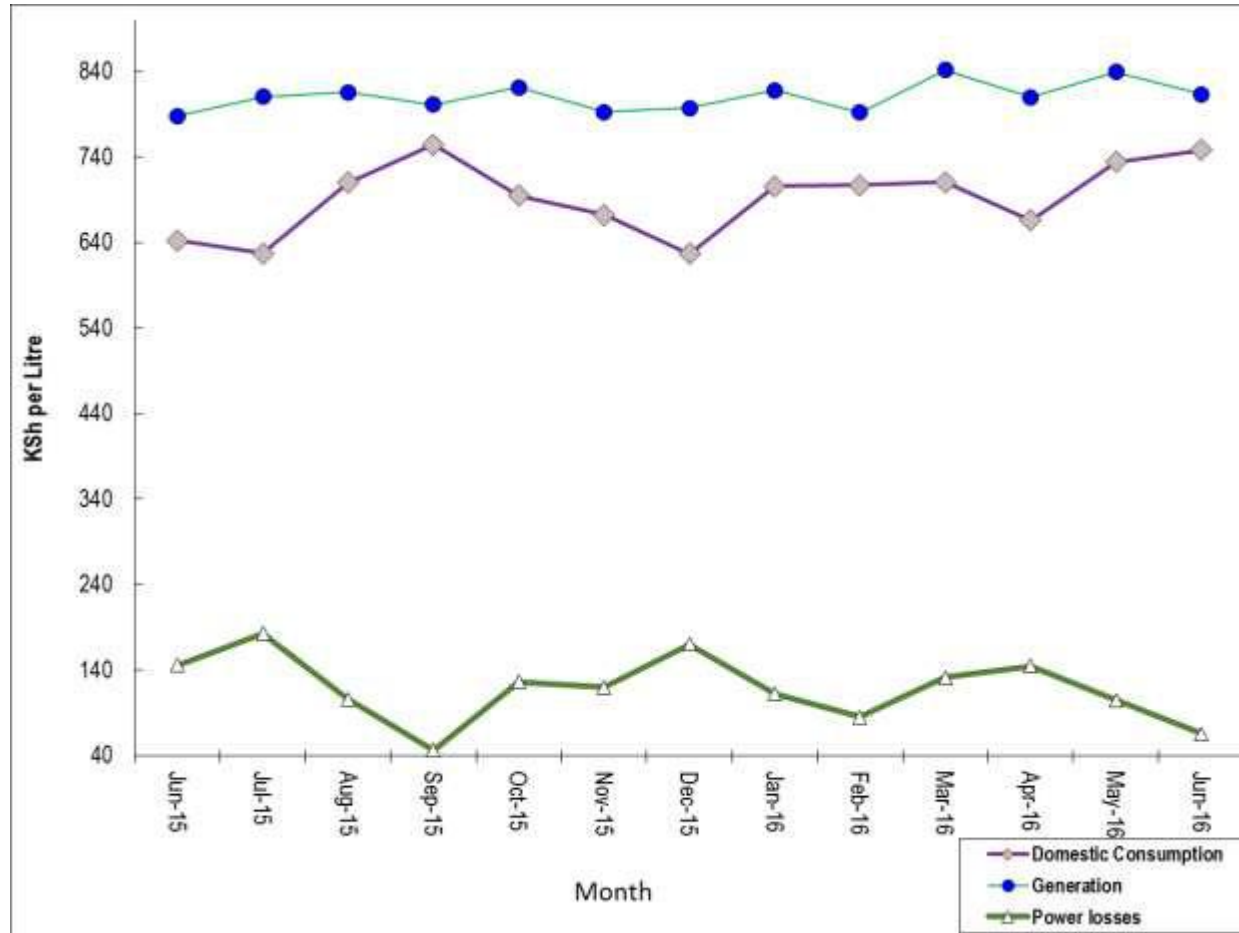

Fig. 10: Average Prices for Liquefied Petroleum Gas in Kenya

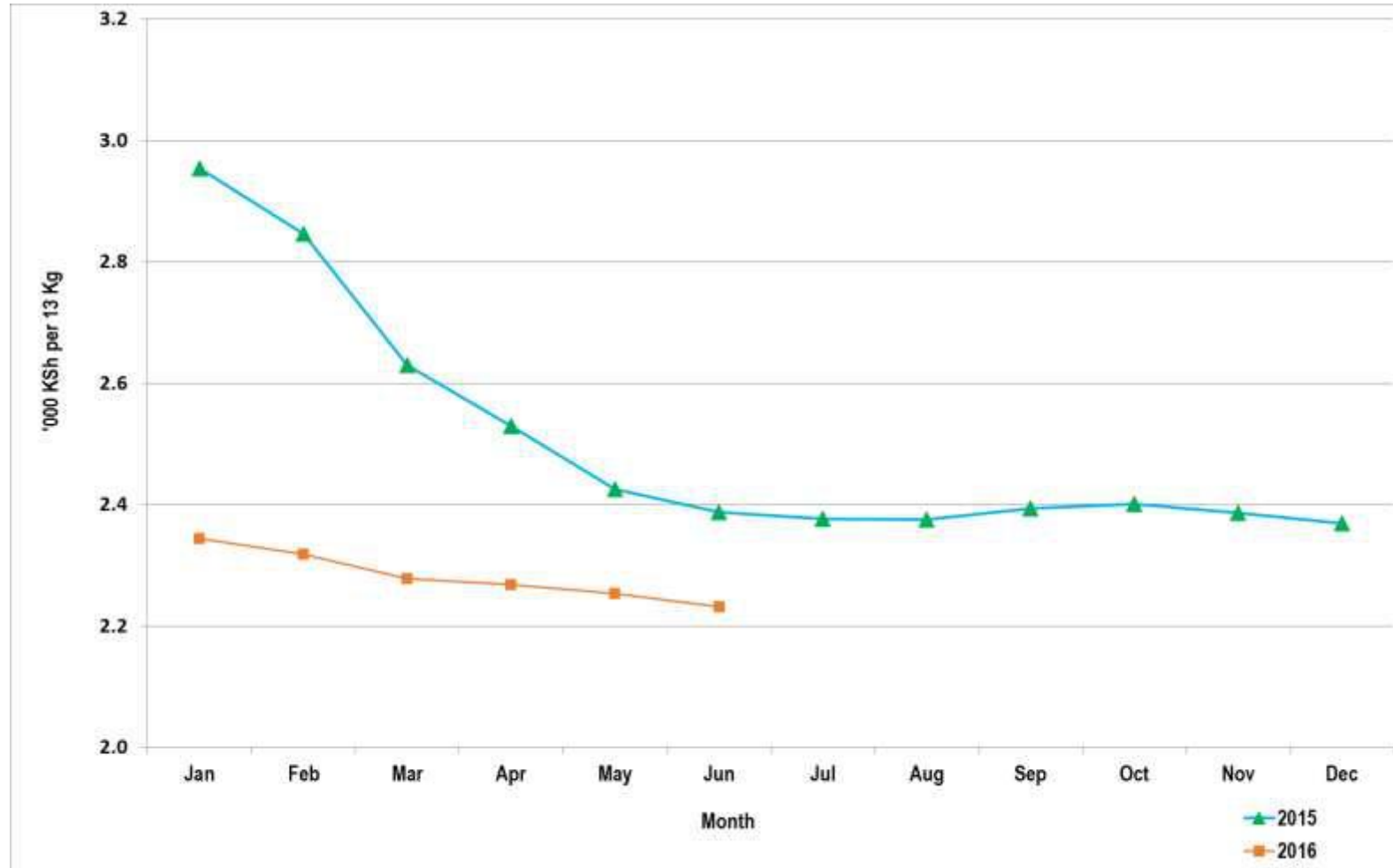

Fig 11: Trends for Different world Crude Oil Prices

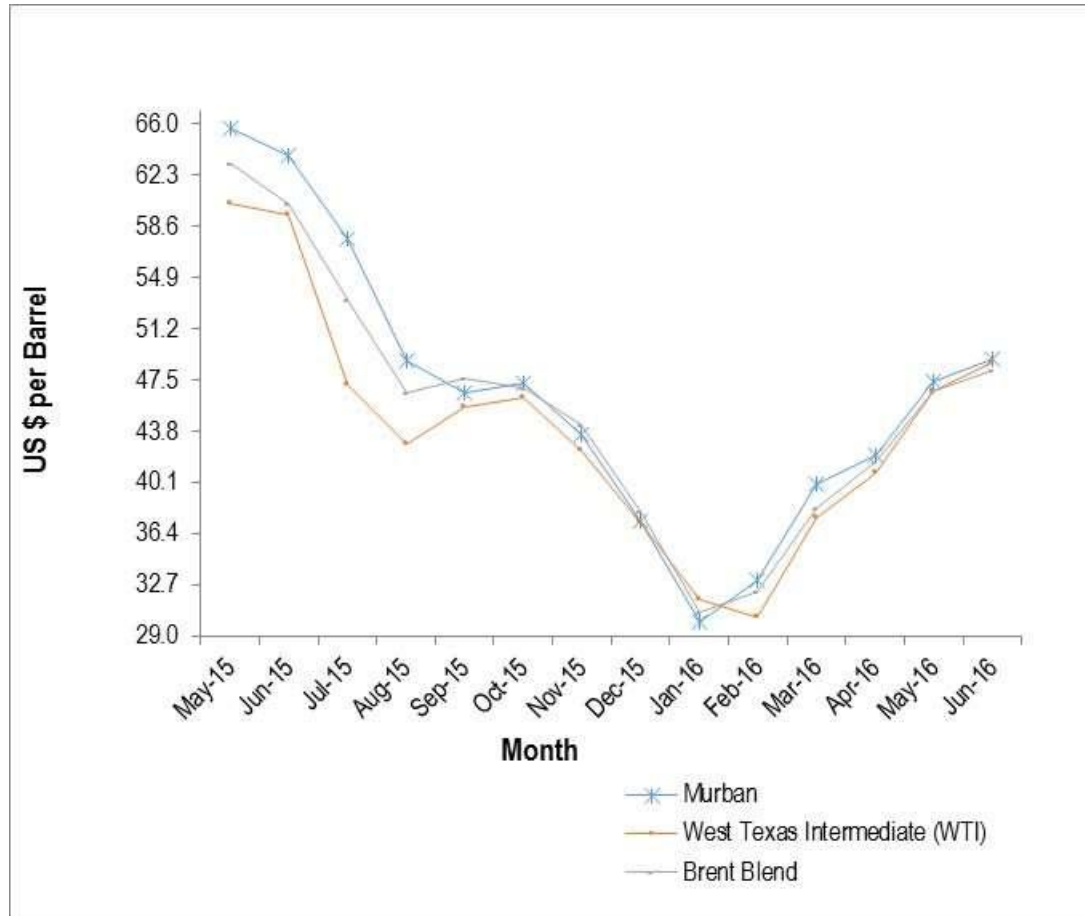

Fig. 12: Milk Intake in the Formal Sector

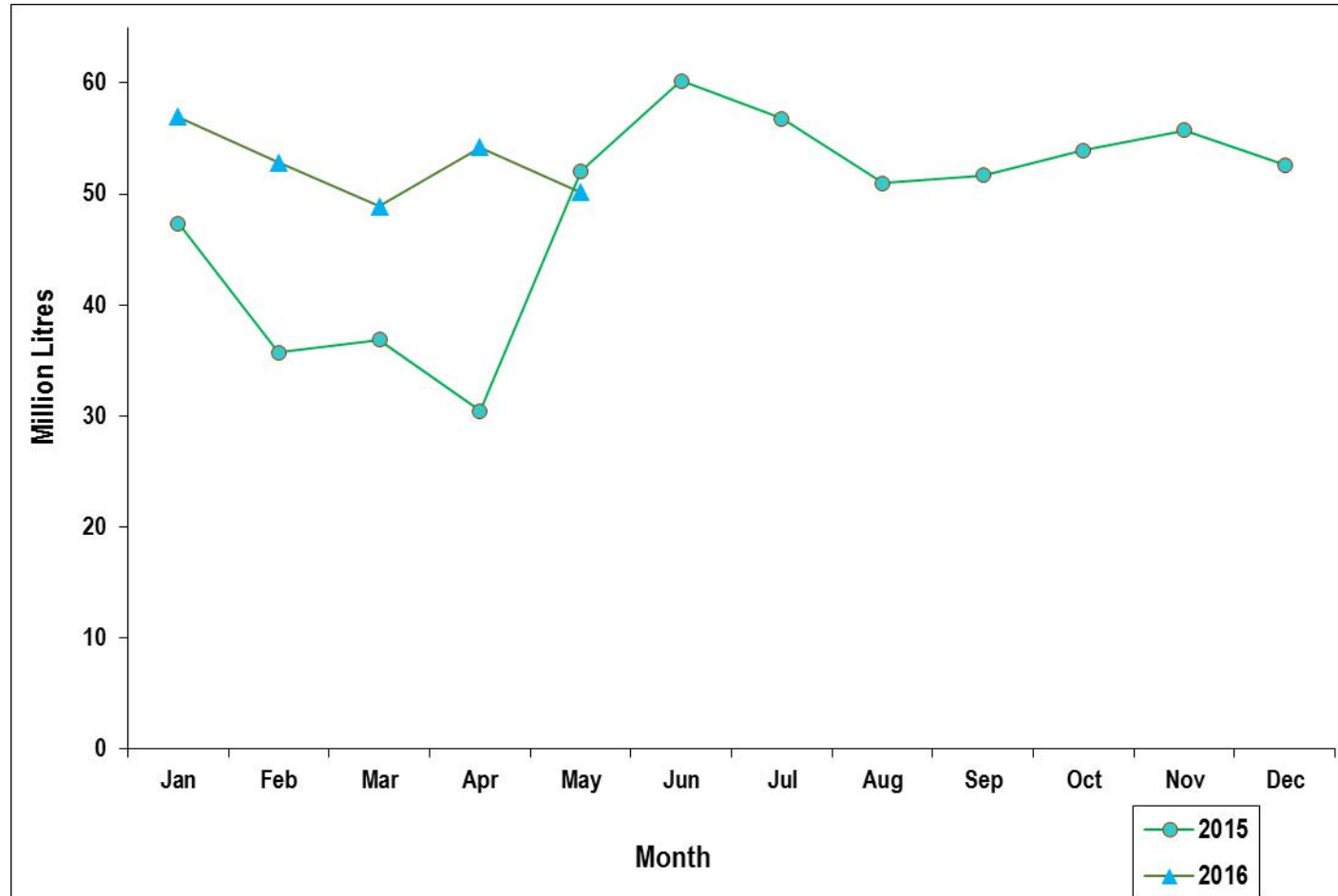

Fig. 13: Visitor Arrivals through J.K.I.A and M.I.A

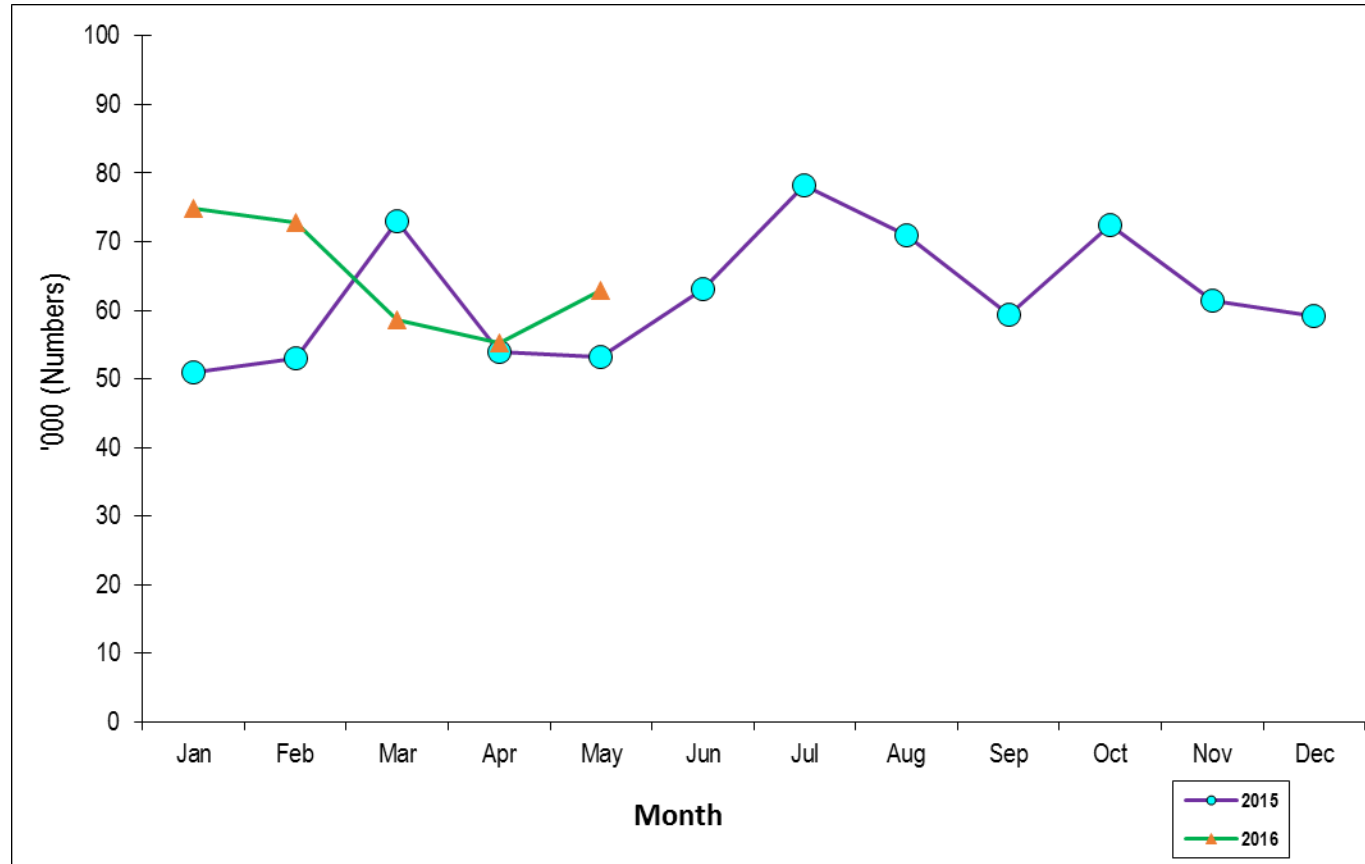
